JUMBO SHRIMP POWER BY SOUNDS 7-5

Lewin Díaz and Nick Fortes each popped two-run home runs to help Jacksonville beat Nashville 7-5. Both two-run shots for the Jumbo Shrimp came in the first inning, but the Sounds plated two in the fifth and two in the sixth to tie the game. Jacksonville regained the lead in the bottom of the sixth when Lorenzo Quintana scampered home on a wild pitch. Charles Leblanc registered an RBI double and Díaz added an RBI single in the seventh to widen the gap. A Nashville run in the ninth got things to 7-5, but the Sounds left the tying runs on base to end the game.

TO THE MAX

Max Meyer makes the start on Thursday against Nashville, and the University of Minnesota product is hoping to continue an outstanding beginning to his season. Among the 270 pitchers in the International League with at least 10.0 innings pitched this season. Mever owns the circuit's 24th-highest swinging-strike rate (16.5 percent), helping him strike out 31.5 percent of opposing hitters thus far, a figure that ranks 42nd in the IL, and post a 24.2 K-BB%, which ranks 31st. When opponents do put the ball in play, Meyer has registered the IL's 37th-highest ground ball rate (56.3 percent) and 39th-lowest fly ball rate (25.4 percent). Consequently, Meyer is 14th in the league in FIP (2.04) while placing 18th in xFIP (2.98).

SIX & DIP

Heading into play on Thursday, Jacksonville has scored at least six runs in 15 of their last 24 games, and 17 of the club's 32 contests (53.1 percent) this year. In 2021, the Jumbo Shrimp mustered at least six tallied in only 48 of their 130 games (36.9 percent). When scoring at least six runs this year, Jacksonville is 15-2 (.882).

ROAD IS WHERE THE HEART IS

Jacksonville boasts a 12-6 record on the road thus far in 2022, marking one of just two teams in the IL East with a winning record away from home. Interestingly, the Jumbo Shrimp have hit far better on the road, posting a team batting line of .299/.368/.516. The club's resulting .884 OPS places second in Triple-A. When playing at 121 Financial Ballpark, Jacksonville is hitting .239/.335/.391, with the club's .

BLEDAY OF THE DEAD

Over the season's first 18 games. Jacksonville outfielder JJ Bleday struggled, going just 10-for-63 at the plate with two doubles and two home runs for a measly batting line of .159/.321/.286/.607. However, over the last 12 games, Bleday is 14-for-43 with three doubles and four home runs, slashing .326/.453/.674/1.127. Including a nine-game hitting streak from April 28-May 7, Bleday has reached base at least once in 11 of his last 12 contests. Among the 124 qualified hitters in the IL. Bleday has posted the third-highest fly ball rate (56.9 percent), eighth-lowest ground ball rate (29.2 percent) and 10th-lowest line drive rate (13.9 percent).

CHARLES LE MAGNIFIQUE

Charles Leblanc has reached base in 16 consecutive games (13-for-59, .373/.422/.542/.964, 4 2B, 2 HR, 12 RBIs, 7 R), the longest such streak in the International League this season. The Laval. Quebic City native has reached base safely in 26 of his 28 games on the year, with multiple trips on in 16 of those contests. On the season, Leblanc leads the International League in OPS (1.079) and ranks second in batting average (.381), third in OBP (.450), fourth in hits (40), sixth in slugging (.629), tied for sixth in RBIs (24) and tied for 12th in extra-base hits (14) Among the 124 qualified hitters in the circuit, Leblanc leads the league in both wOBA (.469) and wRC+ (187).

