SUNDAY: The Flying Squirrels lost to the Senators, 4-2, to close the series at FNB Field. The Senators took a 3-0 lead in the bottom of the first inning. Joe Naranjo hit an RBI single, Cayden Wallace brought in a run with a sacrifice fly and Carlos De La Cruz singled in a run. The Flying Squirrels cut the deficit to 3-2 in the top of the eighth with an RBI double by Justin Wishkoski and a sacrifice fly by Carter Howell. Jeremy De La Rosa pushed the lead to 4-2 in the bottom of the eighth.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the first of a six-game road series against the Erie SeaWolves, Double-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers. This is the first series between the two teams. The series mark's Erie's only trip to Richmond this year. The Flying Squirrels will play a six-game series at UPMC Park from June 3-8 and again from August 5-10.

PACKING THE HOUSE: Last year, the Flying Squirrels led all 30 Double-A teams in average (6,595) and total (435,295) attendance. Among the 120 MiLB teams, the Flying Squirrels were 10th in average attendance. It was the third straight year the Flying Squirrels led all 30 Double-A clubs in average and total attendance, which had not been done prior to 2022. Last year's total attendance is the highest since 2013 (434,769) and the fourth-highest average in team history. April 4 marked the 15th consecutive Opening Night sellout, marking every home opener in franchise history to date. This year, the Flying Squirrels are averaging 6,894 fans per home game, which ranks third among all 120 MiLB clubs. Their average of 7,290 in the season's first month was the highest April attendance in franchise history.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS dropped four-of-six last week in Harrisburg and were outscored 42-8 for the series. Dating back to a season-best three-game win streak from May 1-3, the Flying Squirrels are 5-5. Richmond's offense is 11th in the EL in runs scored (108) and the pitching staff is 12th in ERA (5.22). Richmond's 10-23 start is tied for the worst record through 33 games to begin a season in team history, tied with the 2016 Flying Squirrels. That year, the team went 10-24 through 34 games.

THE SEAWOLVES are tied for first place in the Southwest Division with Akron. Last week, they won the first four games of the series against the Curve before dropping the last two. Erie lead's the Eastern League in batting average (.257), runs (175), hits (273), homers (31), RBIs (161), OBP (.343), SLG (.415) and OPS (.758). The Erie pitching staff is first in the league in ERA (2.99). The Erie roster includes four players ranked in Baseball America's top-30 Tigers prospects, including C Thayron Liranza (No. 5), RHP Jayden Hamm (No. 11), RHP Troy Melton (No. 24) and OF Justice Bigbie (No. 26). MLB.com's top-30 Tigers prospect list features eight Erie players, including Liranzo (No. 5), Hamm (No. 7), Melton (No. 10), RHP Joseph Montalvo (No. 17), OF Roberto Campos (No. 20), INF Max Anderson (No. 21), Bigbie (No. 25), RHP RJ Petit (No. 28) and RHP Yosber Sanchez (No. 30).

FOR RICHMOND: Left-hander Jack Choate makes his seventh start of the season and the second of his career against the SeaWolves. He last pitched last Wednesday at Harrisburg and allowed two runs over five innings in a loss. Choate faced the SeaWolves in one other previous start, last August 29 on the road, and allowed five runs over 4.2 innings. In his last four starts since April 19, Choate is 1-0 with a 1.53 ERA (3 ER/17.2 IP). Last year, Choate spent most of the season with High-A Eugene, going 1-3 with a 2.90 ERA in 19 outings (18 starts). He was promoted to Double-A Richmond in August and made eight starts for the Flying Squirrels, posting a 1-4 record with a 5.82 ERA to close the season. Choate finished 2024 ranked first among qualified, full-season Giants minor-league pitchers in BAA (.231) and WHIP (1.21) while ranking second in ERA (3.79). Choate was selected by the Giants in the ninth round of the 2022 MLB Draft out of Assumption University. He entered 2025 ranked by Baseball America as the No. 28 Giants prospect and No. 27 by MLB.com. For more on Choate, see page two.

FOR ERIE: Right-hander Jaden Hamm makes his seventh Double-A start and his first against the Flying Squirrels. He last pitched last Tuesday against the Curve and tied his longest outing of the season, throwing five scoreless innings and allowing one hit with four strikeouts in his first Double-A win. Hamm spent the 2024 season with High-A West Michigan and went 5-4 with a 2.64 ERA in 24 games (23 starts). He is rated by Baseball America as the No. 11 Tigers prospect and No. 7 by MLB.com. Hamm was selected by the Tigers in the fifth round of the 2023 MLB Draft out of Middle Tennessee State.

DON'T RUN ON RICHMOND: The Flying Squirrels' catching unit of **Adrián Sugastey** and **Zach Morgan** have combined to throw out 20 stolen base attempts this season, which is tied for first among all 30 Double-A teams and leads the Eastern League. Sugastey is tied for first in Double-A with 11 runners caught stealing, which leads the EL. Morgan is fourth in the EL with nine.

