ABOUT LAST NIGHT... Five shutout innings from starter Troy Miller set the tone Wednesday night, as the Vancouver Canadians took down the Spokane Indians (Rockies) 2-0 at Ron Tonkin Field.

Miller's effort was backed by a pair early runs. Ronny Brito doubled with one out in the second inning and later scored on a rule book double from Luis De Los Santos to give the C's a 1-0 advantage. In the third, three consecutive two-out singles - highlighted by a run-scoring base hit from Ryan Gold - doubled Vancouver's lead.

The pitching staff handled the rest. Miller gave way to Vancouver native Brayden Bouchey, who returned to action after arm surgery for the first time since August of 2018, and Bouchey was followed by Cobi Johnson and Will McAffer (5, 1). McAffer - a native son of North Vancouver - notched the first six-out save by a Canadians pitcher this season.

THE TRIBE HAS SPOKANE: The Canadians welcome the Spokane Indians to Ron Tonkin Field this week for the first of five series between these two clubs. Vancouver and Spokane will go head-to-head a total of 30 times this year, the second-most games against one opponent for the C's (Everett, 36).

HOME AWAY FROM HOME: Due to pandemic-related border closures, Ron Tonkin Field in Hillsboro will serve as Vancouver's home ballpark this year. 78 of 120 C's game will take place in the Tualatin Valley over the course of the season (60 home games, 18 against Hillsboro as the visitors).

SHOOTING BLANKS: Vancouver used a quartet of pitchers to record its first shutout of the season. It was the first time the C's blanked an opponent since August 21, 2019 when they beat Tri-City 1-0 in Pasco.

LATE LIFE: Vancouver's best single-inning batting average this season is in the 8th, when the C's are hitting .303.

RUNNING AMOK: The Canadians have swiped 15 bases this season, six of which belong to outfielder Cameron Eden.

GOOD AS GOLD: Ryan Gold is off to a hot start in 2021. He leads the team in average (.381), doubles (2), triples (1), RBI (5), OBP (.500), SLG (.571) and OPS (1.071). He's reached base in all six games he's played in and has a hit in five consecutive contests.

ON THE HILL: #10 Blue Jays prospect (MLB.com) CJ Van Eyk will make his second career start tonight for Vancouver. The right-hander toughed out his pro debut on May 6, when he lasted seven batters and gave up four runs on three hits and walked two. Van Eyk, 22, was a second round selection in 2020 after playing college ball at Florida State. Van Eyk (van IKE) struck out 25 batters in 20.2 innings his junior season before the pandemic cancelled the rest of the campaign. He was a staple of the weekend rotation as a sophomore in 2019, when he started all 18 games and finished with a 10-4 record and a 3.81 ERA. Once struck out 11 batters in six innings in the ACC Tournament against NC State and against Wake Forest. Van Eyk was first drafted by the Mets in the 19th round of the 2017 draft out of Steinbrenner High School in Tampa.

RHP Ryan Feltner gets the nod for Spokane. He made his season debut on May 7 against Eugene, when he allowed one run on five hits in four innings pitched. He walked three and struck out six. He spent all of 2-19 with Low-A Asheville, where he went 9-9 in 25 starts with a 5.07 ERA over 119 innings pitched. Feltner, 24, was a fourth round selection in the 2018 draft out of Ohio State, where he was considered a top three prospect in the BIG 10. His 204 strikeouts in three seasons is the 24th-most in team history.

The changeup is still a work in progress, but with two good breaking balls and a fastball that's improving, Kloffenstein is building in the right direction and, according to several members of the organization, made fantastic use of his time in 2020."