THIS CUBAN IS CRUSHING MISSILES

Over his last 16 games, Lorenzo Quintana has gone 22-for-64 at the plate, slashing .344/.417/.734/1.151 with seven doubles, six home runs, 18 RBIs and 16 runs scored. This hot stretch has pushed Quintana up in the top 20 of the league in OPS (5th; 1.033), slugging (7th; .628), home runs (T-8th; 7), extra-base hits (T-10th; 15), batting average (12th; .319), RBIs (T-13th; 22), doubles (T-15th; 8), hits (T-16th; 30) and runs (T-16th; 20). Of the 132 qualified hitters in the IL, Quintana has posted the fifth-lowest strikeout rate (12.5%). He places fifth in both wOBA (.430) and wRC+ (162).

	ABOUT MAX					

-Selected by the Marlins with the third overall pick of the 2020 draft, Meyer tied Hall of Famer Paul Molitor (No. 3 to the Milwaukee Brewers in 1977) as the highest pick in Minnesota Golden Gophers history. Meyer is one of four Minnesotans to be pick in the top five in the draft, along with Molitor, Joe Mauer and Dave Winfield. Prior to Meyer, the last time the Gophers had a pitcher taken in the first round of the MLB draft was left-hander Glen Perkins, who was selected 22nd overall by the Minnesota Twins in 2004.

-During his junior season at Minnesota in 2020, Meyer was tabbed as a consensus Preseason All-American and made four starts in a shortned season due to the pandemic. He finished fifth in the nation with 46 strikeouts and a team-best 1.95 ERA in 27.2 innings. Meyer has slashed .185/.214/.222 with one double, two runs scored, four RBIs and a stolen base while playing infield for the Gophers.

-As a sophomore in 2019, Meyer was named an All-Big Ten Second Team Selection. He made 16 appearances on the mound, including 11 starts, and went 5-3 with a 2.11 ERA and two saves 76.2 innings. He fanned a team-high 87 batters. Meyer also played in 35 games, including 30 starts, on the infield, batting .256/.323/.314 with four doubles, one home run, 12 RBIs and 15 runs scored.

-Meyer is currently ranked among the top 50 prospects in baseball by Baseball Prospectus (No. 24) and MLB.com (No. 35).

-A native of Woodbury, Minn., Meyer played hockey at Woodbury High School, lettering for three seasons as a forward. He was selected by the Minnesota Twins in the 34th round of the 2017 draft, but opted to pitch collegiately at the University of Minnesota.

-Both of Max's parents, Kathy and Kent, played collegiately while attending St. Olaf College (Northfield, Minn.). Kent was a member of the Oles' football team while Kathy played on the school's women's soccer team.

2022 SEASON

-Meyer needed just 53 pitches (38 strikes) to strike out eight in 5.0 perfect innings before departing with a calf cramp on April 12 at Durham.

2021 SEASON

-Meyer was promoted to Jacksonville on September 23 from Double-A Pensacola. With the Blue Wahoos, he led Double-A South in both ERA (2.41) and batting average against (.226) while ranking second in both strikeouts (113) and WHIP (1.23) and fourth in innings pitched (101.0).

-Among the 200 pitchers who recorded at least 50.0 innings in Double-A at the time of Meyer's promotion, he ranked 12th in ERA (2.41) and 30th in FIP (3.34) while posting the level's 14th-highest ground ball rate (52.7 percent) and 26th-lowest fly ball rate (28.3 percent).

-Meyer's 10 strikeouts in his Triple-A debut on September 24 against Memphis were the most for any Jacksonville pitcher in a level debut since at least 2005.

-Selected to the SiriusXM All-Star Futures Game, Meyer threw just seven pitches to two batters, getting Adley Rutschman (Baltimore Orioles) to fly out to left before walking Nick Pratto (Kansas City Royals).

ADDITIONAL CAREER NOTES

-Meyer competed for the USA Collegiate National Team in both 2018 and 2019. In 2018, he picked up seven saves with a 3.38 ERA in eight appearances, striking out a team-leading 15 batters in 8.0 innings. In 2019, he appeared in four games, including three starts, and recorded a 0.64 ERA across 14.0 innings with 12 strikeouts. He was named Outstanding Pitcher of the 2019 USA vs. Cuba International Friendship Series.
