LUG-NOTES

History: The Nuts set a new franchise record with 45 losses on the road, breaking the original mark of 42 losses set by the 1999 team (which starred **Corey Patterson** and **Carlos Zambrano**, lost only 25 games at home, finished 73-67, went to the postseason, swept Michigan in two games, and was eliminated in the divisional championship round by Wisconsin).

Diametrically Opposed: The Nuts have lost 13 of their last 16 road games while winning 13 of their last 15 home games.

Two for the Price of One: The Lugnuts lead all of High-A in turning double plays, 119. Fort Wayne is in second with 112 double plays.

Transaction: Entering this series, outfielder **Pedro Pineda** was promoted to Double-A, replaced on the Lansing roster by the 54th Lugnut of the season, outfielder **Alex Fernandes**. After hitting just .182 in April and .222 in May, the speedy 22-year-old Pineda hit for a .281 average / .814 OPS in July, then followed up with a .275 avg. and .869 OPS in August to lead the Nuts' offense, flourishing as Lansing's leadoff hitter following the promotion of Jared Sprague-Lott. Meanwhile, the 23-year-old Fernandes is in the starting lineup tonight, batting 7th, in his professional debut. A native of San Marcos, Calif., he batted a sizzling .401/.528/.661 for San Jose State this past season, then followed up it up with a remarkable Pioneer League performance for the Glacier Range Riders (Kalispell, Mont.) in which he collected 36 hits, 30 walks and 36 steals in just 28 games, batting .367 with a 1.115 OPS. Fernandes was signed as an undrafted free agent on July 20.

Who's Streaking:

- **Jake Reinisch** enters today on a 39-game on-base streak, batting .302 with a .461 OBP and a .512 slugging pct. during the streak, with 39 base hits and 36 walks. It is the second longest active streak in the minors behind only Jose Cerice's 46-game streak for Quad Cities. The longest in MLB history was Ted Williams' 84 games (July 1-Sept. 27, 1949).

Welcome Back, Z! Pitcher **Chen Zhong-Ao Zhuang** tossed two innings on Sunday in an MiLB rehab appearance The Taiwanese right-hander, affectionately nicknamed "Z Man," posted a 2.56 ERA in nine appearances spanning 31 2/3 innings with the Lugnuts in 2024, with a remarkable 3:29 BB:K ratio. He spent all of 2025 in Double-A Midland (6-11, 4.08 ERA, 145 K in 145 2/3 IP) and was added to the A's 40-man roster entering 2026. But Zhuang landed on the 7-day IL from May 4-30 and was designed for assignment on July 31, going back on the Injured List (right elbow) on August 6.

Major League Lugnuts: Ten former Nuts have made their MLB debuts this season: **Daniel Susac** for the Giants, **Junior Perez** for the White Sox, **Eduardo Rivera** for the Red Sox, **Jack Weisenburger** with the NY Mets, and **Henry Bolte**, **Gage Jump**, **Kade Morris**, **Joshua Kuroda-Grauer**, **Tommy White** and **Yunior Tur** for the Athletics. In all 48 Lugnuts have appeared in a Major League game this season.

Moving On Up: The Lugnuts have seen above-average roster movement, with 18 players moving to the upper levels of the minors...

- 2026 Nuts **Ryan Magdic**, **Jake Garland**, **Devin Taylor** and **Davis Diaz** have reached Triple-A Las Vegas.
- **Nathan Dettmer**, **Jay Dill**, **Steven Echavarria**, **Jackson Finley**, **Ben Hansen**, **Blaze Pontes**, **Zane Taylor**, **Logan Sauve**, **Bobby Boser**, **Ali Camarillo**, **Jared Sprague-Lott**, **Nate Nankil** and **Pedro Pineda** are with Double-A Midland.

SEPTEMBER 1 IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2014: The season ended disappointingly, two outs into the sixth inning, shortened due to rain, with a 4-3 South Bend victory at Cooley Law School Stadium. 19-year-old 1B Rowdy Tellez went 3-for-3 with his second home run, finishing with a .357 batting average in a 12-game stint with the Lugnuts. The Nuts finish 62-77.

2018: In his final at-bat of the season, Johnny Aiello singled to extend his hitting streak to 15 games. (He finished 1-for-4.) The Lugnuts beat Fort Wayne, 7-5, in the next-to-last game of the season at Parkview Field. The TinCaps didn't help their cause, going 0-for-10 with runners in scoring position and committed five errors, leading to three unearned runs. In the Majors, Robinson Chirinos, an infielder in Lansing, becomes the first MLB Lugnut to catch a no-hitter, handling Justin Verlander's third career no-no in a 2-0, 14-K Astros victory over the Toronto Blue Jays.

In a Nutshell: Hometown of Las Vegas is located in Aragua, directly south of Maracay (which produced Miguel Cabrera, Carlos Guillen and Bobby Abreu), to the east of Lago de Valencia... made his Midwest League debut last Tuesday, August 25, at Great Lakes... became the 16th different Lugnuts starting pitcher this year, the 28th different pitcher, the 52nd different player in 2026, and the 1,012th Lignut all-time... skipped directly over Single-A Stockton.

Signing Class: Part of a group of 16 international signees announced by the A's in January 2024, joining top prospects Edgar Montero (Dominican Republic) and Jose Ramos (Venezuela) alongside Nathan Arends (Aruba), Yohandri Contreras (VZ), Braya Cota (Mexico), Samuel Gonzalez (VZ), Celso Lopez (VZ), Erick Matos (Cuba), Hugo Meraz Trejo (MX), Azzael Pacheco (VZ), Alejandro Pereira (VZ), Luis Plicet (Panama), Sebastian Rojas (VZ), Oliver Sirotti (DR), Franco Zabaleta (Colombia)... while Montero has spent the season in Single-A Stockton, Parra becomes the first to reach High-A.

2024: Made his professional debut in the Dominican Summer League, making four appearances in June and three appearances in August.

2025: Achieved much greater success... of 14 runs allowed during the whole season, nine were scored in two appearances... if we take those out, posted a 0.95 ERA in 9 G/6 GS spanning 38 IP (5 R/4 ER)... tossed remarkable eight-inning gem on July 28, giving up only one hit (a one-out double in the 6th inning) while walking six and striking out seven on 132 pitches, 77 strikes. (This feels unlikely, doesn't it? Like there was a missed pitching change?)

2026: Began the season in Arizona Complex League pitching in piggyback relief of top prospect Shotaro Morii in the third game of the season... in worst start of the season, gave up 10 runs to Brewers on three hits, eight walks and two HBPs in two innings on June 18... two starts later, tossed five hitless innings at D-Backs on July 4... in most recent start, the final game of the Arizona Complex League season, took the loss on July 23, giving up two runs on three hits and two walks in four innings at Rockies... pitched to 11.96 ERA at home, 5.51 ERA on the road... limited lefties to .192 avg. (14 BB/18 K), righties to .237 (28 BB/22 K)... limited opposition to .145 avg. with bases empty, .288 with runners on base.
