Leading Off

Today, Reading and Richmond will conclude a brief three-game series to open the season. Richmond took both games of yesterday's doubleheader and Reading will look to avoid being swept to open the season. Following today, the R-Phils will head back north to Reading for the home opener on Tuesday against Hartford.

Looking Back

Reading's offense struggled to the tune of just five runs in a doubleheader sweep at the hands of Richmond yesterday. In game one, the R-Phils took an early lead thanks to a Wendell Rijo double. But, a 3-0 lead wasn't enough as Richmond fought back to take a 4-3 lead and hold on for the win. In game two, the R-Phils saw themselves down 3-0 and scored two runs in the seventh to make it interesting, but could not complete the comeback and fell 4-3.

Aces Aplenty

When looking back at the 2022 R-Phils roster, the word ace certainly comes to mind. Pitching was Reading's strength in 2022 and three guys who contributed to that were Andrew Painer, Mick Abel and Griff McGarry. All three came to Reading in last summer and dominated in the starting rotation. Abel returns to Reading to start the season with the R-Phils, while Painter and McGarry are currently on the injured list.

New Skipper

With Shawn Williams' relocation to the Phillies complex in Clearwater, the R-Phils welcome Al Pedrique as the manager for the 2023 season. Pedrique brings years of both playing and coaching in the minor leagues. Most recently, he served as the third-base coach for the Miami Marlins. Prior to that, Pedrique managed Miami's triple-A affiliate, Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp. He also has experience coaching within the Diamondbacks, Astros, Yankees and many more organizations. Pedrique remains in search of his first managerial win.

Looking Up

The big club, Philadelphia Phillies, won its second game in a row yesterday in dramatic fashion over the Cincinatti Reds. Down 2-0 in the bottom of the ninth, the Phillies rattled off three unanswered runs to win 4-3 and clinch its first home series of the season. 2021 R-Phil Bryson Stott remaned hot with multiple hits, including the game-winning single in the bottom of the ninth to walk it off.

Loaded with Prospects

Reading's Opening Day roster features five of the Phillies top-30 prospects. Mick Abel ranks second, Johan Rojas sixth, Carlos De La Cruz ninth, Ethan Wilson 14th and Andrew Baker 17th. All those players spent time in Reading last season.

This Day in Baseballtown History

April 9-10, 1999: At Reading, Jimmy Rollins and Pat Burrell make their Reading Phillies debut and the Altoona Curve makes its franchise debut on an Opening Night in which bad weather forces the game to be suspended in the 2nd inning. The Phils win the game, which is completed the next day, 6-2, as Rollins goes 1-for-3 with an RBI while Burrell is 2-for-4.

The Flying Squirrels

Richmond won both games of yesterday's double header thanks to great pitching and timely hits. Nick Zwack shined in game two with nine strikeouts over four innings pitched as the starter. Luis Matos had an impressive couple of games as well, picking up three hits and four runs scored.

Squirrel on the Bump

Richmond will trot out righty Mason Black as it looks to sweep out Reading to open the season. Black split last season between single-A San Jose and high-A Eugene. He impressed with a 6-4 record and 3.21 ERA over 24 starts in 2022.
