YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels beat the Rumble Ponies, 8-4, to open the series. **Luis Toribio** opened the scoring with a two-run homer in the second inning. In the top of the third, Nick Lorusso hit a solo homer to cut the score to 2-1. In the bottom of the inning, **Jairo Pomares** reached on a fielding error to score **Wade Meckler**, pushing the score to 3-1. Toribio hit a solo homer in the fifth, his second of the game, to stretch the lead to 4-1. Later in the inning, Meckler and Pomares hit RBI singles and an additional run scored on an error to open a 7-1 lead. Binghamton cut the score to 7-3 in the sixth with RBI singles by Ryan Clifford and Kevin Parada. Matt Rudick hit an RBI single in the seventh to pull the Rumble Ponies within three runs. In the bottom of the eighth, Toribio hit an RBI double to move the Flying Squirrels ahead by four. He finished the game with a season-high four RBIs. Richmond relievers **Kyle Cody**, **Jose Cruz** and **Mat Olsen** did not allow an earned run over 3.2 innings of work. **Dylan Cumming** allowed three runs over 5.1 innings to pick up his first Double-A win.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels face the Binghamton Rumble Ponies, Double-A affiliate of the New York Mets, in the second of a six-game series at The Diamond. This is the only series between the two teams this season. This week marks the Rumble Ponies' first trip to Richmond since August 17-21, 2022, which was a series split. The Flying Squirrels played six games in Binghamton last May and went 1-5. The Flying Squirrels have gone 16-12 against teams from the Northeast Division this season and Binghamton is 14-19 against teams from the Southwest Division on the year.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have gone 2-5 in their last seven games dating back to July 13 after winning each of their previous four games. For the year, the Flying Squirrels are hitting .228 and averaging 3.83 runs per game (175 runs/46 games) at home compared to a .235 batting average and 4.71 runs per game on the road (212 runs/45 games). The Flying Squirrels are 11-5 in their last 16 road games since June 12. Richmond is 6-14 in its last 20 home games dating back to June 6.

THE RUMBLE PONIES had won 10 straight games prior to dropping their last three, including the final two games of last weekend's series against the SeaWolves on Saturday and Sunday. After finishing tied for second in the Northeast Division in the first half, the Rumble Ponies are currently tied for second place in the division in the second half. Binghamton's roster includes seven of Baseball America's top-30 Mets prospects, including RHP Brandon Sproat (No. 6), RHP Nolan McLean (No. 7), OF Ryan Clifford (No. 8), C Kevin Parada (No. 16), OF Alex Ramirez (No. 20), RHP Tyler Stuart (No. 22) and INF Rowdey Jordan (No. 30). There are five Binghamton players on MLB.com's top-30 Mets prospects list, including Clifford (No. 3), C Kevin Parada (No. 9), Ramirez (No. 15), Stuart (No. 17) and McLean (No. 18).

FOR RICHMOND: Left-hander **John Michael Bertrand** makes his 19th start of the season and the first of his career against Binghamton. He last pitched on Friday at Akron and allowed one run over six innings. He has gone 3-0 with a 0.75 ERA (2 ER/24.0 IP) in his four July starts. On the season, he has made eight scoreless starts, all at least five innings, which is the most in the Eastern League. Bertrand has the highest groundball percentage (53.2%) and has induced the most double plays (13) in the league this year. He also ranked second in the EL in innings pitched (100.2), fifth in ERA (3.22), seventh in WHIP (1.18) and eighth in HR/9 (0.72). Bertrand has been named the Eastern League Pitcher of the Week twice this year, first for throwing seven perfect innings against the Baysox on April 27 and then for working six hitless innings in Bowie on May 23. Last season, he climbed three levels, working from Low-A San Jose to High-A Eugene before joining Double-A Richmond in July for the remainder of the season. For the year, he led all qualified Giants minor league pitchers in winning percentage (.688) and ranked second in ERA (3.65), second in wins (11), tied for second in WHIP (1.23), third in innings pitched (118.1) and fourth in BAA (.248). Entering 2024, Bertrand was rated by Baseball America as having the best control in the Giants system. Bertrand began his collegiate career at Furman University in South Carolina before playing his final two seasons at the University of Notre Dame. He was selected by the Giants in the 10th round of the 2022 MLB Draft. **For more on Bertrand, see page two.**

FOR BINGHAMTON: Right-hander Tyler Stuart makes his 17th start of the year. Today marks his first start since July 14 at New Hampshire, when he allowed two runs (one earned) over four innings. After starting the year 1-5 with a 5.02 ERA (29 ER/52. IP) in his first 11 starts through June 12, Stuart has gone 1-2 with a 2.42 ERA (7 ER/26.0 IP) in his last five starts since June 18. Stuart was selected by the Mets in the sixth round of the 2022 MLB Draft out of the University of Southern Mississippi. He first reached Double-A last July. Between Binghamton and High-A Brooklyn, Stuart went 7-2 with a 2.20 ERA in 21 starts, earning a pick as an MiLB.com Mets Organization All-Star following the season.

