RHP PEDRO AVILA (7-2, 4.62) VS. LHP LOGAN ALLEN (0-3, 6.95)

TODAY'S GAME: The Isotopes play their final home game of the 2022 season. It is the first time Albuquerque has finished a season at home since 2014. Logan Allen will take the hill for his sixth start with the Isotopes.

SAM I AM: Sam Hilliard has 62 career homers with Albuquerque, four away from tying franchise home run leader Jordan Patterson.

CP: Pérez is 12-for-30 with three doubles, three homers and nine RBI over his last seven games ... Blasted his 31st homer of the season Monday—tying his career-high set with Las Vegas in 2021. He is sixth on the all-time single season homer list.

FAN FAVORITE: Wynton Bernard belted his sixth game-opening homer of the year—breaking the previous record of five set by Tony Abreu in 2009 ... Has team-leading 44 multi-hit efforts of the season and tenth since returning to the Isotopes lineup on August 31. Additionally, he recorded his team-leading 30th multi-RBI game ... Is the 14th Isotope to reach the 90 RBI plateau.

30 STOLEN BASES: Bernard also stole his 30th bag of the year—the seventh Isotopes to swipe 30 bags in a season and first since Joc Pederson 2014. He is the second player in Isotopes history to tally a 20-30 season, also Pederson in 2014.

DINGERS: Albuquerque has hit 239 homers on the year—the most in all of MiLB. El Paso is second with 221. The Isotopes are also second in all of pro ball (New York Yankees, 242).

20 HOMERS: Montes hit his 20th homer Monday. He joins Pérez, Bernard, Sean Bouchard and D.J. Peterson with 20-plus homers—the first time in team history five players hit 20-plus.

DOYLE: Brenton Doyle struck out five times in a game for the first time in his professional career. It was the first platinum sombrero for an Isotopes hitter since Lucas May (6 Ks) on July 19, 2010 at Nashville ... Recorded his second two-homer game this season Mnday (August 26 with Double-A Hartford) and his first five RBI game of his career. It was just his third career two homer game. Over eight games with the Isotopes, he is slashing 382/432/.765 (13x34) with two doubles, three homers, eight RBI and three walks. He has four multi-hit efforts as well.

DOUBLE-TROUBLE: Albuquerque turned four double plays last night, tying a season-high reached on two prior occasions: most recently Sept. 7 vs. El Paso (Game 2 of DH).

DELAYS: The start of the game was delayed 30 minutes due to rain, Albuquerque's 17th delay of the season and 14th at home. The cumulative delay time is 15:53 overall, and 11:56 at home.

SLUGGING: The Isotopes have a .484 slugging percentage—the second-highest mark in team history behind the 2019 squad that slugged .500.

HITS IN A SEASON: Albuquerque is just three hits away from eclipsing 1,400 hits for the year. It would be the seventh time the Isotopes will hit that plateau in team history. The team record for hits in a season is 1,533 set in 2010.

ATTENDANCE: The Isotopes lead the PCL in average attendance (7,040) and are second in total attendance (506,879) with two fewer openings than the PCL leader, Las Vegas (518,221). They are the only PCL squad to average over 7,000. In all of MiLB, Albuquerque is eighth in total attendance and average.

STRIKEOUT RECORD: Karl Kauffmann's strikeout of Pedro León Thursday was the 1,136th of the season for Albuquerque's pitching staff—setting a new single-season team record, eclipsing the 1,135 punchouts by the 2013 team, in 144 games.

TAKE FLIGHT: Jimmy Herron extended his on-base streak to 15 games. During the stretch, he is slashing .346/.426/.654 with three doubles, two triples, three homers, seven RBI and two steals. Herron has raised his batting average from .220 to .266 since the streak began. ... tied for the third-longest active streak in PCI

HOMER HISTORY: D.J. Peterson's grand slam Sept. 9 was the 213th homer by the Isotopes this year—a new franchise record.

PCL LEADER BOARD: Wynton Bernard is first in average (.334), slugging (.593) and OPS (.982), second in hits (142), tied for second in extra-base hits (60), third in total bases (252), RBI (92), fifth in OBP (.389) and runs (95), tied for seventh in doubles (31) and tied for seventh in stolen bases (30). ... Carlos Perez is tied for second in XBH (57), third in homers (31), fourth in slugging (.528), fifth in total bases (239) and RBI (87) ... Coco Montes is eighth in slugging (.500), tenth in OPS (.859) and runs (82) ... Zach Lee is first in games pitched (63) while Julian Fernandez is second (57) ... Zach Lee is sixth in saves (11).

Wynton Bernard's grand slam Sept. 16 was the Isotopes 14th of the season— breaking the all-time MiLB single-season record set by the 1995 Indianapolis Indians. They are now tied with the 2000 Oakland Athletics and 2006 Cleveland Indians for the most in professional basehall history.

Wynton Bernard's stolen base Saturday was his 30th of the season—becoming just the second Isotopes player to tally a 20-30 season (Joc Pederson 30-30 in 2014).

THIS DAY IN BASEBALL HISTORY

2016: The Houston Astros played against the Seattle Mariners in their final home game of the 2016 season—the last contest with Tal's Hill in center field. The Hill was constructed in honor of former team president Tal Smith and had a 90-ft. wide incline inspired by Crosley Field and Fenway park. It also had a flagpole, inspired by old Yankee Stadium, on the upper left-hand side of the hill. Tal's Hill had a 30 degree incline, doubling the incline of Crosely's. The hill was originally scheduled to be removed in 2015 as part of a \$15 million renovation. However, because the Astros made the playoffs, along with other delays, the renovation had to be postponed. After the renovation, the center field fence moved in from 436 ft. to 409 ft.
