FRES-NOTES

TABLE-SETTER TRAFFIC: Cam Nelson has continued to find ways aboard, leading the California League with 19 walks while also pacing the league with 21 runs scored. Even without the hits fully falling yet, Nelson has turned the bottom of the order into a run-scoring lane. His patience has helped flip the lineup back to the top. Fresno has been at its best when those extra baserunners turn into pressure innings.

GRAY'S AREA: Clayton Gray has quietly become one of Fresno's hottest bats, climbing to .389 with a .488 on-base percentage and 1.016 OPS. He added three hits in Friday's win over Rancho Cucamonga, continuing a strong push during the homestand. Gray has also done damage against left-handed pitching, going 5-for-10 in those matchups. That has given Fresno another steady matchup option in the middle-to-lower half of the order.

COLE WORLD: Ethan Cole made the most of his first professional start, holding Rancho Cucamonga to one run over five innings in Friday's 10-3 win. The left-hander is now 2-0 and ranks ninth in the California League with a 4.08 ERA. He also sits tied for third in the league in innings pitched at 17.2 and fifth in WHIP at 1.19. Cole has kept opponents to a .194 average, third-best among qualified California League pitchers.

FRIDAY NIGHT LIGHTS: Fresno's 10-3 win Friday night evened the Rancho Cucamonga series and pushed the Grizzlies to 12-7 overall. The victory also moved Fresno to 6-4 at Chukchansi Park, where the offense has produced several of its biggest innings of the season. The Grizzlies drew 10,189 fans, their largest crowd of the year and the 3rd largest in all of MiLB this season. It was Fresno's second double-digit scoring game at home this season.
