**Tonight's Game:** The Sounds and Bulls wrap up their six-game series this afternoon at Durham Bulls Athletic Park. Durham has already clinched the series with wins in four of the first five games. Left-hander DL Hall makes his return with the Sounds with the start and will face off against left-hander Antonio Jimenez.

**DL Hall:** The 25-year-old left-hander makes his 13th start for the Sounds this season. He started the season with the Brewers and made four starts before being sidelined with an injury at the end of April. He was successful in his long rehab stint with Nashville, posting a 2.87 ERA (31.1 IP/10 ER) before being called up to Milwaukee for a start on August 11. In that game, he went 4.2 innings with three runs allowed (one earned) and a season-high nine strikeouts. It was the most strikeouts he has had in an MLB appearance in his career. The Valdosta, Georgia native was drafted in the first round by the Orioles in 2017. He was notably acquired along with Joey Ortiz in exchange for Corbin Burnes before the season. He entered the season as the fifth-best prospect in the Brewers organization. Used mainly as a reliever in the big leagues, five of his six career MLB starts have come this season after he had 28 relief appearances for Baltimore in 2022-23.

**Antonio Jimenez:** The 22-year-old left-hander makes his 12th appearance (1st start) for the Bulls this season. He has been up and down from Double-A Montgomery where he had 22 appearances for the Biscuits. Overall this season, Jimenez is 3-0 with a 4.05 ERA (46.2 IP/21 ER) and 40 strikeouts. He has 41 career starts among his 132 outings with his last start coming on June 7, 2023, at Pensacola. He worked predominately as a starter during the 2022 season for Charleston. His season high in innings was 3.0 IP on July 12 vs. Tennessee and he has thrown over 40 pitches just four times in 2024. The San Pedro De Macoris, Dominican Republic native was signed as a free agent by the Rays in 2018. With Jimenez not expected to last long, a plethora of Bulls relievers will be used. The Durham bullpen ranks 17th out of 20 teams in the International League in ERA (5.09) and has the second most innings (560.1 IP). But the Bulls relievers have given up just two earned runs in 26.2 innings during the series.

**A Pirates Life for Me:** Craig Yoho has been filthy this season for Biloxi and Nashville. With two more scoreless innings, he has not allowed an earned run in 17 consecutive outings. During the stretch, he has pitched 20.1 innings and has 39 strikeouts. In 47.1 innings overall, he has a remarkable 90 strikeouts which is tied for second in the minor leagues this season. He has especially been great against righties, striking out 56 of the 108 right-handed batters he has faced with a .121 opponent batting average.

**Bombs Away:** Wes Clarke hit his 11th homer as a Sound in the sixth inning last night. His homer extended his on-base streak to 15 games which is tied for the fourth longest by a Sound this season. It is the second consecutive night with a Clarke home run and has only hit a homer in three straight one time in his career (August 1-3, 2023 at Pensacola). He has been trending upwards in August, slashing .258 (8-for-31) with a .891 OPS. Eight of his 11 home runs for Nashville have been in Road games and his blast last night was his first in a weekend game this season.

**Reliever>Starter:** Evan McKendry limited the damage last night with 3.1 innings and two runs (one earned) out of the pen last night. Though he had a rough few outings recently, he still has a 2.68 ERA (37.0 IP/11 ER) as a reliever. This is much better than his ERA of 7.97 (35.0 IP/31 ER) as a starter.

**Future Brew Crew:** The Sounds currently have four of the top 30 Brewers prospects, per MLB Pipeline. They are RHP Jacob Misiorowski (No. 3), RHP Logan Henderson (No. 10), RHP Craig Yoho (No. 20), and RHP Carlos Rodriguez (No. 21). Misiorowski is also No. 66 on the MLB Top 100 prospect list.

**The Sweet Life:** Manager Rick Sweet is in his fourth consecutive season as the Sounds manager (5th overall) and his 34th season as a manager in MiLB. Sweet is the winningest manager in Nashville Sounds history, earning his 321st victory in the 2023 season finale vs. Jacksonville. This is his 11th season as manager of the Brewers' Triple-A affiliate and boasts a 744-640 record (Nashville in 2014, Colorado Springs from 2015-18, San Antonio in 2019 and Nashville 2021-). Overall, Sweet has a career managerial record of 2,336-2,160 - that's the fifth most wins in MiLB history and second among active managers (only Buddy Bailey with Single-A Myrtle Beach has more).

Sounds Manager Rick Sweet ranks fifth among Minor League managers in wins. He has the second-most among active managers, trailing Single-A Myrtle Beach manager Buddy Bailey.

**LAST OUTING:** Hall made his first start for the Brewers since April 20. He allowed three runs (one earned) in 4.2 innings.

**AGAINST OPPONENT:** Hall has faced Durham five times but only once with Nashville. In his start on June 20, he went 1.1 innings, zero runs, two walks and one strikeout. In his four appearances (two starts) against the Bulls while with Norfolk, he gave up two earned runs in 9.0 total innings.

### 2024 SEASON HIGHLIGHTS:

- Started the season of the Opening Day roster
- Went 0-1, with a 7.71 ERA (16.1 IP/14 ER) in four starts in March and April before being placed on the 15-day injured list on April 21 due to a left knee sprain
- Tweaked knee injury fielding a ground ball in rehab start vs. Charlotte... moved to the 60-day injured list on June 8 with a left knee sprain

- Entered the season as the fifth-best prospect in the Orioles organization according to Baseball America