DOUBLE TROUBLE: The Flying Squirrels turned three double plays on Friday night. It was the third time this season the Richmond defense has recorded three double plays. On the season, Richmond leads the Eastern League with 64 double plays turned. For the year, the Flying Squirrels have turned 13 double plays with **John Michael Bertrand** pitching, which is the most in the league. The three double plays induced by Bertrand on Friday were tied for the most by a pitcher in a game this season in the Eastern League.

RETURN OF THE MECK: In his three games with Richmond this year, **Wade Meckler** has picked up five hits, batting .417 (5-for-12). He first reached the Flying Squirrels last season and batted .336 (50-for-149) over 39 games, which was the third-highest average in the league (min. 170 PA) for the year. He hit .371 (115-for-310) in the minors last year, which was the highest in MiLB (min. 350 PA). It was the second straight year that a Flying Squirrels player led the minors in batting average, with **Vaun Brown** topping the charts (min. 350 PA) with a .346 average in 2022.

GLOW SHOW: Since June 29, **Jimmy Glownke** is batting .304 (17-for-56) with two homers, seven doubles and nine RBIs over 17 games. In that span, he has picked up three hits three times, including Friday's series opener at Akron. Last season, Glownke hit .155 (11-for-71) in his first 21 Double-A games from May 31-June 30 before batting .290 (51-for-176) in his final 54 regular-season games from July 1-September 17.

BERICOTO BASHING: In his last 34 games dating back to June 6, **Victor Bericoto** is hitting .324 (45-for-139) with three homers, eight doubles, seven walks and 17 RBIs. After leading the Giants organization in homers (27) last year, Bericoto hit just one homer in his first 34 games this season through May 21. From May 22-28, he homered three times in five games. He went deep again on June 14 at New Hampshire and added a homer on June 18 at Portland, but he has not homered in his last 24 games. In his last 44 games since May 22, Bericoto is batting .310 (53-for-171) with six homers, nine doubles, 13 walks and 26 RBIs. Bericoto has picked up multiple hits in 12-of-26 games dating back to June 15 and is batting .327 (34-for-104) in that stretch.

SCORELESS WORK FROM SILVA: Reliever **Eric Silva** has thrown eight consecutive appearances dating back to June 19 without allowing a run, spanning 10.2 innings. He has 15 strikeouts in that time frame. That span has lowered his season ERA from 6.41 to 4.58. Since throwing an immaculate inning on June 9 against the Curve, Silva has gone 3-0 with a 1.26 ERA (2 ER/14.1 IP) with 20 strikeouts and four walks. Earlier this season, Silva threw six consecutive scoreless outings from May 1-21, spanning 9.2 innings with 10 strikeouts. Over his next six outings prior to his current scoreless streak, he posted a 10.38 ERA (10 ER/8.2 IP) from May 26-June 14.

PACKING THE HOUSE: The Flying Squirrels drew an average of 7,113 fans in April for their home games at The Diamond to open the season, their highest April average in franchise history. The previous high was 6,891 in 2014 followed by 6,571 in 2019. This season, the Flying Squirrels are leading all 30 Double-A teams and are ranked eighth among the 120 minor league clubs in average home attendance (6,671), just shy of the highest average attendance in franchise history (6,689 in 2013).

PROSPECT WATCH: Four of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects are on the Richmond roster, including OF **Wade Meckler** (No. 12), RHP **Trevor McDonald** (No. 17), RHP **Eric Silva** (No. 21) and SS **Diego Velasquez** (No. 26). On Baseball America's Best Tools list, Meckler is rated the best hitter for average and best strike-zone discipline and LHP **John Michael Bertrand** is rated as having the best control. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list features five Richmond players, including McDonald (No. 12), Meckler (No. 16), Velasquez (No. 18), OF/1B **Victor Bericoto** (No. 19) and OF **Jairo Pomares** (No. 26).

BOULEVARD TO THE BAY: This season, 10 former Flying Squirrels players have reached the majors for the first time. That is tied for the second-most in a season in franchise history. Last year also saw 10 former Flying Squirrels players debut in the big leagues, including a team-record five from that season's Richmond roster. In 2014, a team-record 11 alumni made their MLB debuts, including **Joe Panik**, **Adam Duvall**, **Andrew Susac**, **Matt Duffy**, **Jackson Williams**, **Edwin Escobar**, **Hunter Strickland**, **Chris Dominguez**, **Gary Brown**, **Brett Bochy** and **Chris Heston**. The Flying Squirrels alumni to debut in the majors this season are **Erik Miller** (2023 Flying Squirrels), **Landen Roupp** (2022-23), **Kai-Wei Teng** (2022-23), **Nick Avila** (2022), **Randy Rodriguez** (2022-23), **Mason Black** (2023), **Gerson Garabito** (2021), **Spencer Bivens** (2023), **Raymond Burgos** (2023) and **Hayden Birdsong** (2023-24). Dating back to 2022, 20-of-the-last-21 Flying Squirrels alumni who have reached the majors have debuted with the San Francisco Giants, with Garabito (Rangers) being the only exception.

Ricardo Genovés hit a three-run homer to close the score to 6-3 in the third. In the sixth, Brett Auerbach hit a solo homer and Jacob Heyward drove a two-run shot to tie the game, 6-6. Diego Rincones hit a go-ahead single in the seventh. The six-run deficit tied the team record for the largest come-from-behind win in team history.
