Today: The Lansing Lugnuts, High-A affiliate of the Oakland A's, play the second game in a six-game series against the Great Lakes Loons, sending right-hander **Jeff Criswell**, a native of Portage who is ranked No. 18 among A's prospects by MLB Pipeline, against Loons right-hander **Cole Percival**, who is best friends with Lugnuts reliever Daniel Martinez. The Nuts are 1-0 against the Loons in the 24-game season series.

Yesterday: Lugnuts 7, Loons 4. Trailing 4-1, the Nuts narrowed the deficit to one run with a two-run 4th, took the lead on a two-out Matt Cross two-run homer in the 7th, and then watched Cross crush a second two-run homer in the 9th for insurance on their way to a series-opening win. Brett Harris added his team-leading seventh homer of the season and the Lugnuts' bullpen tossed 5 1/3 scoreless innings in outdueling the Loons' relievers in the victory.

On Deck: The Nuts play the Loons through Sunday, take a day off on May 23, and then continue this 12-game, 13-day homestand with a six-game series at the Beloit Sky Carp. The Lugnuts' next home game is on May 31, opening a six-game series with the Cedar Rapids Kernels.

May Power: With three more homers yesterday, the Lugnuts have slugged a league-leading 25 roundtrippers in 14 games in May after hitting 11 homers in 20 freezing games in April, the second-fewest total in the MWL. The Lugnuts are slashing .259/.344/.487 (.831 OPS) this month. 3B **Brett Harris** has been particularly effective, slashing .341/.429/.854 with three doubles, six homers, 12 runs scored and 11 RBIs in 11 games.

**Improbable:** When **Matt Cross** stepped to the plate in the 7th inning yesterday against reliever **Braydon Fisher**, Cross had collected four hits in 48 plate appearances while Fisher had allowed two hits in 44 batters faced.

Among the MWL Leaders: 3B Brett Harris ranks 1st in the Midwest League in OBP (.425), 3rd in slugging (.617), 2nd in OPS (1.042) and tied for 5th in runs scored (21). OF Lawrence Butler is tied for fifth in the Midwest League with 20 walks, INF Euribiel Ángeles is 4th with 38 hits, starter Jeff Criswell is fifth with a 0.83 WHIP, and reliever Angello Infante and Kumar Nambiar are tied for second with 12 appearances and Infante is tied for third with five saves. Criswell owns the only shutout in the league thus far, a seven-inning one-hitter at Lake County.

As a Team: The Lugnuts' offense ranks 2nd in the MWL in batting average (.249), 3rd in base hits (270), 3rd in total bases (440), 2nd in home runs (36), 1st in fewest strikeouts (289), 3rd in OBP (.333), 4th in slugging percentage (.405) and 4th in OPS (.738).

**Dany Dominates:** 2018 Lugnuts closer **Dany Jiménez** recorded a five-out save for the A's last night in a 5-2 win over Seattle, his seventh save of the year. Jiménez, who entered this year with 1 1/3 innings of MLB experience, has allowed three runs (one earned) in 15 1/3 innings for a 0.59 ERA, notching 16 strikeouts compared to five walks and limiting MLB hitters to a .175 avg. and a .452 OBP.

And So Does David: Southpaw David Leal, the man with the 82 mph fastball, continued his strong season with a gem last night. Leal, promoted earlier this year from Lansing, allowed two unearned runs in six innings in his second start for Double-A Midland, walking one and K'ing seven in a 5-2 RockHounds loss. In 33 total innings this year between Lansing and Midland, Leal has a 2.18 ERA with six walks and 34 strikeouts.

**166 Major League Nuts...:** Pitcher **Danny Young** (2016 in Lansing) debuted for the Seattle Mariners on May 9 with 2 1/3 scoreless innings in relief, becoming the 166th all-time Nut to reach the Majors and the fifth this year, joining Oakland A's relievers **Zach Logue** and **Zach Jackson** and infielder **Christian Lopes** and Toronto Blue Jays utilityman **Vinny Capra**.

## 26 PHIL POHL MANAGER

Born in Bakersfield, Calif., Phil Pohl's family moved to Cooperstown when he was nine years old. He starred at Cooperstown Central High School, where he was honored as the 2008 Gatorade New York High School Baseball Player of the Year.

Pohl was drafted by Tampa Bay in the 44th round, becoming Cooperstown Central's first ever draft pick, but decided to attend Clemson University. He served as a two-time team captain for the Tigers, was honored three times as a member of the ACC Academic Honor Roll, and was selected Second Team All-ACC.

Pohl signed as a 28th-round pick of the Athletics in 2012 and played four seasons of Minor League Baseball, rising as high as Triple-A Sacramento. Upon retiring from playing, he rejoined the organization as the A's MLB bullpen catcher, a position he held through the end of the 2021 season. This is his first season managing.

Personal: Criswell played the trombone, cello and guitar while growing up "but I didn't have any serious musical talent, that's probably why I took the career path I did"... his father, Brian, was drafted by the A's in the 17th round in 1984 from Western Michigan and pitched in the Midwest League for the Madison Muskies, today's West Michigan Whitecaps, eventually reaching Double-A Huntsville, where he was teammates in 1986 with Mark McGwire... Jeff's mother, Patti, has written books for the American Girl company... Jeff's sister, Natalie, was a record-setting swimmer at Bowling Green State University.

