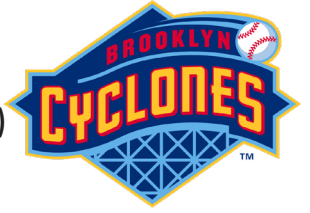

LAST TIME OUT: Brooklyn outlasted Asheville in a topsy-turvy, 13-12, 10-inning marathon on Thursday night...Cyclones erased a 4-run deficit, trailing 7-3 after 3 innings...Game featured 3 lead changes from the 7th inning on...Brooklyn went ahead 8-7 in the 7th on a C **Kevin Parada** 2-run home run...Asheville took the lead, 9-8, in the 8th on a 2-run broken bat single by CF **Jacob Melton**...Cyclones went in front, 10-9, on a 2-run knock to left by 3B **William Lugo** with 2 out in the top of the 9th...Tourists tied it on a 2B **Kobe Kato** single with 2 out in the bottom half...Brooklyn scored 3 in the top of the 10th to win on a CF **Rhylan Thomas** single, a C **Christian Pregent** sacrifice fly, and LF **Omar De Los Santos** scoring on an attempted double steal of home...Game featured a combined 25 runs and 27 hits with 6 home runs...17-of-19 players that had at least 1 at-bat picked up at least 1 hit in the game.

LAST TRAIN RUNNING: Brooklyn scored a then-season-high 12 runs in Wednesday's 12-5 victory over Asheville and surpassed it with a 13-run performance in Thursday's 13-12 triumph in 10 frames...The Cyclones' previous high water mark was 11 on 2 separate occasions...Brooklyn bested Wilmington, 11-7, on both July 27 and 30 at Maimonides Park...The 13 runs scored are the most for the 'Clones since they scored 18 runs in an 18-1 win at Jersey Shore on August 28, 2022...RF **Stanley Consuegra** homered in both Wednesday's contest and the game on 8/28/22...The 25 combined runs over a 2-game period are the most for Brooklyn since scoring 26 between August 27-28, 2022, at Jersey Shore...The Cyclones beat the BlueClaws, 8-3, on August 27, and then throttled Jersey Shore, 18-1, on August 28.

THE HITS KEEP COMING: Brooklyn and Asheville united for 25 runs in the Cyclones' 13-12 win in 10 innings on Thursday night...The 25 tallies are the most combined runs in a single game for the 'Clones in 2023...It is tied for the 3rd-largest combined score in a South Atlantic League game this season...Aberdeen won at Greensboro, 16-14, in 9 innings on July 5, for a total ledger of 30 runs...The 25 combined runs were the most in a single game featuring Brooklyn since May 27, 2022...The Cyclones and Bowling Green Hot Rods united to scratch across 26 runs in Brooklyn's 20-6 victory.

HOMER HAPPY: The Cyclones tied a season-high with 4 home runs in Thursday's win at Asheville...RF **Stanley Consuegra** clubbed a 455-foot solo home run to center in the 2nd, DH **Ryan Clifford** tacked on a 2-run blast to right-center in the 3rd, LF **Omar De Los Santos** added a 2-run clout to left in the 4th, and C **Kevin Parada** smashed a 2-run blast to right-center in the 7th...Brooklyn also blasted 4 long balls in a 6-1 win vs. Hudson Valley on June 23...Parada homered twice, while 3B **William Lugo** and LF **Jaylen Palmer** went deep, as well...The Cyclones had smashed 8 home runs in the first 3 games of the series, scoring 34 total runs...Brooklyn has not clubbed that many round-trippers in a 3-game span since they walloped 10 between May 27-29 at Bowling Green, tallying 31 total runs.

WALK IT OUT: Brooklyn's 10 walks on Wednesday were the most for the squad in a 9-inning game this season...The Cyclones earned 12 free passes in an 11-inning, 9-8 win vs. Jersey Shore on Opening Day, April 7...The 10 walks were the most for Brooklyn in a 9-inning game since August 28, 2022, at Jersey Shore...LF **Rhylan Thomas** earned 4 walks in Wednesday's victory tying 3B **Jaylen Palmer** for the most by a Cyclone in a single game this year...Palmer accomplished the feat in Brooklyn's 9-8, 11-inning Opening Day win vs. Jersey Shore...The 4 free passes were the most by a Cyclone in a 9-inning game since 2B **Nic Gaddis** walked 4 times in a 10-3 win at Jersey Shore on July 22, 2022...Since Minor League Baseball's stat portal began in 2005, no Brooklyn player has walked more than 4 times in a single game.

