**AGAINST OPPONENT:** Hall has faced Durham five times but only once with Nashville. In his start on June 20, he went 1.1 innings, zero runs, two walks and one strikeout. In his four appearances (two starts) against the Bulls while with Norfolk, he gave up two earned runs in 9.0 total innings.

- Started the season of the Opening Day roster
  Went 0-1, with a 7.71 ERA (16.1 IP/14 ER) in four starts in March and April before being placed on the 15-day injured list on April 21 due to a left
- knee sprain
