## **CONINE POWERS JUMBO SHRIMP TO 7-2 WIN**

Griffin Conine went 3-for-5 with a home run, two RBIs and two runs scored on Saturday to lead Jacksonville to a 7-2 victory over Charlotte. A pair of erros led to a Jumbo Shrimp run in the first and Conine scored on a wild pitch in the second. He went yard in the fourth and Jacksonville made it 4-0 in the sixth on Jhonny Pereda's RBI double. After Bryan Ramos' homer cut things to 4-1 in the sixth, the Jumbo Shrimp plated three runs in the seventh on Victor Mesa Jr.'s RBI double and RBI singles by Pereda and Conine. Carlos Pérez collected an RBI double in the seventh to make it 7-2.

### MAY SHOWERS BRING JUNE FLOWERS?

Jacksonville finished 8-19 during the month of May, marking the club's worst record in any month since at least 2005. The Jumbo Shrimp actually lost the final game of April to begin a stretch of 17 losses in 20 games. After a season-high five-game winning streak from May 23-28. Jacksonville has now lost seven of their last 10 games, meaning the club is just 11-24 (.314) in the last 35 games. Unsurprisingly, the Shrimp rank near the bottom in Triple-A in many categories since April 30: runs scored (162, 28th), batting average (.248, 22nd), OBP (.339, 24th), slugging percentage (.384, 28th), OPS (.723, 28th) and home runs (31, T-26th).

## FRIENDS CLOSE, ENEMIES CLOSER

A remarkable 39 of Jacksonville's 62 games (62.9 percent) in 2024 have been decided by three runs or fewer, including 21 of the club's last 31 contests. After beginning the year 12-3 (.750) in these narrowly-decided contests, the Jumbo Shrimp have suddenly struggled in games determined by no more than three runs: Jacksonville has lost 20 of its last 24 games decided by three runs or fewer for an overall record of 16-23 (.410) in these affairs.

## GRIFFIN-DOR, WHERE DWELL THE BRAVE AT HEART

In eight games from April 26-May 5, Jacksonville outfielder Griffin Conine suffered through a 2-for-30 (.067) stretch with 12 strikeouts. In the 28 games since, however, the former Duke Blue Devil has gotten hot. Conine is 29-forhis-last-90, slashing .322/.431/.689/1.120 with six doubles, nine home runs, 25 RBIs, 18 walks and 19 runs scored. He's driven in at least one run in 17 of those 28 games, with multiple RBIs in seven contests.

## **ROAD IS WHERE THE HEART IS?**

Jacksonville's 11-22 (.333) home record is the worst such mark in the IL, while the club's 16-13 (.552) road record is one of only six winning away records in the circuit this year. On the road, the Jumbo Shrimp have scored 153 runs in 29 games (5.3 per game), more than a full run better than what they average at home (134 runs in 33 games, 4.1 per game). The Jumbo Shrimp have surrendered 181 runs (10th-most in Triple-A) in 33 home games (5.5 per game) compared to 131 (fourth-fewest) on the road (4.5 per game).

### ALWAYS THE BRIDE, NEVER THE BRIDESMAID

Jumbo Shrimp infielder Jonah Bride has had two short stints in the major leagues this season, batting 2-for-12. With Jacksonville, however, Bride is 52-for-183 (.284/.432/.525/.957) with 12 doubles, one triple, 10 home runs, 32 RBIs, 45 walks and 28 runs scored in 53 games played. The Owasso, Okla., native ranks fourth in the International League in walks, fifth in on-base percentage. ninth in OPS, tied for 16th in extra-base hits (23) and 19th in slugging percentage. Among the 124 qualified hitters in the IL, Bride ranks fourth in swinging-strike rate (4.8 percent) and 22nd in line drive rate (28.3 percent).

## LITTLE GUY, BIG RESULTS

Over his first 11 games in Triple-A, Javier Sanoja was just 6-for-39 (.154) at the plate. However, the 5-foot-7 Venezuelan struck out in only two plate appearances. His contact ability has manifested itself in a huge way of late; Sanoja has reached base safely in 26 of his last 29 games, notching 14 multi-hit contests. During this span, he is 43for-116 (.371/.427/.543/.970) with 10 doubles, two triples. two home runs, 20 RBIs, 13 walks and 18 runs scored. Among the 208 IL hitters with at least 110 PA, Sanoja has posted the highest opposite-field rate (51.4 percent) and the fourth-lowest swinging-strike rate (3.8 percent).

## SHRIMP BITES

A win on Sunday would net Jacksonville its fourth road series win this season. The Jumbo Shrimp have gone 3-1-0 in road sets in 2024 Tacksonville has homered in five consecutive games, matching a season-high... Victor Mesa Jr. ranks in a tie for eighth in the IL in hits (59) and a tie for 17th in RBIs (37).
