**FRIDAY'S RECAP:** The New Hampshire Fisher Cats returned from the four-day All-Star break with a 7-2 win over the Altoona Curve on Friday night at Delta Dental Stadium. New Hampshire opened the scoring on a **Damiano Palmegiani** solo home run to left-field, his 11<sup>th</sup> homer of the year and his second home run in his last three games. Fisher Cats tacked on three in the second on an RBI single by **Sebastian Espino** and a two-run triple by **Steward Berroa**, only his second triple of the year. Starting right-hander **Sem Robberse** went five innings, giving up two runs on three hits and two walks while striking out four, picking up the win. Altoona collected a pair of runs in the third on a two-run homer by Matt Fraizer off Robberse but the Fisher Cats bullpen of right-hander **Andrew Bash**, left-hander **Mason Fluharty** and right-hander **T.J. Brock** combined for four scoreless innings of one-hit ball to close the door.

**BATS ARE HOT:** The Fisher Cats are now hitting a league-best .282 in the month of July, ahead of second-best Akron (.262). New Hampshire has scored the second-most runs (49) and leads the league in on-base percentage (.355) this month. This comes after New Hampshire had the second-lowest batting average in the month of June (.214) and scored a league-low 90 runs.

**PICKING UP THE SLACK:** The Fisher Cats 6-9 hitters accounted for seven of the 10 hits in last night's contest. **Sebastian Espino** led the way with a game-high three hits, his first three-hit game of the season while **Phil Clarke** hit two doubles and **Miguel Hiraldo** hit a two-run double in the eighth.

**PALMEGIANI POWER:** **Damiano Palmegiani** went 2-for-4 last night and launched his second home run in three games with a line drive solo shot in the first, his 11<sup>th</sup> of the season. The Blue Jays top 30 prospect is off to a hot start in the month of July, hitting .333 (12-for-36) with two homers, two doubles and five RBIs. He leads the team in multi-hit games this season with 19.

**IT'S BECAUSE HE GETS ON BASE:** IF **Leo Jimenez** reached base for the 19<sup>th</sup> straight game on Sunday, a new season-long on-base streak for the Fisher Cats middle infielder, after going 1-for-4 with a walk. The Blue Jays No. 19 prospect owns the two longest on-base streaks on the team this season at 19 games and 18 games. During this stretch, he is hitting .286 with a .390 on-base percentage with nine extra-base hits (6 2B, 2 HR, 1 3B) and 15 RBIs.

**DALLAS DAY:** RHP **Chad Dallas** makes his ninth Double-A start of the season tonight. The 23-year-old righty faces Altoona for the first time as he was still a member of High-A Vancouver when New Hampshire visited Altoona during the very first series of the season. While Dallas hasn't eclipsed five innings in his last two starts, he has struck out 21 hitters over his last 15.1 innings pitched.

**EASTERN LEAGUE PLAYERS OF THE WEEK:** LHP **Jimmy Robbins** and OF **Will Robertson** were named the Eastern League Pitcher and Player of the Week for July 3-9, respectively. Robbins tossed a career-high 7.1 innings Friday and did not allow a run in a win over Hartford. He took a no-hitter into the seventh and allowed just two hits, walked one batter, and struck out seven...Robertson had multiple hits in three of his five games played against the Yard Goats. In the series, Robertson hit .391 (9-for-23) with five extra-base hits and six RBIs. He is currently on a seven-game hit streak.

**THIS DAY IN FISHER CATS HISTORY (July 15, 2022)-** Paxton Schultz and Andrew Bash combined on a 1-0 win at Reading. Schultz went 6.2 innings before giving way to Bash, who finished up for his first NH save. The Fisher Cats scored in the sixth inning. Ryan Gold singled, advancing on a groundout. Cam Eden doubled him home.

**MANCHESTER-BOSTON REGIONAL AIRPORT FLIGHT TO THE MAJORS:** Toronto (51-41) scored five in the seventh and beat Arizona 7-2. Vladimir Guerrero Jr. homered in the second for the Blue Jays. Gabriel Moreno, who started 2021 with the Fisher Cats, homered for the Diamondbacks. Game two of the series this afternoon...Buffalo (41-46) won the series opener with Toledo 8-5 as Davis Schneider and Addison Barger both went deep. Hayden Juenger picked up his second save...Vancouver (49-32) won 4-2 over Eugene as Devonte Brown broke the tie with a sixth inning homer, his eighth...Dunedin (38-44) lost to the Marauders in Bradenton 8-6.

**COMING UP:** The Fisher Cats finish their homestand tomorrow against the Altoona Curve. Promotions for tomorrow include a Flag Giveaway Sunday, presented by Delta Dental.
