JUNE GLOOM: After dropping its third straight series last week at home, the FredNats' first half title hopes are hanging on by a thread as the team hits the road again to play a second straight first-place team, the Carolina Mudcats (Milwaukee). FXBG comes into play today 6.0 games behind Carolina in the division with nine left to play in the first half, so it will take at least five wins this week to make things interesting going down the stretch. FXBG is just 1-7 in June after posting above .500 records in the first two months of the season, and has been outscored 52-21 this month. The team batting average this month is .190 and the team OPS is .548 compared to .301 and .831 for the opponents. RHP Bryan Polanco gets the series opening start, looking to build on a strong recent stretch.

ABOUT LAST WEEK: FXBG lost its third straight series, five games to one against the first-place Kannapolis Cannon Ballers. Prior to this three-series skid, Fredericksburg had not lost a series all season. The Cannon Ballers scored first in all five of their wins on the week, and in total, Kannapolis outscored FXBG 40-15 in the series and outhit 66-34 on the week. Jarlin Susana was a bright spot on the mound, pitching five shutout innings in his Friday night start, and the rehabbing Jared McKenzie hit home runs on back-to-back days on the weekend.

ROSTER MOVEMENT: Prior to the start of last week's series and this series, the FredNats made several roster moves. Carolina League save leader Thomas Schultz was promoted to High-A Wilmington after posting a league-best eight saves and an ERA of 1.82 in 24.2 IP. Reliever Anthony Arguelles returns to Fredericksburg from the Complex after four early-season appearances with FXBG. Jared McKenzie continues to rehab a broken bone in his upper leg with the FredNats as well, and has hit home runs in back-to-back games of this rehab assignment. Today, OF Nick Peoples joins FXBG for the first time, and LHP Dannel Diaz returns after a brief stint with High-A Wilmington.

FORMULA FOR SUCCESS: The FredNats are 22-4 this season when scoring first, including 19 out of the last 20 wins. FXBG did not score first in any of its losses the last two weeks, and has scored first in its last three wins, two of them on the last road trip against Down East, and it did score first in its only win last week against the Kannapolis Cannon Ballers.

BULLPEN WORK: So far in 2024, the FredNat bullpen has been one of the best units in all of Minor League Baseball. So far this season, the bullpen has pitched 288.1 innings this year and allowed 93 earned runs for a group ERA of 2.93, which is the best in the Carolina League. The Freddies are also 15/16 in save opportunities, and prior to his promotion, Thomas Schultz was first in the Carolina League and T-4th in MiLB with eight saves. Fredericksburg remains undefeated when leading after 7 (24-0), and 8 (25-0) innings this season as well.

RBI KING: Brandon Pimentel continues to lead the Carolina League in RBI with 48. This year, Pimentel is hitting .375 with runners in scoring position, and is 11-for-22 (.500) with runners in scoring position and two outs. Pimentel continues to be one of the best situational hitters in all of MiLB.

THE SKIP IS BACK: The FredNats' leader from the last two seasons returns to the Managerial role for 2024. Jake Lowery is back for another year in the 'Burg. Lowery, 34, was selected by Cleveland in the fourth round of the 2011 Draft out of James Madison University, where he was given the Johnny Bench Award as the nation's top collegiate catcher. The Midlothian, Virginia native played in the Nationals organization from 2016 to 2019, including parts of two seasons with the Potomac Nationals. Lowery reached the Iriple-A level in 2018 and transitioned to a managerial role in 2021 after nine seasons in the minor leagues. Lowery is the 28th manager in franchise history dating back to 1978. Lowery is 171-146 in his two-plus years as Manager in Fredericksburg, including the 2022 Carolina League playoffs.

THE STAFF: The majority of the 2023 coaching staff returns for 2024, with the lone exception being Hitting Coach Mike Habas. Pitching Coach Justin Lord, Development Coach Carmelo Jaime, Performance Analyst Josh Freligh, Strength & Conditioning Nathan Sier and Athletic Trainer Jake Meyer are all back from last year's staff. Lord, 44, will begin his fourth season coaching in the Washington organization. The Florida State alum pitched six seasons professionally before transitioning to coaching, spending time in the Baltimore organization prior to joining the Nationals.

Habas, 33, begins his first season in the Washington organization after spending the last four seasons coaching in the Milwaukee Brewers organization. He was the hitting coach for the ACL Brewers the last two seasons, and was an Assistant Coach for the independent Gary SouthShore RailCats and Head Coach at Prarie State Junior College prior to his time with Milwaukee. Jaime, 38, was Detroit's 24th round selection in the 2008 Draft out of Miami Dade College. The Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic native reached Double-A in his three-year minor league career, and has served as the first base coach and infield coach with the FredNats the past two seasons, roles he will continue in 2024. Meyer is in his seventh year with the Nationals overall and second with the FredNats, he spent his first five years at the facility in West Palm Beach, FL. Sier is in his second year with FXBG after previous stops with 2SP Sports and Macomb Community College (MI). Freligh begins his second year with the Nationals after previous stops with the Boston Red Sox and Los Angeles Dodgers.

A LASTING LEGACY: The Fredericksburg Nationals adopt the franchise history of their predecessors in the Carolina League dating back to 1978...the Alexandria Dukes (1978, 1980-83) and Alexandria Mariners (1979) played at Four Mile Run Park in Alexandria, Virginia...the Prince William Pirates (1984-1986), Prince William Yankees (1987-1988), Prince William Cannons (1989-1998), Potomac Cannons (1999-2004) and Potomac Nationals (2005-2019) played at G. Richard Pfitzner Stadium in Woodbridge, Virginia...the franchise has won five Mills Cup Championships, as the Dukes in 1982, as the Yankees in 1989, and as the Nationals in 2008, 2010 and 2014.

TODAY'S START: Bryan Polanco is set to make his sixth start of the season, this evening against the Kannapolis Cannon Ballers. Polanco made a spot start at the end of April against Delmarva, and his since taken over a starting role with the promotion of Jose Atencio.

NOTHING NEW: While Polanco had been primarily a relief arm with Fredericksburg this year, starting games is a role he's more than familiar with. In his MiLB career, 17 of Bryan's 33 career appearances have been as a starting pitcher. In 2022 and '23 in particular, he started 16 games compared to just six relief appearances.

Further simplifying the transtition, Polanco has served as the "bridge guy" out of the FredNat bullpen this year, capable of handling longer outings. Of his five relief appearances, Polanco has worked three innings once, 4+ innings three times, and even logged a five inning relief outing on 5/1 vs Down East.

ROAD TO THE FREDDIES: Polanco began his professional career with a rough debut in the DSL in 2021, but he returned in '22 and cut his ERA in half (7.04 to 3.51) while striking out 49 hitters in 41.0 IP. He jumped to the FCL and faced some struggles, but joined the FredNats late in 2023 for a pair of starts.

LAST TIME OUT: Kannapolis tagged Polanco for seven hits last week, but the righty allowed just two runs (1 ER) in a hard-luck loss.
