Yesterday: Cubs 7, Lugnuts 6. South Bend rallied from 4-1 and 6-4 deficits, taking the lead in the ninth on a Pedro Ramirez three-run homer. Lansing starter Mitch Myers allowed one run in five innings and Euribiel Angeles delivered a two-run double and an RBI triple in the losing effort.

On Deck: Tomorrow is a Midwest League off day, and then the Nuts head on the road for a six-game series at Great Lakes, returning home Tuesday, May 14th, for a six-game series with the Lake County Captains.

#### Lug•Notes

Major League Nut: 2021-22 Lansing Lugnuts infielder Brett Harris notched his first two Major League hits last night in his second career MLB game... and they were both home runs in a 20-3 Oakland A's victory over the Miami Marlins. Harris, the 186th Lugnut all-time to reach the Majors joins Max Schuemann as Lugs to make their MLB debut in 2024; Schuemann also homered for his first big league hit.

Where There's a Will, There's a Way: 1B/3B Will Simpson went 2-for-4 with a single, a triple and a walk yesterday; he has reached base in 23 of 24 games and ranks 2nd in the Midwest League in batting average (.358), tied for 2nd in walks (24), 2nd in OBP (.500), 1st in OPS (1.080), tied for 1st in triples (3) and tied for 4th in RBIs (20).

League Leaderboard, Will Excluded: Colby Halter's 21 walks place him 4th in the league; Brayan Buelvas is 2nd in runs scored (22); and Henry Bolte is tied for 3rd in stolen bases (11).

Action on the Bases: Yesterday, the Lugnuts went 2-for-3 in stolen base attempts; overall this series the Lugs are 7-for-15 with one pickoff.

Three's a Charm: The Nuts tripled twice yesterday and lead the league with 11 triples.

A Grand Start: On April 3, Will Simpson crushed a grand slam (as well as a solo shot) in an 18-0 victory over Michigan State in the Crosstown Showdown. Ten days later, Simpson launched a grand slam off the Great Lakes Loons in an 8-5 loss.

Prospecting: The Nuts' roster includes three MLB Pipeline Top 30 A's prospects in pitcher Luis Morales (No. 2), outfielder Henry Bolte (No. 10) and first baseman Will Simpson (No. 28). Morales was just activated off the Injured List and made his 2024 Midwest League debut last night; he is the top pitching prospect in the organization. Bolte, the A's No. 2 outfield prospect, was selected 56th overall in 2022 from Palo Alto High School, where he led all California high schoolers with 13 home runs. Simpson impressed with a .319/ .367/.543 line in his professional debut after he was drafted in the 15th round from Washington last year.

### **TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY**

**2009:** Rebel Ridling slugged a three-run go-ahead home run in the 9th, and the Peoria Chief rallied from deficits of 5-2 and 6-4 for a 7-6 victory at Oldsmobile Park.

**2015:** The Quad Cities River Bandits piled up 10 hits and limited the Lugnuts to a bloop single, but the Lugnuts still won 1-0 at Cooley Law School Stadium, earning 2015 1st-rounder Jon Harris his first professional victory. The Nuts only run came via three walks and a Juan Kelly double-play grounder in the third inning, scoring Aaron Attaway. The Bandits collected two hits in the fifth and exactly one hit in every other inning.



**2023 Retrospective:** Added to the Lansing roster from Stockton on August 30, 2023, becoming the 922nd Lugnut in franchise history, the 15th different starting pitcher for Lansing this season and the 51st different player used... signing bonus of \$3 million broke the record given to Sandy Gaston by Tampa Bay in 2018 (\$2.61m)... declared a free agent on August 25, 2022... signed on the first day of the international signing period, January 15, 2023.

**Prospecting:** Morales is ranked the A's no. 2 prospect by MLB Pipeline, which grades his fastball at 60, his curve at 50, his slider at 55, his change at 50 and his control at 50.

They write, "Morales was billed as the consensus top pitching prospect of the 2023 international signing period when he signed for \$3 million with the A's in January that year. After setting a U-18 record for strikeouts with 161 across 82 2/3 innings between 2019-20 in Cuba's Serie Nacional, he defected in 2021 to Mexico, where he trained with Maels Rodríguez, a former Cuban National team pitcher and Olympian who regularly threw 100 mph fastballs. Initially expected to pitch solely in the Dominican Summer League for his introduction to pro ball, his excellent performance earned him stops at four different levels. He finished the year at High-A Lansing, combining for a 2.86 ERA with 53 strikeouts in 44 innings.

Morales' whip-like delivery produces an electric fastball that sits around 94-97 mph and can reach up to 99. His four-pitch mix also includes a slider, a changeup and a curveball, all of which appeared to be quality secondary pitches as he rapidly ascended through the Minors in his debut season.

Adding about 10 pounds of muscle to his 6-foot-3 frame in preparation for his first full season as a pro, Morales will see his durability tested as he looks to navigate the rigors of pitching. While his command was solid upon joining the A's, he has struggled with controlling his pitches in the past. If he can keep that control steady, he has a chance to make another significant jump through the system in 2024, with enough potential to evolve into a frontline starter in the future."

Path to Lansing: Luis opened the 2023 season in the Dominican Summer League, making his professional debut on June 6 with 1 2/3 hitless innings vs. DSL Astros Blue, striking out three... struck out six batters in three one-hit innings on June 20... struck out five batters in four one-hit innings on June 27... made four appearances in DSL before he was promoted to the Arizona Complex League Athletics on July 2, debuting on July 4 with three innings, allowing one run with three strikeouts vs. D-Backs Black... made three starts in AzCL before he was promoted to the Stockton Ports on July 24, debuting on July 28 with three one-hit innings and five strikeouts vs. Lake Elsinore... in last of five California League starts, tossed four two-hit scoreless innings at Fresno on August 25... promoted to Lansing on August 30, his fourth different stop along the ladder... innings high: 4 IP, 2x; strikeouts high: 6, 6/20.

**2023 Lugnuts Debut:** Started vs. West Michigan at home on September 1... tossed 3 2/3 IP, 5 H, 3 R, 1 BB, 4 K, allowing 2 HR... 59 pitches, 35 strikes... fastball touched 99 mph... in 1st inning, struck out Seth Stephenson and Luke Gold while pitching around a single to Gage Workman (stranded at third)... in 2nd inning, allowed two-out, first-pitch solo HR to RF from Izaac Pacheco... in 3rd inning, allowed one-out, first-pitch solo HR to RF from Gage Workman... in 4th inning, departed with two outs and runners at 1st and 2nd base; reliever Jake Garland allowed RBI single, bringing in one inherited runner, before ending the inning with the score tied 3-3... Garland kept the game tied by blanking the Whitecaps until the 9th, when West Michigan plated two runs against him for a 5-3 victory.