HE'S THE HOME RUN KING: OF **Stanley Consuegra** broke a tie with C **Francisco Álvarez** for the franchise record in career home runs by blasting his 23rd with Brooklyn in the top of the 5th on Wednesday night...He added another blast on Thursday and is 3 home runs (19) behind Álvarez (22) for the single-season home run mark...Consuegra has homered in each of the first 3 games of the series in Asheville, tying SS **Jett Williams** (8/19-22) for the most consecutive games with a round-tripper this year...The multi-home run night marked the 2nd of the season for Consuegra...Stanley tallied a pair of solo blasts in a 6-4 loss at Hudson Valley on July 19...He and C **Kevin Parada** (6/23 vs. HV & 7/15 vs. GBO) are the only 2 players to post multi-homer contests for Brooklyn in 2023...Since the Minor League stat portal began in 2005, Consuegra and Parada are just 2-of-3 Cyclones to post multiple 2-plus home run games...INF **Nick Evans** accomplished the feat in 2005 on July 22 vs. Jamestown and again on August 24 at Williamsport...Entering Friday, Consuegra is tied for 3rd in the SAL in home runs (19) and 5th in slugging percentage (.479).

JETT THE MET: INFs **Jett Williams** made his Cyclones debut on August 1 and has been stellar all summer long...Since returning from the All-Star break on July 14, the 19-year-old is slashing .345/.490/.630 with a 1120 OPS, 26 runs scored, 12 doubles, 2 triples, 6 home runs, 17 RBI, 33 walks, and 15 stolen bases in 34 games between Brooklyn and Single-A St. Lucie...Since that date, no player in Minor League Baseball (min. 150 PA) has a higher on-base percentage (.490) or OPS (1.120)...On the season, Williams is 10th in Minor League Baseball in walks (87)...Among teenagers, Williams ranks 2nd in MiLB...Since making his SAL debut, the Rockwall, Texas, native has led the circuit (min. 80 PA) in batting average (.342), on-base percentage (.474), OPS (1.079), and doubles (8)...He is also tied for 1st in extra-base hits (12), 2nd in hits (26) and stolen bases (9), and tied for 2nd in walks (18)...Among SAL players with at least 90 plate appearances in 2023, Williams is 2nd in the circuit in OBP (.474), 4th in walk rate (18.9%), 5th in wRC+ (191) and wOBA (.479), and 6th in OPS (1.079).

DOWN THE STRETCH THEY COME: Brooklyn's looking to manufacture a second-straight playoff appearance and has dropped just 2 of their last 9 series since Greenville won 4-of-6 on Coney Island from June 6-11...The Cyclones are 6-2-2 in their last 10 sets...The Cyclones are 30-21 in the second half and are tied with Jersey Shore (30-21) atop the North Division of the SAL with 15 games left to play...The BlueClaws hold the tiebreaker over Brooklyn as a result of winning the season series (15-11).

vs. ASHEVILLE: Brooklyn begins a 2-week road trip with 6 games against the Astros' High-A affiliate...The Tourists possess 4 of Houston's top 30 prospects per *Baseball America*: OF **Jacob Melton** (1), RHP **Miguel Ullola** (13), OF **Zach Cole** (18), RHP **Nolan DeVos** (24)...Brooklyn and Asheville are meeting for the second time in each franchise's history...Both squads met at McCormick Field to open the 2021 season...The Tourists took 3-of-5 games in the series from May 4-9...The final game of that series was canceled due to weather.

CLIFF NOTES: OF **Ryan Clifford** was added to Brooklyn's roster on August 3...The 20-year-old was acquired by the New York Mets with OF **Drew Gilbert** from the Houston Astros in exchange for RHP **Justin Verlander** on August 1...The 2022 11th-round pick enters Friday ranked 3rd in the South Atlantic League in slugging percentage (.502) and tied for 3rd in home runs (19)...He is also 5th in OPS (.846)...Clifford is also 1st in isolated power (.251), and 7th in wOBA (.375) and wRC+ (126).

