CORNIELL DOMINATES, RIDERS DROP ROCKHOUNDS FOR SIXTH WIN IN A ROW:

The Frisco RoughRiders downed the Midland RockHounds 4-2 on Saturday night at Riders Field. In the bottom of the second, Frisco (21-23, 59-53) scored on Julian Brock's RBI fielder's choice to take a 1-0 lead. The Riders continued scoring in the bottom of the third as Frainyer Chavez clubbed an RBI single to put Frisco ahead 2-0. The RoughRiders then plated two in the bottom of the sixth when Marcus Smith hit an RBI single before Jax Biggers scored on a wild pitch to increase the lead to 4-0. Midland (17-27, 56-57) got on the board in the ninth when Luke Mann sliced an RBI double before Brayan Buelvas was hit by a pitch with the bases loaded, making the score 4-2. Larson Kindreich (4-2) earned the win, pitching two scoreless innings. Braden Nett (6-5) was tagged with the loss, vielding two earned runs. vielding two earned runs.

WIN WIN AND WIN SOME MORE:

The Riders have won a season-best six-straight games and nine of their last 10 games coming into the series finale against the Rock-Hounds. During this winning streak, the Riders are first in the Texas League with a 2.17 ERA as a staff without allowing a home run. In the 10-game stretch, they are first in Double-A and second in all of Minor League Baseball with a 1.85 ERA.

THAT'S ZA-BALLGAME:

Aaron Zavala walked off the Midland RockHounds with a home run on Friday night for his first walk-off homer with the Riders and second walk-off hit. In his last 10 games, he is hitting .306 (11-for-36)/.366/.583/.949 with four doubles, two home runs, 11 RBIs, two walks, seven runs scored and one steal.

POP, POP, FIZZ, FIZZ, OH WHAT A RELIEF IT IS:Frisco's bullpen has struggled this season, but has been great to start August. In 14 games, the Riders bullpen is second in the Double-A with a 2.35 ERA while they are 7-for-11 in save opportunities.

ROTATION ROTATING:
With the RoughRiders' recent promotions of **Trey Supak** and **Ben Anderson** and the trade of **Mitch Bratt**, Frisco only has one remaining starter from the opening rotation of the year (**Josh Stephan**). Frisco's starting ERA of 3.72 in the second half is second in the Texas League, while it is 3.43 since the start of July, which is also second in the league. In the last 16 games, Frisco has a 2.24 ERA for starters which is first in the league and they're also first with a 1.99 ERA in 14 August games. **Jose Corniell** (15.2 IP, 0 ER), **Leandro Lopez** (14.1 IP, 4 ER) and **David Davalillo** (38.2 IP, 7 ER) have been incredible to start their Double-A careers.

<u>BROKEN BATS</u>:
Frisco ended their scoreless streak with **Aaron Zavala**'s two-run double in the 10th last Wednesday in Arkansas, stopping the streak at 29 consecutive innings without a run. In the first 13 games in August, Frisco has scored just 41 total runs while hitting .214/.314/.295/.609 at the plate as a team with five home runs. Zavala has scored or driven in 15 of the 41 runs in the month for

THE BOYS ARE PICKIN' IT:
The RoughRiders have been fantastic on defense this season, owning the best fielding percentage (.982) in the Texas League while committing the fewest errors (69). After committing 20 errors in the first month of the season, Frisco owns a .984 fielding percentage since May 1st, which is the third-best in Double-A. They committed two errors last Saturday, just their ninth game since May 1st committing multiple errors.

WALK IT LIKE I TALK IT:

Aaron Zavala walked twice on July 18th, collecting his 207th career walk in a RoughRiders uniform to break the all-time franchise record, previously held by **Guilder Rodriguez**. Making it much more impressive, Zavala accomplished the feat in 312 games with a 15.1 percent walk rate over four seasons (2022-2025) while Rodriguez needed 524 RoughRiders games from 2009-2015 and a 9.8

HOLD ME CLOSE AND DON'T LET GO: In their last 31 games, the RoughRiders have had the lead or a tie game in the eighth inning in 24 of the 31 games, but they are 17-14. The Riders have blown 11 saves during that span. Their bullpen ERA of 4.99 in July is last in all of Double-A and while they allowed 54 earned runs, they also surrendered 12 unearned runs.

WALLY'S WORLD:
Rangers top prospect **Sebastian Walcott** has showed off incredible consistency this season. In April, he hit .244 with a .766 OPS, in May, produced a .257 average and .811 OPS, but struggled with extra-base hits in June, hitting .239, but just a .640 OPS. This season, his walk rate of 12.2 percent is a career high while he is striking out at just 21.4 percent, a career low. This season, he is on pace for 34 steals over 124 games, which would best his prior career high of 27 last year. The only teenagers since 2005 to steal 30 or more in Double-A are **Elvis Andrus** (51, 2008), Jackson Chourio (43, 2023), Nelson Rada (35, 2024) and Mike Trout (31, 2011). Chourio was the only one on that list with 30+ stolen bases and double-digit home runs (22). Walcott participated in the Futures Game for the second season in a row over the All-Star Break, going 0-for-1 with a sacrifice fly and a groundout to shortstop while playing third base defensively.
