#### NATURALS COME BACK IN NINTH TO WIN ON SATURDAY:

NATURALS COME BACK IN NINTH TO WIN ON SATURDAY:

Jack Leiter tossed five innings with two hits and two runs and Wyatt Langford recorded a double, a single and a walk, but the Frisco RoughRiders let a ninth-inning lead slip away in Northwest Arkansas' 7-4 win on Saturday from Riders Field. Frisco (30-32, 61-69) led 4-3 in the ninth inning but gave up four runs in the final frame. With the loss and an Amarillo win, the RoughRiders were eliminated from 2023 playoff contention. Northwest Arkansas (31-30, 60-70) clinched the series, claiming victory in four of five games so far this week. In his 18th start of the season, Leiter struck out five batters in his five innings. He gave up a two-run home run in the first inning and allowed just one hit after. Leiter threw 75 pitches, 49 for strikes. Langford went 2-for-4 with a walk and an RBI double on Saturday. In his first week of Double-A baseball, the 21-year-old has four hits with two doubles and five walks in five games. Langford recorded Frisco's first hit of the day in the third inning when he laced a double to right center field for an RBI. David Garcia had walked earlier in the inning and scored to shorten the Naturals' lead to 2-1. Langford helped spark a go-ahead rally in the fifth inning with a single. He followed a leadoff walk by Keyber Rodriguez, who scored on a reror to tie the game. Kellen Strahm bunted for a single to load the bases and Aaron Zavala produced the go-ahead run on a sac fly. Chris Seise extended the advantage to 4-2 with a base hit up the middle to score Hicks. Aidan Anderson kept the Naturals off the scoreboard in the eighth inning but Northwest Arkansas scored one run in the seventh inning to make it a 4-3 Riders lead. Danny Duffy got out of a jam with the bases loaded and no outs, allowing just one score and pitching a scoreless eighth inning. Andy Rodriguez (0-1) came in to pitch for Frisco in the ninth inning and allowed four runs to take the loss. Anthony Simonelli (1-0) was the winning pitcher with his scoreless frame in the eighth.

WELLOME, WTALL:
Wyatt Langford, who was taken with the No. 4 pick by the Rangers in the 2023 draft, was promoted to Frisco on Monday. He is the No. 2 prospect in the Rangers system and No. 13 in MLB.com's top 100 prospects. At the University of Florida, he was a Unanimous First Team All-American selection after leading the Gators to the College World Series Championship Finals, where they fell to the LSU Tigers. On the season, the outfielder hit an astounding .373/.471/.746/.1217 with 21 home runs and 57 RBIs over 64 games. In his Double-A debut on Monday, he went 0-for-4, and he went 2-for-2 with a walk and a sac fly in his second game on Wednesday.

#### THE CARTER STORY GETS EVAN BETTER:

THE CARTER STORY GETS EVAN BETTER:
On Thursday, the Texas Rangers announced that No. 1 prospect and former RoughRiders outfielder Evan Carter was called up to the Major League roster. A second-round selection in 2020 by the Rangers out of Elizabethton High School in Elizabethton, Tennessee, Carter spent the last week of 2022 and the playoffs with Frisco before beginning the season with the RoughRiders in 2023. During the 2022 season, he won the Tom Grieve Texas Rangers Minor League Player of the Year award, batting 295/3397/489/886 with 21 doubles, 10 triples, 12 home runs and 28 steals over 106 games. In 97 games with the RoughRiders in 2023, Carter hit 284/411/.451/.862 with 15 doubles, six triples, 12 home runs, 62 runs, 74 walks, 68 runs scored and 22 steals. When he was promoted to Triple-A Round Rock, Carter was second in the Texas League in walks (74) and on-base percentage (.411) while he was sixth in OPS (.862). In his MLB debut, he went 1-for-3 with a single, a walk and a stolen base.

Since the exit of **Thomas Saggese** and **Luisangel Acuña** at the end of July, the RoughRiders have had a tough time scoring runs on the offensive side. Since August 1st, the RoughRiders are last in the Texas League with just 4.5 runs per game, a .236 batting average and 20 home runs over their 35 games. Frisco's record since August 1st is 15-19. The 20 home runs during that time frame are the fewest in Double-A.

### DRIVERS, START YOUR ENGINES:

The RoughRiders have scored in the first inning in six of the last 14 games. The Riders are first in the Texas League in first-inning runs with 96 over their 129 games. As a team, Frisco is hitting .270/.367/.430/.797 in the first inning with 14 home runs.