Hail to the Victors: Rated Perfect Game's No. 1 high school right-hander in Michigan in 2017 while at Portage Central, Criswell was drafted by the Tigers in the 35th round in 2017... turned them down and went to Ann Arbor... named All-Big Ten First Team as a sophomore (2.72, 116 K in 106 IP) and was a key contributor in leading the Wolverines on their run to College World Series Runner-Up to national champion Vanderbilt... in all, went 10-4, 2.88, 50 G, 162 1/3 IP, 174 K at Michigan.

The Run to Omaha: A look at how important Jeff was to the Wolverines in their 2019 path to the College World Series National Championship:

NCAA Regional: Struck out nine in 7 2/3 innings in a 10-4 comeback victory over Cincinnati. Michigan went on to eliminate No. 22 Creighton to advance.

NCAA Super Regional: Facing No. 1 UCLA, relieved Karl Kauffman with the potential tying and game-winning runs aboard in the bottom of the ninth and dispatched Jake Pries with a pop-up and Jack Stronach with a strikeout to secure a thrilling 3-2 win. Started the very next day and allowed one earned run in 5 1/3 innings, departing with a 3-2 lead, only to see the Bruins win 5-4 in 12 innings. Michigan went on to eliminate UCLA in Game 3, advancing.

College World Series: Pitched the final two innings scorelessly, earning the save, in a 5-3 CWS-opening win over No. 8 Texas Tech, striking out Brian Klein with the tying runs aboard to end the game. Earned another save in a rematch with Texas Tech six days later, firing the final three innings scorelessly with six strikeouts to complete a 15-3 romp, sending the Wolverines into the CWS Finals against No. 2 Vanderbilt. Secured the final two outs in Game 1 against the Commodores, a 7-4 UM win. Worked the final five innings in relief, striking out seven, in Michigan's Game 3 series-clinching 8-2 loss to Vandy.

**National Pride:** Following the 2019 college baseball season, Jeff was invited to pitch for the Team USA Collegiate National Team... recorded yet another crucial save, firing the final three innings against Taiwan in Game 2 of their three-game series... limited opposing batters to a .120 average, best of all pitchers on the team.

Prospecting: Criswell is currently Keith Law's No. 12 overall A's prospect, MLB.com's No. 9 A's pitching prospect and No. 22 overall prospect, and Fangraphs' No. 15 A's prospect... MLB Pipeline's grades: Fastball 60, Curve 50, Slider 55, Change 55, Control 45, writing about him, "Criswell's success as both a starter and reliever at the University of Michigan led to him landing a \$1 million signing bonus from the A's as a second-round pick in the 2020 Draft. After injuries limited him to just 12 innings pitched at High-A in what would have been his first full season with the organization, he did manage to end his year on a high note by returning in time to play in the Arizona Fall League and ranking among the league's top strikeout leaders.... He's been described as Bassitt-ish in reference to Chris Bassitt for similarities in their athletic builds."

2021 Pro Debut: Began 2021 as the highest ranked prospect on the Lugnuts' Opening Day roster: Keith Law's No. 5 overall A's prospect, MLB.com's No. 3 A's pitching prospect and No. 14 overall prospect, and Baseball America's No. 14 A's prospect. Wrote Law, "Criswell was mostly a two-pitch guy up to 95 mph at Michigan, but was showing four pitches and hitting 97 mph in instructs, with a cleaner delivery than the violent one he'd had before the shutdown. Criswell's slider was a swing-and-miss pitch in college and it's gotten sharper now, while his changeup, which he barely used in school, was flashing plus in instructs too." ... started the fifth game of the Lugnuts season, May 8 vs. Lake County, and tossed two easy scoreless innings, but then spent May 12-August 27 on the Injured List, limiting season... made six appearances, three starts, for the Arizona Fall League champion Mesa Solar Sox: 2-1, 6.75 ERA, 22 2/3 IP, 26 H, 17 R/ER, 5 HR, 12 BB, 32 K, 3 HBP, 1 balk, 1.68 WHIP... 12.7 K/9 IP.

2022: Debuted as Lugnuts starter in the third game of the year, April 10 vs. Lake County... gave up two third-inning runs, but that was all in 4 2/3 innings in a no-decision... departed with the Nuts leading, 3-2... Lansing went on to win, 6-5, avoiding a three-game sweep... started April 16 at West Michigan; gave up 1st-inning (two-run) and 3rd-inning (solo) home runs to West Michigan's Jake Holton in suffering his first professional defeat... Midwest League Pitcher of the Week: started Game 2 of a doubleheader April 30 at Lake County, taking a no-hitter into the 7th inning before allowing a Petey Halpin single; finished with a one-hit shutout in 8-0 Lugnuts win: 68 pitches, 1 H, 1 BB, 6 K... May 7 vs. West Michigan – appeared to be on his way to finishing five scoreless innings with a 4-0 lead to his back before serving up a three-run HR to Corey Joyce; that spelled the end, with final line 4 2/3 IP, 6 H, 3 R, 1 BB, 7 K... Lugnuts ran out of pitching after nine innings, using Joshwan Wright on the mound in a 7-7 game in the 10th; West Michigan scored four runs off of Wright and hung on for an 11-10 win.

Last start: May 12 vs. Dayton. Criswell allowed a double to Jose Torres on his first pitch of the game, then walked the third and fourth batters of the game to load the bases, but recovered to strand the bases loaded, setting down the final 14 hitters he faced to complete five scoreless one-hit innings with eight strikeouts... departed with a 2-0 lead, only to see Daniel Martinez blow the lead in a three-batter span in the 6th, allowing home runs to Elly De La Cruz and Alex McGarry... Lugnuts recovered to walk off on Tyler Soderstrom's one-out grand slam in the 9th, 7-3.
