#### By the Numbers

Lake County has been in 1st place in the Midwest League East overall standings for the last 38 days, a stretch dating back to May 28. <u>Since then, the Captains are 21-12 and are tied for 10th in MiLB with a .636 win percentage in that span.</u>

RHP Carter Spivey manufactured 8 shutout innings in Thursday's 6-5 loss in 10 innings. Spivey's 8 innings are in a start in his college, collegiate summer, and professional

402 Lake County leads the Midwest League and ranks  $3^{\text{rd}}$  in High-A with 402 runs (5.2 per game), its most through 77 games since the 2007 Captains scored 455 in this span.

## **CAPTAINS LOG**

LAST TIME OUT: RHP Carter Spivey pitched a Minor League best 8 shutout innings, but Lake County came up short in a 6-5 loss to Dayton in 10 innings on Thursday at Classic Auto Group Park.

A 4<sup>TH</sup> TO REMEMBER: Spivey earned his 7<sup>th</sup> quality start of the season, allowing no runs on 4 hits while fanning 7 across a career-high 8 innings. No previous Captains team since 2005 had more than 2 8-inning starts. The 2024 Captains staff has 4 (Trenton Denholm – 2, Carter Spivey, Austin Peterson).

STRIKING FIRST: In the bottom of the 8th, the Captains struck for 3 runs on an RBI double by 2B Jose Devers (12), MLB Pipeline's No. 19 Cleveland prospect, and a solo home run by 1B Maick Collado (2), his 1st home run since April 16 versus Lansing.

EXTRA, EXTRA: After Dayton scored 3 in the top of the 9th off RHP Jay Driver, his first 2 earned runs allowed in 82 days, the Dragons scored 3 in the top of the 10th off a 2-run double by 3B Sal Stewart and an RBI single by DH Cam Collier. In the bottom of the 10th, C Cooper Ingle, MLB Pipeline's No. 30 Cleveland prospect, blasted a 2-out, 2-run home run (5), but Dayton RHP John Murphy then got the final out to secure the win.

ANGEL ON THE INFIELD: SS Angel Genao, MLB Pipeline's No. 11 Cleveland prospect, went 3-for-5 in Wednesday's, his 4<sup>th</sup> 3-hit game as a Captain. *He is batting .361 (13-for-36) since June 25, tied for the 9th-best clip in the MWL in that span.* Genao is 2<sup>nd</sup> in Single/High-A with 91 hits across Lake County and Single-A Lynchburg, hitting safely in 13 of his last 16 games. *Genao is the only player in Minor League Baseball with a .325+ AVG, 30+ XBH, and 15+ SB this season.* 

DOMINANT DEBUTS: On June 27, Captains RHP Rorik Maltrud earned his 1st High-A win in his 1st High-A start, allowing 1 run on 4 hits while striking out 5. On June 28, former Captains RHP Austin Peterson struck out 10 and earned his 9th quality start of the season in his Double-A debut for Akron. Also in his Double-A debut, former Captains LHP Parker Messick pitched 5 no-hit innings versus Binghamton on June 23.

THIS IS 40: The Captains won their 40th game of the season in their 65th contest, becoming the fastest team in franchise history to win 40 games since the 2010 Midwest League Championship Team won 40 in 61 games.

#### **TRENDS & NOTABLES**

NGLE'S HAT TRICK: C Cooper Ingle went 3-for-5 with a 2-run home run in Thursday's loss, marking his team-best 7th 3+ hit game of the year. Ingle's .330 AVG and .924 OPS are the 3rd-highest by a Captain (min. 200 PA) through a team's first 78 team games since 2005.

STARS AND STRIKES: Lake County leads the Midwest League with a 3.60 ERA, surrendering just 302 runs, tied for the 11th-fewest in MiLB. Captains starters lead the MWL with 383 strikeouts, while the bullpen is 2nd in the MWL with a 3.57 ERA.

THE BATTLE OF TRENTON: RHP Trenton Denholm ranks tied for 3<sup>rd</sup> in the Midwest League in quality starts (6), 3<sup>rd</sup> in WHIP (1.04), 4<sup>th</sup> in ERA (3.39) and is 1 of 2 Midwest Leaguers to pitch a 7-inning complete game shutout (5/9 vs. Dayton). <u>Denholm won 7 games in his first 11 starts</u>, the fastest Captain 7-game winner since Ryan Miller won 7 in 10 appearances and 9 starts in 2008.

TRIPLE ENTENTE: INF Alex Mooney, OF Jonah Advincula and OF Guy Lipscomb are the 1st Captains trio to steal 20-plus bases in Lake County's first 74 team games of a season since 2012. 4 Captains that stole 20-plus bags in 74 team games, 1 of them being current New York Mets SS and 4-time MLB All-Star Francisco Lindor.