THE RHY-T STUFF: In 34 games since July 4 at Wilmington, OF **Rhylan Thomas** has put up bonkers numbers...He is slashing .360/.435/.456 with a .891 OPS at the dish and a 149 wRC+...Thomas has added 16 runs scored, 5 doubles, 2 home runs, 16 RBI, and 16 walks (12.2 BB%) to only 8 strikeouts (6.1 K%)...Since the start of July, Thomas has led the South Atlantic League in batting average (.350) and has 7 fewer strikeouts (9) than any other batter (min. 135 PA)...He is also 2nd in on-base percentage (.430).

YO-JOANDER: RHP **Joander Suárez** continues to hit his stride after returning from Tommy John surgery in June of 2021...With his 7 strikeouts vs. Hudson Valley on Friday night, the Cumaná, Venezuela native is now tied with RHP **Blade Tidwell** for the franchise single-season record in strikeouts with 112...Tidwell set the mark earlier this season...The 23-year-old set a new career-high with 11 strikeouts over 6.0 innings in a shutout victory vs. Aberdeen last Friday night...Over his last 11 appearances (10 starts) since June 14 at Aberdeen, Suárez holds only a 3-5 record, but a 3.73 ERA (21 ER in 50.2 IP), 15 walks (7.1 BB%), and 73 strikeouts (34.4 K%)...Narrowed down to his last 7 starts, the Cumaná, Venezuela native is 1-4, yet holds a 3.16 ERA (13 ER in 37.0 IP) with 8 walks (5.2 BB%) and 54 strikeouts (35.1 K%)...Since the start of July, Suárez is tied for 2nd among SAL pitchers in strikeouts (57) trailing only Greensboro's RHP **Thomas Harrington** (59).

BEST IN SHOW: Since the start of a 4-game winning streak at Hudson Valley on May 17, the Cyclones' pitching staff has, statistically, been one of the most dominant in Minor League Baseball...Entering Friday, Brooklyn has posted a 3.39 ERA (281 ER in 745.1 IP) over their last 85 games, holding a 47-38 record in that span, which is good for 2nd-lowest in the minors...The Rangers' Single-A Down East (3.38) leads MiLB...The Cyclones have hurled 9 shutouts — which is tied for 3rd in MiLB — in that span...Additionally, Brooklyn pitching holds the 3rd lowest hits-per-9 innings (7.20) and batting average against (.216), in addition to the 4th lowest opposing OPS (.641) in that period.

THE AMAZING ALEX: OF **Alex Ramírez** is scattered among the Cyclones' all-time leaderboard despite joining the team last July 4...Entering Thursday, the Dominican native is 2nd in franchise history in RBI and is 6 (85) behind INF **José Peroza** (91) for the all-time mark...He surpassed Peroza for 1st in doubles (37), is 2nd in total bases (232), hits (158), and walks (69), and 3rd in runs scored (83)...Ramírez is 4 hits behind Peroza (162) for the franchise record.

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: *Baseball America* released their updated list of Top 30 New York Mets' prospects last Wednesday...10 members of the 2023 squad are featured...OF **Ryan Clifford** (No. 3), SS **Jett Williams** (4), C **Kevin Parada** (7), RHP **Blade Tidwell** (9), RHP **Christian Scott** (10), OF **Alex Ramírez** (12), 3B **Jacob Reimer** (14), RHP **Tyler Stuart** (22), RHP **Raimon Gómez** (24), and RHP **Jordany Ventura** (29)...Williams (No. 98) and Clifford (99) also appear on the publication's list of Top 100 prospects...Former Cyclones listed include INF **Ronny Mauricio** (No. 6), RHP **Mike Vasil** (8), RHP **Dominic Hamel** (19), OF **Matt Rudick** (20), and RHP **Junior Santos** (27)...In all, 15-of-30 members of BA's Top 30 have experience playing on Coney Island...MLB Pipeline released their updated list last Thursday evening...8 members of the 2023 team are recognized...SS **Jett Williams** (No. 3), C **Kevin Parada** (5), OF **Ryan Clifford** (6), RHP **Blade Tidwell** (10), OF **Alex Ramírez** (11), RHP **Christian Scott** (12), IF **Jacob Reimer** (13), RHP **Tyler Stuart** (17), and RHP **Raimon Gómez** (25)...Former Brooklyn stars featured are: IF **Ronny Mauricio** (No. 4), RHP **Mike Vasil** (9), RHP **Dominic Hamel** (16), and OF **Matt Rudick** (27)...Williams (No. 84), Mauricio (93), and Parada (96) are recognized in the Top 100.

