LAST TIME OUT

The Baysox could not complete their ninth inning comeback last night in a 4-2 loss to Richmond on Monday. After being shut out for eight innings, Bowie pulled within two after a bases loaded walk by **John Rhodes** and a wild pitch that scored **TT Bowens**. With the tying runs on base, **Silas Ardoin** struck out to end the game. Richmond starting left-hander John Michael Bertrand threw seven shutout innings to earn the win and has now thrown 20 shutout frames against the Baysox this season.

ALL-STAR SAMUEL

C/1B **Samuel Basallo** was selected to the 2024 All-Star Futures Game today and will represent the Orioles at Globe Life Field in Arlington, TX on Saturday, July 13. The Orioles No. 2 prospect is the 14th Baysox player in franchise history to be named to the All-Star Futures Game and is the first since Adley Rutschman was named in 2021. The 19-year-old has reached base safely in 30 of his last 32 games dating back to May 21, including in his last 10 straight.

ON-BASE BENCOSME

IF **Frederick Bencosme**'s team-best 14-game hit streak was snapped yesterday, which is tied for the second-longest hit streak in the Eastern League this season behind Portland's Blaze Jordan (19 games). The Orioles No. 27 prospect still owns a 15-game on-base streak, the fourth longest active on-base streak in the league.

WELCOME MR. ETZEL

OF/1B **Matthew Etzel** was the first Orioles '23 draft pick to be promoted to Double-A after being selected in the 10th round out of So. Miss. The 22-year-old hit his first two Double-A homers at Reading this past week. His 37 steals on the season between High-A Aberdeen and Double-A Bowie is tied for the seventh-most in all of MiLB.

BOWENS BATS 'EM IN

1B **TT Bowens** is the first Baysox player to reach 40 RBI on the season after his tie-breaking solo homer on Saturday in Reading. He is tied for the eighth-most RBI in the league and is tied for the third-most doubles (17) in the circuit. Bowens has played in 61 games this year after playing in only 47 last year due to injuries.

THE FANTASTIC FABIAN

OF **Jud Fabian** is tied for second among active Eastern League players with 13 home runs on the season. Fabian hit a league-high six homers in the month of May and hit five in June.

LEAVE IT TO BEAVERS

OF/1B **Dylan Beavers** has reached base in 54 of 65 games started in his second season with the Baysox. The Orioles No. 7 prospect leads the team in OBP (.344) and leads the team in walks (38), tied for the third-most in the Eastern League.

SHOVING THE SHOVE

After recording a 4.28 ERA in the month of May, Bowie's pitching staff recorded the seventh-lowest ERA in all of Double-A in the month of June (3.51). The Baysox are tied with Northwest Arkansas for the most strikeouts in all of Double-A (769).

SIZING UP THE SQUIRRELS

The Richmond Flying Squirrels finished the first half in fourth in the Southwest Division with a record of 34-35. The Double-A affiliate of the San Francisco Giants lost five of six to open the second half against Somerset but have won nine of 12 against Bowie in the season series. Richmond's active roster includes only three of the Giants' top 30 prospects (per MLB Pipeline) - RHP Trevor McDonald (No. 12), OF/1B Victor Bericoto (No. 19) and OF Jairo Pomares (No. 26).

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

RHP Dylan Cumming makes his fourth start of the season for the Flying Squirrels since being promoted from High-A Eugene on May 28. Cumming started the season with the Emeralds and posted a 1.87 ERA in nine games with 50 strikeouts over 33.2 innings. In five games with the Flying Squirrels, he has a 3.63 ERA over 22.1 innings with 22 strikeouts. The 25-year-old signed with the Giants as a undrafted free agent back in February 2023.

Began season in rotation for three starts before being bumped into long relief role for five straight outings. Named to Bowie Opening Day roster.

