Scouting Report: The Patriots play the second of a six-game series against the Erie Sea-Wolves at UPMC Park tonight. In the series opener, the SeaWolves hit three home runs, ths most the Patriots have allowed in a single game this season. The SeaWolves sit just 2.5 games behind Bowie for the top spot in the Southwest Division and lead all of Double-A with a .273 batting average. Erie features top-five Tigers prospect Riley Greene, who is hitting .267 with six home runs and 21 RBI in 30 games this season.

Peraza Party: The New York Yankees announced top-five prospect Oswald Peraza has been transferred from Hudson Valley to Somerset on Tuesday. In his Patriots debut, Peraza went 0-for-4 but did start a double play on a sliding stop to his left. In 28 games with the Renegadees, Peraza hit .306 with 10 doubles, five home runs and 16 stolen bases while only being caught once. Baseball America lists Peraza as the No. 6 prospect in the Yankees' organization and rated him the best infield arm in the Yankees' system in both 2020 and 2021.

Sandstorm: C Donny Sands continued his team-best 16-game on-base streak after collecting two hits in last night's contest. Over the 16 games, Sands is 20-for-63 (.317) and has reached base at a .394 clip. He has also hit safely in six straight games carrying a .400 batting average over that stretch.

Boy Am I Impressive: The Patriots swept this week's Double-A Northeast League Awards. Diego Castillo was named the position player of the week while JP Sears earned pitcher of the week honors. Castillo 10-for-20 (.500) with three doubles, three home runs, five runs and four RBI in five games. Sears made two appearances, including his first start of the season. Over six innings of work, Sears allowed just an unearned run on three hits with one walk and 10 strikeouts.

Digging the Long-Ball: Dermis Garcia hit his 11th home run of the season last night. He is now tied for the most in all of Double-A (Johan Mieses) and has the third most in all of the minors. The Patriots now have 40 home runs collectively on the season, second-most in the Double-A Northeast League (41, Bowie) and fifth-most in all of Double-A (46, Northwest Arkansas).

Hits and Misses: The Patriots pitching staff owns the lowest ERA (3.15) in all of Double-A baseball. The team has also struck out the most batters (358), tied for second-lowest WHIP (1.12) and own second-lowest batting average against (.199) amongst all Double-A teams.

Fought the Phils: The Patriots took four of six games against the Reading Fightin Phils last week. Somerset hit 11 home runs including five in the first game of the series. Donny Sands finished the series 8-for-21 (.381) with 2 HR. The Patriots finished their 11-game homestand with seven wins.