REAL STEAL: The Captains have stolen 138 bases through their first 78 games, their most through their 1st 78 games since at least 2005. <u>Lake</u> County ranks 3rd in MiLB with an 88.5% stolen base percentage.

NAVAL POWER: LHP Matt "Tugboat" Wilkinson eclipsed 100 strikeouts on June 25 versus Great Lakes, and now ranks 3<sup>rd</sup> in MiLB with 108 strikeouts this season. He and current Guardians LHP Logan Allen are the only Cleveland Minor Leaguers since at least 2005 to reach 100-plus strikeouts through a team's first 70 games. Allen fanned 104 with Double-A Akron in 2022.

THE ATLANTIC CAMPAIGN: Since 2021, 11 of Cleveland's draft picks have come from the Atlantic Coast Conference (ACC), including 6 in the 2023 MLB Draft. Of those 11 ACC draftees, 5 have played for the Captains this year (LHP Parker Messick, OF Angel Zarate, 1B/LF C.J. Kayfus, C Cooper Ingle, and INF Alex Mooney), with 5 total '23 draftees being Top 30 Cleveland prospects by MLB Pipeline.

PROSPECTING: Cleveland has experienced a gold rush of prospects, with 5 current Lake County Captains and 6 2023 draftees listed among Cleveland's Top 30 prospects by MLB Pipeline. The latest is C Cooper Ingle, who is MLB Pipeline's No. 30 Cleveland prospect, replacing 2021 Captain and current Cleveland Guardians SS José Tena who graduated from prospect status on Sunday.

**LAST TIME OUT: Trenton Denholm** (7-2) earned his 2<sup>nd</sup> loss of the season on June 30 versus Great Lakes, pitching 4.1 innings, allowing 9 runs (6 earned) on 6 hits, striking out 4 and walking 5 in the 12-10 loss. **Denholm** threw 59 of 94 pitches for strikes (62.8%).

**MIDWEST LEAGUE RANKS: Denholm** ranks top-10 in the Midwest League in: Wins (7, T-1st), innings pitched (79.2, 2nd), ERA (3.39, 3rd), WHIP (1.04, T-3rd), opposing AVG (.218, 5th) and ground ball rate (42.2%, 6th). He is also 1 of just 3 Midwest League pitchers to throw a complete game this season, and 1 of 2 to toss a shutout (May 10 versus Dayton (Game 1)).

THE GREAT EIGHT: On May 22 versus West Michigan and June 15 versus Fort Wayne, Denholm pitched 8+ innings. Back on May 22 versus West Michigan, Denholm pitched a Minor League-best 8.1 innings, the most by a Lake County pitcher since RHP Joe Colón also pitched 8.1 frames on 5/14/2022 vs. Great Lakes. Denholm allowed 3 runs on 5 hits while not recording a strikeout. He is the first Captain since at least 2005 to throw 8+ innings without recording a strikeout.

MIDWEST LEAGUE PITCHER OF THE WEEK: Denholm earned Midwest League Pitcher of the Week honors the week of May 6-12 after tossing a complete game shutout in 7 innings on May 10 versus Dayton. Denholm pitched Lake County's first 7-inning complete game since current Double-A Akron RHP Aaron Davenport recorded a CG SHO on 9/4/2022 at Great Lakes.

**HILLCAT ON THE HILL: Denholm** pitched his 1<sup>st</sup> professional season in 2022, making 23 starts for the Single-A Lynchburg Hillcats. The right-hander finished the season with a 5-5 record, 4.79 ERA, and 107 strikeouts in 97.2 innings pitched.

**AWESOME ANTEATER: Denholm** had a strong collegiate career in his four seasons at UC Irvine. As a sophomore in 2019, the right-hander was named the 2019 Big West Pitcher of the Year, as well as a *Collegiate Baseball Newspaper* 3<sup>rd</sup> Team All-American, after finishing the campaign with a 9-4 record, 1.81 ERA, and 93 strikeouts in 99.2 innings pitched. This season resulted in **Denholm** being invited to the USA Collegiate National Team training camp, and being named to the Golden Spikes Award Watch List prior to both the 2020 and 2021 seasons.

**OTHER NOTABLE ANTEATERS:** Three-time MLB All-Star and former Boston/Baltimore/Cleveland OF Brady Anderson (1983-85), Keston Hiura (2015-17), former Cleveland pitcher David Huff (2004).

**BASEBALL IN THE FAMILY: Denholm's** mother, Judi, is cousins with former MLB catcher Rod Barajas. He played 14 MLB seasons with seven different teams, notably winning a World Series with the 2001 Arizona Diamondbacks. Barajas hit .235 in his MLB career, recording 812 hits, 136 home runs, 480 RBI, and 187 doubles in 14 seasons.

