**Mike Vasil in the 2023 SiriusXM All-Star Futures Game:** New York Mets pitching prospect and former Binghamton RHP **Mike Vasil** represented the Mets in the 2023 SiriusXM All-Star Futures Game last night at T-Mobile Park in Seattle. Vasil recorded a walk and a three-pitch strikeout in his 0.1 inning of work. The National League prospects won the 7-inning game 5-0.

**Last Time Out:** The Binghamton Rumble Ponies fell to the Portland Sea Dogs 4-2 at Hadlock Field on Saturday night. Agustin Ruiz and Rowdey Jordan hit into sacrifice flies that drove in the two runs. Matt O'Neill had his first three-hit game of the season and Brandon McIlwain and Jordan also had multi-hit games.

**Jordan's Brand: Rowdey Jordan** is having a great series. In the first five games, Jordan is 8-for-17 (.471 AVG), with two doubles, a homer, four RBIs, four runs, three walks, four stolen bases, and a three-hit game. He reached base safely in his first eight plate appearances in the series. Over the last 28 days, Jordan is batting .320 with eight XBH, 12 RBIs, 12 R, and a .889 OPS.

**Big BMac:** Outfielder **Brandon McIlwain** had his team-leading 19th multi-hit game of the season on Saturday night in Portland. It was his second-straight multi-hit performance and third of this series. In the series, McIlwain is 7-for-19 (.368), with two doubles, two RBIs, and a .928 OPS.

**Amazin' Alvy:** Former Rumble Ponies catcher **Francisco Álvarez** has been on a tear for the New York Mets. Álvarez has hit a home run in four of his last five games, including three in Arizona and one last night in San Diego. He leads all catchers in the major leagues with 17 long balls. He has set the Mets' rookie catcher HR record.

**MLB All-Star Game:** Former Rumble Ponies first baseman **Pete Alonso** (3rd All-Star selection) and right-handed rookie pitcher **Kodai Senga** (1st All-Star selection) will represent the New York Mets at the All-Star Game. Alonso will also participate in Monday's T-Mobile Home Run Derby. Alonso is the No. 2 overall seed in the eight-batter field, and he will face No. 7 seed Julio Rodríguez in the first round. Alonso is looking to join Ken Griffey Jr. as the only players to ever win three Home Run Derby titles, as he won back-to-back titles in 2019 in Cleveland and 2021 in Colorado.

**Last Start:** Scott started the series opener at Portland on Tuesday and faced adversity for the first time at the Double-A level. He allowed a career-high-tying six runs on a career-high-tying eight hits over six innings of work. He allowed two home runs, two walks, and totaled five strikeouts.

**2022:** Scott made 18 appearances and nine starts across two levels at Class-A St. Lucie and High-A Brooklyn. He held a 3.80 ERA in his five starts and six appearances for the Cyclones last season. Across the two levels, Scott held a 77-to-22 K-to-BB ratio.

**BACKGROUND:** Scott was drafted by the Mets in the fifth round of the 2021 draft out of the University of Florida. Scott made four starts for Peoria in the Arizona Fall League this past fall, alongside Rumble Ponies outfielder Brandon McIlwain and pitcher Mike Vasil. He currently ranks as the Mets' No. 27 overall prospect by MLB Pipeline. He totaled a 12-5 career record in 55 appearances and five starts with a 3.72 ERA, three saves, and 111 strikeouts across 121 innings pitched for the Gators across three seasons from 2019-2021. As a redshirt sophomore in 2021, Scott went made 26 appearances and one start going 4-2 with a 3.00 ERA and 51 strikeouts in 54 innings. He ranked in the top 10 in the SEC in appearances in 2021, leading the Gators. Led Calvary Christian Academy to the 2018 4A State Title in Floriday and was a First Team All-American selection by MaxPreps. Was a member of the USA Baseball 2016 17U National Team Development Program.

# Ponies Field Staff

## **Reid Brignac - Manager - 2nd season with Binghamton - 4th year in the Mets organization.**

In 2022, Brignac led a team that saw five players make their major league debut with the Mets after starting the season with the Rumble Ponies (Francisco Álvarez, Brett Baty, Jose Butto, Nate Fisher, and Bryce Montes de Oca), tied for the second-most in franchise history. This past fall, Brignac was one of two Mets staff members selected to be a part of the Arizona Fall League coaching staff, serving as the manager of the Peoria Javelinas. Following his retirement as an active player in 2018, Brignac was the manager of the St. Lucie Mets (Low-A) in 2021 before coming to Binghamton last year. As a player, Brignac appeared in parts of nine seasons in the major leagues with the Tampa Bay Rays, Colorado Rockies, Atlanta Braves, Philadelphia Phillies, New York Yankees, and Miami Marlins. He was drafted by the Rays in the second round of the 2004 MLB Draft.

**AJ Sager - Pitching Coach - 1st season with Binghamton - 2nd year in the Mets organization.** Sager served in the same role for the Brooklyn Cyclones (High-A) last season. Sager previously spent twenty seasons with the Detroit Tigers organization, including six seasons as the pitching coach with Triple-A Toledo. He pitched for parts of five seasons in the major leagues, playing for the San Diego Padres, Colorado Rockies, and Detroit Tigers as part of a 12-year professional career. In 123 major league appearances, the right-hander was 12-15, with five career saves and a 5.36 ERA.

**Darin Everson- Hitting Coach - 1st season with Binghamton - 1st year in the Mets organization.** Everson spent the previous five seasons as the Colorado Rockies Hitting Coordinator and 10 years in the Rockies organization. During his tenure, he served as the organization's Triple-A hitting coach in 2017, Double-A hitting coach from 2013-2014 and as the club's Double-A manager from 2015-2016. He previously was part of the Marlins organization for four years and served as an Associate Scout with the Baltimore Orioles from 2003-04. Everson played professionally as a catcher and first basemen for seven seasons with the Montreal Expos, Pittsburgh Pirates, and Boston Red Sox organizations.

**Mariano Duncan - Bench Coach - 2nd season with Binghamton - 5th year with Mets organization.** Duncan returns to the Southern Tier to begin his second year as Bench Coach with the Rumble Ponies. He previously served as the bench coach for the Brooklyn Cyclones (High-A) in 2021. He is entering his fifth year in the Mets organization. The former infielder played 12 major league seasons with the Los Angeles Dodgers, Cincinnati Reds, Philadelphia Phillies, New York Yankees, and Toronto Blue Jays. He was a member of two World Series championship teams (1990 Cincinnati Reds, 1996 New York Yankees) and was inducted into the Dominican Republic Baseball Hall of Fame in 2008.
