### TONIGHT'S GAME

The Round Rock Express hold a 2-1 series lead against the El Paso Chihuahuas ahead of Sunday's contest. Express LHP Wade LeBlanc is scheduled to start against Chihuahuas RHP Evan Miller. First pitch at Dell Diamond is set for 6:05 p.m.

### ABOUT LAST NIGHT

The Round Rock Express scored 12 unanswered runs to overcome a 9-0 deficit and defeat the El Paso Chihuahuas by a final score of 12-9 on Saturday. El Paso plated three runs in the third inning when C Michael Cantu drew a leadoff walk before LF John Andreoli hit a home run to left field. CF Brian O'Grady then hit a triple and crossed home on a Patrick Kivlehan base hit. The Chihuahuas took a 9-0 lead with six runs in the fourth. 3B Nick Tanielu walked and was followed by back-to-back singles from 1B Gosuke Katoh and Cantu to load the bases. SS Pedro Florimón drew a walk, scoring Tanielu. Katoh followed on a sacrifice fly from 2B Ivan Castillo. O'Grady then hit a threerun homer, scoring Cantu and Florimón. Kivlehan scored the sixth run with a solo homer. Round Rock started its rally in the bottom of the fourth as Ibáñez hit a three-run homer, scoring C John Hicks and DH Curtis Terry to trim El Paso's lead to 9-3. The Express tallied four more in the fifth as LF Leody Taveras, 1B Eli White, Terry and Ibáñez scored on a combination of two walks, two base hits, a double and a groundout. Round Rock took a 10-9 lead in the sixth as CF Delino DeShields drew a leadoff walk before moving to third and scoring via singles from Tayeras and White. Hicks added a hit, scoring Taveras then White for the go-ahead run. The E-Train added two last runs in the eighth when Ibáñez hit a single to score White and Hicks.

### LEBLANC ON THE MOUND

Round Rock LHP Wade LeBlanc is scheduled to make his second start for the Express on Sunday. In his first outing on June 1 at Salt Lake, the lefty allowed three runs on five hits in 5.0 innings while striking out eight. LeBlanc limited Salt Lake's many left-handed hitters to a .154 (2-13) average.

### JUST KEEP SWIPING

The Express went 4-4 in stolen bases on Saturday night, marking the sixth time this season Round Rock totaled four or more swipes in a single contest. The E-Train's 41 total stolen bases ranks second among all Triple-A teams, eight behind the league's leader, Syracuse. INF Anderson Tejeda has totaled eight stolen bases this season and sits tied for fifth in the overall Triple-A rankings and second in the Triple-A West League in the category.

### RUNS BATTED IBÁÑEZ

Round Rock INF Andy Ibáñez tallied a season-high six RBI in Saturday's win, bringing in half of the Express runs on three hits. The third baseman was a triple short of hitting for the cycle as he recorded an RBI single, RBI double and three-run home run. Ibáñez extended his current hitting streak to 10 games and recorded seven total bases in the win.

### SECURING THE SAVE

RHP Ryder Ryan earned the save for Round Rock in Saturday night's 12-9 win for his first of the season in his 10th relief appearance. Ryan recorded a hitless 1.1 innings and struck out a season-high four batters to close out the night and keep El Paso off the board, securing Round Rock's unanswered rally.

### IT RUNS IN THE RIVALRY

Round Rock's impressive 12-run comeback against El Paso marked the second time the home team has recovered from a nine-run deficit to earn the win in the last two series between the teams. On August 9, 2019, the last time the two met prior to Thursday's series opener, the Chihuahuas depleted the Express' seventh-inning 12-3 lead to win the contest 15-12, thanks to a 10-run ninth inning capped by a walk-off grand slam in El Paso.

### STATING THE FACTS

American-born players on Round Rock's roster hail from 14 different states: California, Florida, Georgia, Illinois, Kansas, Louisiana, Maryland, Nevada, New York, North Carolina, South Carolina, Texas, Utah and Virginia. RHP Jake Lemoine is the lone Texan on the roster, hailing from Bridge City. Lemoine was a standout pitcher at the University of Houston before being drafted by the Texas Rangers in 2012.

Six different nations are represented on the Express roster. In addition to the 21 players from the United States, INF Charles Leblanc is Canadian, INF Andy Ibáñez was born in Cuba, INF Anderson Tejeda and OF Leody Taveras hail from the Dominican Republic, RHP Jharel Cotton is a native of the U.S. Virgin Islands and C Yohel Pozo and INF Yonny Hernandez are Venezuelan.

### EXPRESS MANAGER KENNY HOLMBERG

The 2021 season marks Round Rock Express Manager Kenny Holmberg's 13th year in the Texas Rangers organization. In 2020, he worked with Rangers prospects at the Alternate Training Site in Arlington, as well as the Fall Developmental League in Arizona. Round Rock will be the fourth different club for which Holmberg has managed in the Rangers farm system after serving at the helm of Short-Season Spokane in 2018, the Rookie-level Arizona League Rangers from 2013-2015 and the Rookie-level Dominican Summer League Rangers from 2010-2011. He has compiled a 207-172 (.546) record while leading his clubs to the postseason in four of his six managerial campaigns, including a Northwest League championship series appearance in 2018. He originally joined the Texas organization as a coach for the DSL Rangers in 2009 and



also served as a coach for the club's High-A affiliate in Myrtle Beach in 2012. In addition to his managerial post for the Express, Holmberg also serves as the Rangers' Major League Infield Coordinator.

An infielder in his playing days, Holmberg was selected by Milwaukee in the 22nd round of the 2005 MLB draft and played four seasons in the Brewers organization. He compiled a .272 average with 34 home runs and 187 RBI over 338 career minor league games. Holmberg was also selected by the Toronto Blue Jays in the 49th round of the 2001 MLB draft out of Dunedin High School in Florida but opted to play collegiately at St. Petersburg College from 2002-2003. He then spent two seasons at Embry-Riddle Aeronautical University, earning first-team NAIA All-America honors in 2005.
