FRES-NOTES

HOME, SWEET HOME: The Grizzlies are 2-1 to start the second half and kick off a stretch of home games with 15 of the next 18 games at Chukchansi Park prior to the All-Star Break. The Grizzlies were 18-15 at home in the first half and won four of six series in Downtown Fresno. The Grizzlies are 11-10 this season against the three north division rivals that comprise the next three weeks of the home schedule and the next five weeks overall.

BIG CAT>SMALL E.R.A.: Tuesday's starter for the Grizzlies, Everett Catlett, has the fourth lowest ERA in the California League among qualified pitchers posting a 4.25 ERA in 17 appearances and 8 starts this year. Catlett is 2-1 in eight games at Chukchansi Park with a 1.87 ERA making five starts. He's also responded well in 8 games as a starter, posting a 2.57 ERA in 42 innings, averaging just under 6 innings per start.

SWINGING FOR THE FENCES: The Grizzlies hit seven home runs in Visalia last week, the most of any series this season. The three multi-homer games were also the most of any series this year for the Grizzlies and they were 2-1 in those contests. 16 of the Grizzlies 29 homers this year have come on the road but they have hit 13 in 33 home games at Chukchansi Park. They already have 14 homers in the month of June with six games remaining. Fresno hit 7 homers in April and 8 in May.