THE BRYCE IS RIGHT: Northern Virginia native Bryce Eldridge returned to the Richmond roster on April 22 after missing the start of the season with an injury. He hit a solo home run in his first plate appearance of the year. The 20-year-old first baseman played at four levels in the Giants organization in his first full professional season last year, including nine games with Richmond in September. For the year in 116 games, Eldridge hit .291 with 23 homers and 92 RBIs. He is ranked by Baseball America as the No. 22 prospect in baseball. Eldridge is also the fifth Virginia-born player to suit up for the Flying Squirrels in franchise history. After batting .111 (1-for-9) in his first three games of the season, Eldridge is batting .286 (14-for-49) in his last 13 games. On Saturday night, Eldridge drove a two-out, three-run homer against the Senators to give the Flying Squirrels the lead in the eighth for a comeback win.

HOWELL AT THE MOON: Carter Howell opened the season batting .189 (14-for-74) in his first 20 games through April 26. In his last 12 games dating back to April 29, Howell is batting .271 (13-for-48) with three homers, two doubles, six RBIs, four walks and six runs scored. After hitting three homers in his first 136 Double-A games, he homered three times over a five-game span from during the last homestand. Last Monday, he was named Eastern League Player of the Week for the first time. In 2024, Howell was named Richmond's Player of the Year and led the Eastern League in doubles (30) and triples (7) and leading the Flying Squirrels in batting average (.272), OBP (.347), SLG (.391), OPS (.738), hits (121), runs (64) and stolen bases (15).

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: In the Eastern League, Jairo Pomares is tied for seventh in homers (5). Diego Velasquez is seventh in hits (33). Sabin Ceballos is tied for fifth in walks (19). Seth Lonsway is ninth in ERA (2.45) and sixth in BAA (.194). John Michael Bertrand is tied for first in starts (7) and eighth in innings pitched (32.0).

TOP SKIPPER: Flying Squirrels manager **Dennis Pelfrey** has led the team to 214 wins in his career, which is two away from tying the franchise's all-time wins record for a manager. From 2011-2013, **Dave Machemer** won 216 games as Richmond's manager, leading the team to the Eastern League postseason for in 2011. Pelfrey, who has been with Richmond since the 2022 season, led the team to back-to-back postseason appearances for the first time in franchise history in 2022 and 2023. He also managed the 2021 Eugene Emeralds to the High-A West championship.

PROSPECT WATCH: Richmond's roster includes seven players are ranked in Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects including Bryce Eldridge (No. 1), Joe Whitman (No. 10), Diego Velasquez (No. 13), Sabin Ceballos (No. 16), Trent Harris (No. 26), Aeverson Arteaga (No. 27) and Jack Choate (No. 28). There are also seven players ranked in MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list, including Eldridge, (No. 1), Whitman (No. 7), Harris (No. 11), Velasquez (No. 15), Arteaga (No. 16), Ceballos (No. 23) and Choate (No. 27). Eldridge is also ranked No. 22 overall by Baseball America and No. 22 by MLB.com.

THIS DATE IN RICHMOND BASEBALL HISTORY

1957: The Richmond Virginians beat the Havana Sugar Kings (Cincinnati Redlegs), 6-2, at Parker Field. Bob Martyn hit a two-run triple in a three-run third inning. Tom Carroll added a solo homer in the fourth against future Cy Young Award winner Mike Cuellar, who went by his birth name of Miguel Cuellar at that time. Jim Coates started and picked up a win to improve to 5-0 on the season, striking out seven in a complete game. It was Richmond's sixth straight win. 1983: The Richmond Braves beat the Pawtucket Red Sox, 20-0, at Parker Field. After not scoring in the first inning, the R-Braves led 18-0 through four. Pawsox starter Steve Crawford allowed nine runs, recording three outs. Richmond set a team record with 25 hits. Albert Hall drove in three runs and doubled twice. Gerald Perry had four and allowed nine runs, recording three outs. Richmond set a team record with 25 hits. Albert Hall drove in three runs and doubled twice. Gerald Perry had four hits, including three doubles, and drove in four. Paul Zuvella homered and doubled in the same inning, finishing his night with four RBIs. Brook Jacoby hit a three-run homer. Ken Dayley started and threw seven scoreless innings. 2021: The Richmond Flying Squirrels beat the Harrisburg Senators 2-0 at FNB Field in the first nine-inning no-hitter in franchise history. Matt Frisbee started and threw six perfect innings, striking out six. Joe Marciano entered in the seventh and walked the first batter he faced but retired the next five in order. Matt Seelinger recorded the final out of the eighth. Patrick Ruotolo closed out the game in the ninth. It was a team-record eighth straight win. 2022: The Richmond Flying Squirrels beat the Harrisburg Senators 6-5 in 10 innings at FNB Field. Richmond batters were hit by a pitch seven times in the game, a franchise record and the most in an Eastern League since at least 2005. Harrisburg starter Steven Fuentes hit five batters in his three-inning start. Brandon Martohit five batters in his three-inning start. Brandon Martorano drove in the go-ahead run in the top of the 10th.
