

AST GAME

he Bowie Baysox dropped another one-run dame on Friday night in Richmond. Despite outhitting the Richmond Flying Squirrels, Bowie found themselves on e wrong end of a 2-1 final. The Baysox only used two pitchers in the contest, and held the Squirrels to only two hits. After stranding 13 runners on base in a ne-run loss the previous night, Bowie left another eight runners on base on Friday. Richmond scored both of their runs, and collected one of their only two hits, the first inning when Sean Roby launched his league-leading eighth home run to left field, a two-run shot. Despite taking the loss, Antonio Velez still cruised rough five innings of the one-hit ball, while Easton Lucas took the back three frames and worked scoreless with three strikeouts.

TODAY'S OPPONENT

Richmond and Bowie meet for the second time this month, after the Squirrels took two out of three at Prince George's Stadium over the opening weekend of the season. Richmond has only managed .500 ball since Opening Weekend, however, after taking four-of-six from Altoona in their first homestand of the year, but having the inverse happen on their recent road trip to Erie. While they did play fewer innings because of a doubleheader, Richmond struggled with Erie's league leading pitching, scoring only 20 runs over the course of the six-game series.

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

Right-hander Matt Frisbee makes just his third start of the season after not appearing in either of Richmond's first two series of the year. Only working into the third inning in each of his starts this season, Frisbee has had his troubles since initially earning a promotion to Triple-A Sacramento at the end of May in 2021. In 11 outlings at Triple-A, Frisbee went 1-7 with a 7.64 ERA, and was returned to Richmond in August. Bowie walloped the hurler the last time they saw him, slapping ten hits and scoring five runs over just 3.2 innings.

ASK JUSTIN TIMBERLAKE

It's gonna be May on Sunday, and the Baysox are closing out a strong month of April. Bowie exits the month currently leading the league with a .353 on-base percentage, and their 101 runs scored are the second-most in the league. This has been the highest-scoring April for Bowie since the plated 108 runs in 2017.

DYLAN DOES IT ALL

Utility outfielder Dylan Harris has made an immediate impact with the Baysox after just eight games in his Double-A career. While he was not assigned to an affiliate team out of spring training, Harris was brought up from the complex on April 16 to replace the injured Toby Welk. With hits in seven of his eight games, including each of the first five, Harris has already gone 13-for-28, with two home runs, five doubles, four RBI, and seven runs scored. Harris has been critical in both of Bowie's walk-off wins this season, scoring the winning run on April 21 against Akron, avoiding a tag at home in the tenth inning, and collecting the gamewinning hit on April 22 against Akron, allowing Zach Watson to score from first base on the hit and an error.

SURPRISING LEADERS

Despite going a combined 1-for-23 at the plate with runners in scoring position over their last two games, including a league-leading 21 runners left on base in the short span, Bowie still leads the Eastern League with a .263 batting average with runners in scoring position, and has stranded the fourth-fewest runners in scoring position this season.

SLIM MARGINS

Bowie had an early handle on one-run games this season, but have dropped their last three. With five of their last eight games coming down to just one run, the Baysox are 3-3 overall on one-run games. It's looking like the Baysox may see plenty of one-run games this season, as their six one-run games are the fewest in the Southwest Division. Despite just under half of their games being decided by three or fewer runs, Bowie's +19 run differential is the second-highest in the league, mostly thanks to their 20-6 win over Akron on 4/19 and their 10-0 win over Richmond on 4/27

BUSY BATTERIES

This series between Bowie and Richmond should stand to see plenty of strikeouts as it continues through the week. Richmond is second in the Eastern League with 215 strikeouts at the plate, Bowie is not too far behind at 211, the third-most in the League. Bowie has been climbing the charts recently, however, as they lead the League with 117 strikeouts since April 18, including two different games where they struck out 17 times.





Manager: Kyle Moore

The 2022 season will be the 13th season for Moore in the Orioles organization. He played 29 games over two seasons (2010-11) before becoming a coach. He spent three seasons as a player/ coach (2013 Frederick Keys, 2014 Bowie Baysox, 2015 Delmarva Shorebirds) before being named as the Shorebirds hitting coach in 2016 and the Keys hitting coach in 2017. Hitting Coach: Branden Becker

Becker was drafted by the Orioles in the 17th round of the Major League Baseball First-Year Player Draft in 2015 and played parts of four seasons in the organization before retiring in May, 2019. He rejoined the Orioles as the Fundamentals Coach for the IronBirds for the 2020 season before it was canceled. He served as the Hitting Coach for the Complex League Orioles in 2021.

Pitching Coach: Josh Conway

Conway was selected in the fourth round of the 2012 Major League Baseball First-Year Player Draft by the Chicago Cubs out of Coastal Carolina. He played three seasons with the Cubs organization, making it to Double- A in 2016. The Smithburg, Md native returned to the Chanticleers to complete his undergraduate degree and served as a student assistant and assistant pitching coach before joining the Orioles.
