SUNDAY: The Captains won their third straight and secured a series win with a 7-2 win at Dayton. **José Tena** hit two solo homers for his second two home run game of the season. **Raynel Delgado** knocked in four runs with a three-run homer and an RBI single. Both of Dayton's runs came on solo home runs. Mariel Bautista hit one in the third and Garrett Wolforth went deep in the ninth. Captains starter **Mason Hickman** notched his third straight win, allowing just one run over five innings.

GOING STREAKING: With their win on Sunday, the Captains have won three straight games for the first time since their four-game winning streak from June 15-18. The Captains have scored seven runs or more in every game of this streak. It is the first time this year Lake County has scored seven or more runs in three consecutive games.

TALE OF TWO SERIES: Two weeks ago, the Captains lost four of six games to the Great Lakes Loons at home. They surrendered 20 home runs and had a -29 run differential (20 R, 49 RA). Last week, the Captains won four of six at Dayton. They surrendered just three homers during the series (one of which was an inside-the-park home run) and had a +16 run differential (26 R, 20 RA).

MOVING UP: Three of the Captains' most impactful position players have been called up to Double-A Akron in the last week. INF **Brayan Rocchio** (#7 CLE Prospect - MLB.com) and C **Bryan Lavastida** (#24 CLE Prospect - MLB.com) were promoted last Friday. OF **Will Brennan** was called up today. Rocchio departed as the team leader in homers with nine. Lavastida exited as the team leader in batting average at .303 and fresh off a 22-game on-base streak from June 24 to July 24, during which he hit .395/.479/.684. Brennan was sixth among qualified High-A Central League hitters in average at .290 and exits at second in the league with 22 doubles.

JULY IN REVIEW: The Captains closed July with the second-best team ERA (4.00) in the High-A Central League during the month, despite allowing the second-most home runs (38). Offensively, the Captains were third in the league in on-base percentage (.347), fifth in slugging percentage (.405) and fourth in runs scored (149).

SUPER NOVA: **Victor Nova** hit .294/.388/.559 (.946 OPS) in the month of July. Over the first two months of the season, he hit .179/.295/.241 (.536 OPS) with one home run in 37 games. Nova started July hot, hitting .412 with four home runs over his first 10 games. He cooled off at the end of the month, hitting .176 with no home runs over his final 10 games of July.

VALERA RAKES AND TAKES: **George Valera** finished July with a team-best six homers and an even K-BB rate. Valera struck out 23 times and walked 23 times during the month. His 21.1% BB% is up from 11.1% in May-June.

ALL OR NOTHING: In his last 10 games, **José Tena** does not have a single one-hit game. The Captains' shortstop has either delivered multiple hits or gone hitless since July 21. He is hitting .263/.364/.500 (.864 OPS) in that span. After his three-hit game on Sunday, Tena pulled his season OPS above .800 for the first time since July 2.

HOME COOKIN' TASTES BETTER: The Captains are 20-10 at home, compared to 22-26 on the road. Captains pitchers have experienced the biggest home/road disparity. Lake County has a 3.79 ERA at Classic Park and a 4.58 ERA on the road.

ALUMNI UPDATE: 2017 Captains RHP **Justin Garza** became the 102nd former Captain to reach the major leagues when he debuted for Cleveland on June 27. A record 10 former Captains have made their major league debuts this year - OF **Ka'ai Tom** (2016), RHP **Luis Oviedo** (2018-19), LHP **Sam Hentges** (2016), RHP **Louis Head** (2012-13), RHP **Nick Sandlin** (2018), INF **Ivan Castillo** (2014), **Jean Carlos Mejia** (2018), RHP **Eli Morgan** (2018), INF **Ernie Clement** (2018) and Garza. That breaks the record for the most former Captains to debut in a single year, besting the nine alumni that debuted in 2013 and 2016.

LAST TIME OUT: Draper worked his longest start of the season against Dayton in his second start with the Captains in 2021. The Dragons took a 1-0 lead with an unearned run in the second inning after an error at third base by Victor Nova. Three consecutive singles in the third inning loaded the bases for Dayton with nobody out. However, Draper induced a double play and another groundout to sacrifice one run but escape the jam without further damage. A James Free double in the fourth along with two more singles and the second Captains error of the game brought in two more Dragons runs to go on top 4-0. Lake County's offense was held quiet by spot starter JC Keys and the Dragons bullpen outside of one tally in the eighth inning for a 4-1 Dayton win.

2021: Assigned to Triple-A Columbus on May 23 and made four appearances out of the Clippers' bullpen, posting an 8.31 ERA. Transferred to Double-A Akron on June 11. Made three starts and four relief appearances for the RubberDucks, posting a 6.43 ERA. Transferred to Lake County on July 21.

COLLEGE OF IDAHO HISTORY: Draper was drafted in the same year as his College of Idaho teammate, Riley O'Brien, a right-handed pitcher who the Tampa Bay Rays selected in the eighth round in 2017. It was the first time two C of I Yotes were drafted in the same year since 1996, when the Montreal Expos selected Kurt Alderman in the 15th round and the St. Louis Cardinals picked Tim Lincecum in the 28th round.

COLLEGE ACCOLADES: Draper earned All-NAIA West honors in both of his seasons at the College of Idaho (2016 & 2017).

WEST COAST LEAGUE: Draper was named the WCL Pitcher of the Year in 2016 after posting an 8-0 record with a 0.72 ERA. He did not allow an earned run in July, tossing 35 shutout innings.

COLLEGE TRANSFER: Transferred to the College of Idaho after two seasons at the College of Southern Idaho. He was initially signed to play at the University of Central Florida.

COLLEGE TEAMMATE LINEAGE: Draper's college teammate, Tampa Bay Rays pitching prospect Riley O'Brien, is the grandson of former Pittsburgh Pirates infielder Johnny O'Brien. Johnny and his twin brother Eddie O'Brien played together on the Pirates in the 1950's and even formed the Bucs' double play combo (one of four pairs of brothers to play together up the middle in MLB history) in their rookie season of 1953 (Eddie at shortstop and Johnny at second). Johnny was mostly a second baseman during his six-year career, but also pitched 25 times, including 16 appearances (one start) in 1957. Eddie also pitched five times (one start) during his career with Pittsburgh, though he was primarily a shortstop and centerfielder. In addition, the pair played basketball at Seattle University where they upset the Harlem Globetrotters and were both drafted by the NBA's Milwaukee Hawks in 1953, though neither signed. In basketball, Johnny earned the distinction as the first player in NCAA history to score 1,000 points in a season and was the shortest player to be named an All-American (5'9") until 2016.