2023: Began season with FCL Orioles on a rehab assignment after recovering from Tommy John surgery. Made four rehab appearances between FCL Orioles, Single-A Delmarva and High-A Aberdeen before being sent to Double-A Bowie on July 25. Made four appearances (two starts) with Baysox and posted a 7.71 ERA in 14 innings, struck out 19 and gave up five homers.

2022: Began season with Triple-A Norfolk. Made two four-inning starts in April before suffering a right elbow injury. Underwent successful Tommy John surgery in May and missed rest of the season.

2021: Began first full season in Orioles system after trade. Started year in High-A Aberdeen and struck out 48 batters over 34.1 innings to an ERA of 2.36. Earned promotion to Double-A Bowie on June 22. Went five innings in six of his 11 starts and finished season with 75 K over 60.2 IP and an ERA of 3.86.

2019: Did not pitch a game while in LAA organization. Traded to BAL on Dec. 4, 2019, along with RHP Kyle Bradish, RHP Zach Peek, and RHP Isaac Mattson for RHP Dylan Bundy.

Personal: Drafted in the 8th round of the 2019 MLB Draft by the Los Angeles Angels out of Elon University. Pitched three seasons at Elon and was named a Consensus All-American in 2018. Struck out 360 batters in 281 career collegiate innings.

Boasting a desire to better represent the Chesapeake Bay area, Bowie's "Cangrejos Fantasmas de Chesapeake" identity came to light after research presented the existence of the small, yet active Atlantic Ghost Crab species in the bay.



CHESAPEAKE BAYSOX

On Sunday, May 26, the Bowie Baysox will take the field as the "Chesapeake Baysox." This alternate identity was created to celebrate and learn about the conservation of the nearby Chesapeake Bay. The uniform tops are detailed with stenciled outlines of local wildlife, design, and architecture around the Chesapeake Bay.

In addition to activities around Prince George's Stadium promoting the conservation of the Chesapeake Bay, the jerseys will be auctioned off following the May 26 contest, with proceeds benefitting the Chesapeake Bay Foundation.



BOWIE PIT BEEF

The "Bowie Pit Beef" is an alternate identity of the Bowie Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland. The Baysox will take the field as the Bowie Pit Beef on both June 23 and August 4.

Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore's east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s



COACHING STAFF

ROBERTO MERCADO

Manager

The 17th manager in Baysox franchise history, Mercado spent each of the past two seasons as the manager of the High-A Aberdeen IronBirds. He was honored with the Orioles organization's Cal Ripken, Sr. Player Development Award following his first season with Aberdeen in 2022. Prior to the start of his professional career, Mercado spent 17 years on the coaching staff at New Britain High School in Connecticut. He began as an assistant coach in 2004 before being promoted to head varsity coach in 2011. In addition to coaching the New Britain baseball team, Mercado served as the Dean of Students for over 18 years. He also spent time as an assistant coach of the Yarmouth Dennis Red Sox in the Cape Cod Baseball League from 2014-2022 and was a coach in the Goodwill Series, where high school baseball players from the United States competed overseas in both Australia and New Zealand in 2017 and 2018.

Pitching Coach

Meine joins Mercado in the move from High-A Aberdeen. Meine served as the IronBirds pitching coach in 2023, where he helped Aberdeen post the third-lowest ERA (3.81) and second-most strikeouts (1,363) across the South Atlantic League. He previously spent two seasons on staff at the University of North Carolina at Charlotte, where he guided the 49ers to the two highest single-season strikeout totals in program history. Meine has also worked on staff at the Premier Pitching and Performance facility in Missouri. He pitched collegiately at Lindenwood University.

JOSH BUNSELMAYER

Hitting Coach

Bunselmayer served as the hitting coach for the Orioles' Single-A affiliate, the Delmarva Shorebirds, last season. 2024 is Bunselmayer's fifth season in the Orioles' system after also spending the previous three campaigns as a hitting coach in both the Florida Complex League and Dominican Summer League.
