Tonight's Game: The Sounds continue their series with the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp tonight at 121 Financial Ballpark. The Jumbo Shrimp got their second win of the series in shutout fashion, taking down Nashville 10-0. Aaron Ashby will try and turn it around for the Sounds tonight. He'll face left-hander Patrick Monteverde who gets the ball for Jacksonville.

Aaron Ashby: The 26-year-old makes his first start since last Saturday tonight. He is 1-5 with an 8.30 ERA (55.1 IP/51 ER) across 13 appearances (11 starts) with Nashville. Ashby has also pitched twice for the Brewers and is 0-2 with a 6.23 ERA (8.2 IP/6 ER) with the big-league club. He took his third loss of the month on June 22 vs. Durham, allowing seven runs (all earned) on four hits and four walks in 3.2 innings. He uncorked a pair of wild pitches and faced 21 batters on 88 pitches (54 strikes). Since tossing his only quality start of the season on May 31 at Memphis, Ashby is 0-2 with a 13.89 ERA (11.2 IP/18 ER) in three outings for the Sounds (took the loss with Milwaukee on June 5 at Philadelphia as well). Aaron is the nephew of Andy Ashby, who pitched in the Majors with Philadelphia, Colorado, San Diego, Atlanta and Los Angeles-NL from 1991-2004. His younger brother, Chandler, plays baseball at William Jewell College, an NCAA Division II school in Liberty, Mo. Ashby was originally selected by Milwaukee in the fourth round of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft out of Crowder Junior College.

Patrick Monteverde: The 26-year-old makes his 10th appearance and ninth start for Jacksonville. He is 3-2 with a 5.28 ERA (46.0 IP/27 ER) this season. Monteverde returned to the rotation on May 21 at Memphis. He gave up three runs (all earned) on eight hits, one home run and three walks without a strikeout in a no-decision. The Jumbo Shrimp would go on to beat the Redbirds 6-3 that evening. Monteverde took the loss in his last time out against Nashville, giving up four runs (all earned) on five hits in 5.2 innings on May 16. He was placed on the injured list following the outing vs. Nashville and made two starts with Single-A Jupiter this month. Monteverde is ranked as the No. 22 prospect in the Marlins system by MLB Pipeline. He was Miami's Minor League Pitcher of the Year last season and was selected to the SiriusXM All-Star Futures Game. He began his collegiate career at NCAA Division III school Virginia Wesleyan in 2017 before transferring to Seton Hill (Pa.) and then played at Texas Tech University as a grad transfer in 2021. Monteverde was born in Pittsburgh, Pa. and attended Fox Chapel High School. He was taken in the eighth round of the 2021 First-Year Player Draft by Miami.

Rehab Report: Garrett Mitchell went 1-for-2 with a single in his 11th game on rehab assignment with the Sounds, moving his hitting streak to eight games. He is batting .310 (13-for-42) with a .408 on-base percentage and 1.051 OPS since joining Nashville on June 13. He has been on Milwaukee's injured list since the end of spring training after fracturing his left index finger in March.

Wiemer Walk: Joey Wiemer worked a pair of walks last night, logging his fourth multi-walk game in June. He's walked 23 times in 32 games and 11 in his last 12 with Nashville. Prior to June, he only had one multi-walk game through April and May.

Big Z: Entering in the fifth inning, Rob Zastryzny retired both batters faced. They were both left-handed hitters. Lefty bats are now just 3-for-39 (.077) against the southpaw this season. The veteran reliever has not allowed a hit in each of his past three appearances (3.2 IP) after giving up runs in four of five appearances between May 30-June 14.

Pat out of the 'pen: A regular starting pitcher, Chad Patrick worked three innings and allowed two runs (both earned) out of the bullpen. It was just the second time Patrick pitched out of the bullpen this season. He now ranks second in ERA, with his mark of 2.89 trailing Gwinnett's Allan Winans ERA of 2.88. Patrick also ranks among league leaders in opponent batting average (2nd, .217), win percentage (2nd, .875), WHIP (3rd, 1.14), wins (T-3rd, 7), strikeouts (T-6th, 76) and innings pitched (7th, 74.2).

Hicklen Hustle: Brewer Hicklen stole his 24th base of the season last night. He ranks fifth in the International League in stolen bases. It's the most stolen bases by a Sounds player since the 2022 season, when Brice Turang had 34 (131 G) and Esteury Ruiz had 25 (37 G).

The Sweet Life: Manager Rick Sweet is in his fourth consecutive season as the Sounds manager (5th overall) and his 34th season as a manager in MiLB. Sweet is the winningest manager in Nashville Sounds history, earning his 321st victory in the 2023 season finale vs. Jacksonville. This is his 11th season as manager of the Brewers' Triple-A affiliate and boasts a 722-622 record (Nashville in 2014, Colorado Springs from 2015-18, San Antonio in 2019 and Nashville 2021-). Overall, Sweet has a career managerial record of 2,314-2,142 - that's the fifth most wins in MiLB history and second among active managers (only Buddy Bailey with Single-A Myrtle Beach has more).

Sounds Manager Rick Sweet ranks fifth among Minor League managers in wins. He has the second-most among active managers, trailing Single-A Myrtle Beach manager Buddy Bailey.

LAST OUTING: Ashby tied a career high with seven earned runs allowed across 3.2 innings in a loss versus Durham on June 22.

AGAINST OPPONENT: Ashby has faced Jacksonville five previous times. Twice in 2021, twice again in 2023 and once this season. In the May 18 outing at Jacksonville, Ashby allowed seven hits, six earned runs and had five strikeouts in a loss. He is 0-2 overall versus the Jumbo Shrimp and has struggled in most of the outings, not pitching more than 3.2 innings in an outing before his 2024 start.
