TONIGHT'S GAME: Welcome to LoanMart Field, as your Rancho Cucamonga Quakes (Dodgers) host the Fresno Grizzlies (Rockies) in the fourth game of a six-game series. Tonight is Chris Taylor Bobblehead Giveaway to 1,500 fans, thanks to Allstar Kia. Tickets are available by visiting rcquakes.com.

VS THE GRIZZLIES: Today's game is the tenth of 12 against the Grizzlies in 2024 and the fourth of six at home. Back in June, the Quakes split a six-game set with the Grizzlies at Chukchansi Park in Fresno. After last night's loss, the Quakes are 5-4 against Fresno in 2024. Last season, the Quakes went 5-7 against the Grizzlies, 4-2 here at home.

LAST GAME: Fresno jumped on the Quakes early and snapped Rancho's five-game winning streak, as the Grizzlies won a 9-3 decision on Thursday night at LoanMart Field. Rancho starter Hyun-Seok Jang, making his Cal League debut, retired the first four hitters, but allowed the next four to reach. Jang (0-1) was charged with three runs on two hits with two walks and three strikeouts over just 1.1 innings of work. Fresno starter Ismael Luciano was sharp over 4.1 innings in a no-decision. Grizzlies' reliever Hunter Mann (1-0) fired two perfect innings and got the win. Rancho got two hits from Wilman Diaz, including his fourth homer of the year. Zyhir Hope (5) also went deep for the Quakes.

WINNING IS GOOD: Rancho's loss last night ended their longest winning streak of the second half, but they're still in the midst of their best stretch of the second half, having won 11 of their last 15 overall. They've won back-to-back series (at Inland Empire, vs San Jose) and currently own the best second-half record in the league, two games up in the South over the Visalia Rawhide and three over the Lake Elsinore Storm. In order to make the playoffs, Rancho must finish the second half ahead of both Visalia and Inland Empire (currently six games back).

ROSTER MOVES: The Quakes added Korean right-hander Hyun-Seok Jang to the active roster on Thursday from the Arizona Complex League. On Wednesday, they activated LHP Luke Fox off the Development List. On Tuesday, they had their busiest transaction day of the year, with nine total moves. The headliner was Dodgers rehabbing INF Miguel Rojas, who went 0-for-3 with a walk, while logging four plate appearances as the DH on Tuesday night against Fresno. In addition, the Quakes transferred INF Sean McLain, OF Juan Alonso and RHP Christian Ruebeck to High-A Great Lakes of the Midwest League. They also placed RHP Gabe Emmett on the Injured List and released LHP Moises Brito. Joining the Quakes are pitcher LHP Sterling Patick, OF Eduardo Quintero and INF Eduardo Guerrero.

SEAN PAUL LINAN: Right-hander Sean Linan makes his tenth appearance and his third start, his second start against Fresno. Linan actually made his Rancho debut in Fresno on June 15, where he allowed two runs on seven hits with six strikeouts over 4.1 innings in a no-decision. In his last outing overall, he dominated against San Jose, allowing just one unearned run on three hits with three walks and eight strikeouts over 5.1 innings of work in a win on August 2. Linan made six appearances (one start) in the ACL this year, going 3-0 with a 2.08 ERA, allowing three runs on nine hits over 13 innings with 21 strikeouts and only two walks prior to getting moved up to Rancho in mid-June. Linan is from Columbia and signed with the Dodgers in 2022.

STU FLESLAND III: Lefty Stu Flesland will make a spot-start for Fresno, his second of the season and 27th appearance overall. In two combined relief appearances against Rancho back in June, he allowed one run on three hits over 1.2 innings, taking a no-decision in each outing. Flesland's last outing overall was against Lake Elsinore on August 3, where he pitched 2.2 innings of scoreless relief, allowing just three hits and one walk, while striking out six in a no-decision. Flesland played college ball at the University of Washington and was drafted by Colorado in the 11th round of the 2023 draft.
