Stopping Wagner: In three games this week against the Nuts, Loons' infielder Logan Wagner has two home runs and two doubles and is 7-for-14 at the plate, hitting .500 with an OPS of 1.604. Manager Javier Godard told David Powell after Wednesday night's game, "I think slowing him down is you probably pitch him backwards and just kind of get away from the middle a little bit because he's very hot in the middle, on the heart of the plate."

Guess Who's Back? After 46 days on the Injured List, infielder Dylan Fien makes his return to the roster as of July 24. The native of Temecula, CA, was hitting .201 with an OPS of .590 in 47 games, collecting 37 hits, eight doubles, two triples and three home runs, including Lansing's only walk-off home run of the season back on May 30 against the West Michigan Whitecaps.

Gig 'Em: In the current homestand, former Texas A&M Aggie Ali Camarillo leads the Nuts on offense, hitting .400 with at least one hit in each of the past five games. Last night, he finished 2-for-4 at the plate with one run scored and one RBI, a run-scoring ground out in the first. In the month of July, Camarillo is hitting a team-best .333 among qualified hitters in 16 games.

Rotation Junction: With three Lugnuts starters promoted to start this series (**Nathan Dettmer**, **Zane Taylor**, **Ben Hansen**), the Lugnuts started **Devin Kirby** (Midwest League debut) last night; **Jorge Marcheco** (19th appearance, 2nd spot-start) tonight; and **Tucker Novotny** (24th appearance, 1st start - hasn't started since August 31, 2025) tomorrow night.

Major League Notables:

- This is the second time in franchise history that four players have vaulted from the Lugnuts to MLB in one season, joining 2023.
- There are 12 former Nuts on the Athletics' active roster: pitchers **Gage Jump**, **Luis Morales**, **Brady Basso**, **Hogan Harris** and **Jack Perkins**; infielders **Max Muncy**, **Tommy White** and **Jacob Wilson**; and outfielders **Henry Bolte**, **Lawrence Butler**, **Tyler Soderstrom** and **Colby Thomas**.
- Nine former Lugnuts have made their MLB debut this season and 209 have achieved the feat all-time, most recently **Tommy White** and **Yunior Tur**.
- **Gunnar Hoglund** (60-day), **Joshua Kuroda-Grauer** (10-day) and **Denzel Clarke** (60-day) are on the Injured List.

Lugnut All-Stars: In the 2026 Major League All-Star Game, 2017 Lugnut **Vladimir Guerrero, Jr.** was voted to started at first base for the A.L., but took the game off; 2019 Nut **Otto López** (Miami Marlins shortstop, N.L. reserve) went 1-for-2 with a single and a strikeout; and 2022 Nut **Mason Miller** (San Diego Padres closer) struck out the only batter he faced, the White Sox' Munetaka Murakami.

Cooperstown Bound: A member of the very first Lugnuts lineup on April 5, 1996, **Carlos Beltrán** went on to be voted 1999 American League Rookie of the Year, was named a nine-time All-Star, and won three Gold Gloves, two Silver Sluggers, the Roberto Clemente Hu-

JULY 24 IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2015: The Lugnuts mashed a team record 23 hits and equaled the most lopsided win in franchise history with an 18-1 cakewalk at Cooley Law School Stadium over the Dayton Dragons. The Lugnuts came three runs shy of the most runs scored in franchise history, 21 against Burlington in June 2004. If not for Aristides Aquino's home run in the ninth, they would have broken the franchise record for scoring margin to boot. Jason Leblebician had five hits and six RBIs, thanks to an RBI double in the 1st, a two-run double in the 3rd and a three-run homer in the 5th. The game began memorably: Chris Carlson led off the bottom of the 1st with a line drive down the right field line that was clearly both foul and too low to be a home run, hit off the high green wall to the right of the yellow stripe, and yet it was ruled a home run by the umpiring crew.

2019: A brutal 82-minute eighth inning in West Michigan saw two separate delays due to light-tower failures, with the Lugnuts breaking a 1-1 tie with two runs, only to allow three runs and lose 4-3. The final, tie-breaking run came in on a controversial catcher's interference call against Hagen Danner – which was immediately followed by the second lights-out delay.