DE RECORD SETTER: OF **Omar De Los Santos** entered as a pinch-runner and caught Hudson Valley napping to steal second base on July 21, giving him 33 stolen bases in 2023...The current 36 swipes breaks INF **Walter Rasquin**'s franchise record for single-season stolen bases (32) which was set back in 2017 when Brooklyn played in the short-season New York-Penn League...He is also 4th in the SAL in stolen bases for 2023...De Los Santos remains among the best base stealers in Minor League Baseball since the beginning of 2022...The Dominican native has accumulated 105 stolen bases in that span, which is 7th most in MiLB...Only Red Sox prospect INF **David Hamilton** (118), Mariners farmhand OF **Jonathan Clásé** (117), D'Backs prospect OF **Wilderd Patiño** (115), Aberdeen OF **Luis Valdez** (114), Marlins farmhand INF **Nasim Núñez** (113), and Cardinals prospect OF **Mike Antico** (111) have tallied more...De Los Santos has also snagged 57 more bases than any other Mets prospect in that time...Fellow 2023 Cyclone IF/OF **Jaylen Palmer** is 2nd with 49.

LAST TIME OUT: Did not receive a decision last Friday night vs. Hudson Valley...Permitted 4 runs on 7 hits over 4.0 innings...Did not walk a batter and struck out 7...Charged with a balk...Tossed 83 pitches and 56 strikes (67.5%)...Relieved by RHP **Jace Beck** to start the top of the 5th inning and Brooklyn trailing 4-2...Cyclones scored 5 runs in the bottom of the 5th capped with a go-ahead 3-run home run by RF **Stanley Consuegra**...Brooklyn went on to win, 8-5.

YO-JOANDER: Suárez continues to hit his stride after returning from Tommy John surgery in June of 2021...With his 7 strikeouts vs. Hudson Valley last Friday night, the Cumaná, Venezuela native is now tied with RHP **Blade Tidwell** for the franchise single-season record in strikeouts with 112...Tidwell set the mark earlier this season...The 23-year-old set a new career-high with 11 strikeouts over 6.0 innings in a shutout victory vs. Aberdeen on August 11...Over his last 11 appearances (10 starts) since June 14 at Aberdeen, Suárez holds only a 3-5 record, but a 3.73 ERA (21 ER in 50.2 IP), 15 walks (7.1 BB%), and 73 strikeouts (34.4 K%)...Narrowed down to his last 7 starts, the Cumaná, Venezuela native is 1-4, yet holds a 3.16 ERA (13 ER in 37.0 IP) with 8 walks (5.2 BB%) and 54 strikeouts (35.1 K%)...Since the start of July, Suárez ranks 2nd among SAL pitchers in strikeouts (57) trailing only Greensboro's RHP **Thomas Harrington** (59).

PROSPECT RADAR: While not currently ranked, Suárez was deemed the Mets' No. 30 prospect entering the 2022 season by *Baseball America*...Considered the No. 25 farmhand entering 2021.

2022: Placed on Single-A St. Lucie's 60-day injured list to start the season...Sent on a rehab assignment with the Florida Complex League Mets on August 12...Tallied a 1-1 record with a 3.97 ERA (5 ER in 11.1 IP) and 12 strikeouts in 6 games (3 starts)...Returned to St. Lucie on August 23...Registered an 0-2 mark with a 7.20 ERA (8 ER in 10.0 IP) and 13 K's in 4 appearances (2 starts).

COMEBACK TRAIL: Suárez is participating in his first full season since the 2019 campaign...The 23-year-old made 6 starts with Single-A St. Lucie in 2021 before undergoing Tommy John surgery in June...Made his return to play in game one of a doubleheader with the FCL Mets vs. the FCL Cardinals on July 14, 2022.
