and the second of six in Reading. Binghamton leads the season-series 4-3, and the teams split a six-game series in Binghamton from Apr. 16-21. Reading went 4-14 against Binghamton last season, including a 2-10 record at home.

The Fightin Phils continue a six-game series on Wednesday with the Binghamton Rumble Ponies. It's the eighth of 18 matchups between the teams this season,

Looking Back

Leading Off

Reading fell in the series opener, 6-5, on Tuesday morning. Reading trailed 4-0 at one point, but made it 4-3, thanks to home runs from Jose Rodriguez, Kendall Simmons and Casey Martin. The Fightin Phils tied it at five with two runs in the bottom of the eighth, but Tyler McKay walked and hit a batter, and ultimately took the loss, allowing one run in the ninth. Caleb Ricketts and Rodriguez each had two hits for the Fightin Phils in the loss. It marked just the second loss of the season for Reading when scoring five-or-more runs in a game (now 15-2).

Power Outage Restored

With a home run from Jose Rodriguez in the fourth inning on Tuesday, it snapped a seven-game homerless drought for the Fightin Phils, dating back to May 11 vs Hartford. In Tuesday's game, Reading matched a season-high with three home runs in a game, and also set a new season-best for home runs in an inning with two in the bottom of the fifth inning. Those two home runs in the fifth inning came on back-to-back blasts from Kendall Simmons and Casey Martin. It marked the first instance of back-to-back home runs this season for Reading, and the first time it's happened since Aug. 2, 2023, at Hartford, when Oliver Dunn and Jhailyn Ortiz did it. Binghamton starter Brandon Sproat allowed three home runs in the game, the most allowed by an opposing pitcher this season.

Allard on the Bump

Kolby Allard, who is on the Phillies 40-man roster, was transferred to Reading from the FCL-Phillies and will make the start tonight. Allard signed with the Phillies on January 23 and was optioned to Triple-A Lehigh Valley on March 19. Allard made eight appearances and three starts with the IronPigs and was 0-4, with a 10.71 ERA. The Phillies assigned Allard to the FCL-Phillies on May 9. Allard only appeared in six games last season between Atlanta (4) and Triple-A Gwinnett (2). Allard pitched for the Rangers from 2020-22, making his big-league debut with Texas in 2020. Allard is expected to pitch about three innings or 50 pitches on Wednesday night, and also appear on Sunday.

Noah's Arc-ing Up

Noah Skirrow is scheduled to pitch the bulk of the middle innings on Wednesday night, once Allard is finished. Skirrow has put together the two best outings of his season over his last two starts. After a month of April that saw Skirrow go 0-2, with an 11.81 ERA, Skirrow did not pitch for 10 days, as he was on the Development List during Reading's series in Portland from Apr. 30-May 5. Since coming off the Development List, Skirrow has been locked in during his two May starts. Following six-strong innings last night, Skirrow is 1-0, with a 0.82 ERA in May

Rodriguez Rolling

Jose Rodriguez has been rolling as of late. After hitting just .176 in April, Rodriguez is slashing .315/.345/.556, with a .901 OPS. He's added 13 runs, five dou bles, one triple, two home runs and 10 RBI in 14 games in May. Rodriguez has also only struck out four times in 58 May plate appearances. He has not struck out in nine-straight games, dating back to May 11, which is a total of 31 plate appearances.

Ponies Rumbling Into Reading

Binghamton enters today with a 21-17 record, which is first in the Eastern League's Northeast Division. The Rumble Ponies hosted the Bowie Baysox at home and took two-of-six games in the series, winning Tuesday and Sunday, and dropping four-straight in the middle. After this week, Binghamton returns to Mirabito Stadium and hosts Harrisburg for a six-game series. Binghamton's roster features 10 of the Mets' top-30 prospects: Jett Williams (1), Ryan Clifford (4), Kevin Parada (9), Blade Tidwell (10), Brandon Sproat (13), Alex Ramirez (16), Tyler Stuart (18), Nolan McLean (19), Joander Suarez (28) and Rhylan Thomas (30).