#### CAPTAINS TO THE MAINLAND

7 former Lake County Captains have been promoted to MLB during the 2024 season.

INF/OF Jhonkensy Noel: On Wednesday, June 26, INF/OF Jhonkensy Noel made his MLB debut for the Cleveland Guardians on the road against the Baltimore Orioles. He started at first base and batted 9th in the Guardians' order, finishing 1-for-4 with 2 strikeouts. In his 1st MLB at-bat, Noel hit a 413-foot solo home run to center field, becoming the 4th player in Cleveland franchise history to homer in his 1st career MLB at-bat. He was the first to do so since 2004 Captain Kevin Kouzmanoff, who became the 1st player in MLB history to hit a grand slam on his 1st MLB pitch on September 2, 2006. Noel played 88 regular-season games for the Captains across the 2021 and 2022 seasons, hitting .238 with 78 hits, 12 doubles, 27 home runs, 67 RBI, a .521 SLG, and an .827 OPS.

**LHP Raymond Burgos:** On Monday, June 24, **LHP Raymond Burgos** made his MLB debut for the San Francisco Giants at home against the Chicago Cubs. He pitched 1 inning of relief, allowing 3 hits, 1 earned run, and 1 walk, while throwing 1 strikeout. **Burgos** made 48 regular-season appearances (11 starts) for the Captains across the 2019, 2021, and 2022 seasons, going 10-6 with a 2.83 ERA, 115 strikeouts, a 1.29 WHIP, a .255 opposing batting average, and 8 holds, converting 1 of his 2 save opportunities. He also made 3 postseason relief appearances for Lake County in 2022, tallying a 4.26 ERA, 6 strikeouts, 2 walks, and a .150 opposing batting average, converting his lone save opportunity in Game 2 of the Midwest League East Championship Series.

**INF Angel Martínez:** On Saturday, June 22, **INF Angel Martínez** made his MLB debut for the Cleveland Guardians at home against the Toronto Blue Jays. He started at designated hitter and batted 9<sup>th</sup> in the Guardians' order, going 0-for-3 with 1 strikeout. **Martínez** played 77 regular-season games for the Captains in 2022, hitting .288 with 81 hits, 17 doubles, 3 triples, 10 home runs, 27 RBI, 10 stolen bases, and an .861 OPS.

**INF/OF Daniel Schneemann:** On Sunday, June 2, **INF Daniel Schneemann** made his MLB debut for the Cleveland Guardians at home against the Washington Nationals. He started at 2<sup>nd</sup> base and batted 8<sup>th</sup> in the Guardians' order, going 1-for-3 with a 2-run double on his first MLB pitch and a strikeout. **Schneemann** played 98 regular-season games for the Captains across the 2018, 2019, and 2021 seasons, hitting .267 with 86 hits, 13 doubles, 3 triples, 5 home runs, 43 RBI, 12 stolen bases, and a .711 OPS. He also played 3 postseason games for Lake County in 2019, hitting .182 (2-for-11) with 2 runs, 2 RBI, and 1 walk.

**1B/OF Trenton Brooks:** On Tuesday, May 28, **1B/OF Trenton Brooks** made his MLB debut for the San Francisco Giants at home against the Philadelphia Phillies. He started at 1<sup>st</sup> base and batted 9<sup>th</sup> in the Giants' order, going 0-for-2 with 1 strikeout. **Brooks** played 29 games for the Captains in 2017, hitting .214 with 24 hits, 5 doubles, 1 home run, 8 RBI, 12 walks, and a .588 OPS.

**OF Johnathan Rodríguez:** On Tuesday, May 21, **OF Johnathan Rodríguez** made his MLB debut for the Cleveland Guardians at home against the New York Mets. He started in right field and batted 7<sup>th</sup> in the Guardians' order, going 0-for-4 with 2 strikeouts. **Rodríguez** played 103 games for the Captains across the 2021 and 2022 seasons, hitting .275 with 103 hits, 20 doubles, 23 home runs, 70 RBI, and an .862 OPS. In 2022, he led the Midwest League with 21 home runs.

RHP Cade Smith: On Saturday, March 30, RHP Cade Smith made his MLB debut for the Cleveland Guardians on the road against the Oakland Athletics. He pitched 2 scoreless, hitless innings of relief, allowing just 1 walk and throwing 5 strikeouts. Smith made 23 relief appearances for the Captains across the 2021 and 2022 seasons, going 2-1 with a 2.67 ERA, 48 strikeouts, a 1.11 WHIP, and a .156 opposing batting average, converting 6 of his 7 save opportunities.