### WALK IT LIKE I TALK IT:

For almost the entire season, the RoughRiders have lead the Texas League in walks as an offense. Frisco has already shattered their franchise record for most walks in a season with 649 and counting (5.0 per game). Frisco's .355 on-base percentage is on pace to set a new franchise record as well. The Riders already have four players who have cracked the top 10 in single-season walks in franchise history: Evan Carter (74, 5th), Trevor Hauver (71, 6th), Kellen Strahm (69, 8th) and Aaron Zavala (69, 8th). In 2015, Drew Robinson set the single-season record with 83 walks. Strahm is also third in career walks in RoughRiders franchise history with 134. Next up is Preston Book who walked 142 times every his four expression with the Rider. **Preston Beck**, who walked 143 times over his four seasons with the Riders.

### HICKS IS THE CORRECT PICK:

Liam Hicks has been as hot as anyone at the plate for the RoughRiders. Over the last 44 games, Hicks is batting .300 (45-for-150)/.425/.387/.812 with eight doubles, a triple, a home run, 22 RBIs, 25 walks and 19 runs scored. In August, he hit .338 (26-for-77) with a .890 OPS.

### ONE HOME RUN, PLEASE, AND MAKE IT GRAND:

The RoughRiders have had a knack for grand slams this year with **Evan Carter** hitting Frisco's ninth grand slam of the season. They are one of five teams with at least nine grand slams in all of Minor League Baseball. Seven different players have accounted for the grand slams (**Liam Hicks, Luisangel Acuña, Jax Biggers, Dustin Harris, Trey Thomas Saggese** (3) and **Evan Carter**). On July 5th, the Riders allowed their first grand slam this year, becoming the final Texas League team to do so.

-Went to Northgate High School in Walnut Creek, California (across the Bay from San Francisco, east of Berkeley). His senior season, he went 6-5 with a 2.20 ERA over 11 games

-Krauth then went to the University of New Mexico for the 2018 season, where he was teammates with current RoughRiders pitcher Justin Slaten.

-After New Mexico, transferred to Diablo Valley College in Pleasant Valley, California where he went 5-4 with a 2.20 ERA. Following that strong season, he transferred again, this time to the University of Connecticut, where he was one of the best pitchers in the country for the 2020 season before it was cut short due to COVID. In his four starts, he went 4-0 with a 0.36 ERA and a .167 BAA. This included five one-run innings against the No. 1 Michigan Wolverines on February 23rd.

-Due to the 2020 MLB Draft getting shortened to five rounds, Krauth went undrafted and signed with the Rangers as a free agent on June 15th.

-Brother, Ben Krauth, pitched for the San Antonio Missions in 2022, making nine starts and recording a 7.18 ERA. In two starts against Frisco, the RoughRiders touched him up for a combined seven runs, six earned, over 7.2 innings while handing him two losses. Ben was released by the Padres organization at the end of the year and retired after six seasons of MiLB

### **2023 SEASON**

-Krauth made first appearance of the season out of the bullpen on Friday, April 7th, allowing three runs over four innings.

-In his first start, Krauth went shutout five innings at San Antonio on April 14th to earn the first win among RoughRiders starting pitchers

-Threw four scoreless innings on April 20th before game was suspended due to rain in the top of the fifth with the Riders up 9-0, ending his night early. The Riders and the Travelers went on to finish the game on April 21st with Frisco winning 13-5.

-Allowed a run in the fourth inning against Amarillo on April 26th, snapping a 14.2-consecutive innings scoreless streak dating back to April 7th.

-Joined Triple-A Round Rock on May 2nd for a spot start and make two appearances. In his start, he went 3.2 IP, 2 H, 0 R, 0 ER, 3 BB, 1 K. Allowed a grand slam to David Freitas of Oklahoma City in relief appearance.

# **2022 SEASON**

-Spent time as both a starter and reliever, going 4-7 with a 5.38 ERA in 17 starts and 1-0, 2.25 ERA out of the bullpen.

-An extreme groundball pitcher, Krauth rolled groundballs at a 50.2% clip with the Crawdads.

### 2021 SEASON

-Showing his durability, Krauth led the Low-A East and the Rangers organization with 102.2 innings pitched. He also made a team-high 20 starts.

-Earned Low-A East Pitcher of the Week twice, including once for a complete-game, onehitter on August 28th vs. Fayetteville (9.0 IP, 1 H, 1 R, 1 ER, 2 BB, 9 K).
