TODAY'S GAME: The Curve continue a six-game series at Erie, Altoona is 9-8 against the 'Wolves this year.

LAST TIME OUT: Aaron Shackelford swatted a 3-run bomb and put away a 13-6 win over Erie. The Curve scored 4 runs in each of their first two at-bats and banged out 14 hits in the win.

SHACK ATTACK: Aaron Shackelford leads Pirates minor leaguers with 26 home runs, passing Josh Bonifay for the second-highest single-season total in franchise history (Adam Hyzdu - 31, 2000). Shackelford and Matt Gorski are the first Pirates minor leaguers to homer at least 24 times in the same season since 2007 (Jonel Pacheco and Steve Pearce in 2007). Shackelford's 28 extra base hits and 14 homers in the second half (6/28 - Present) are 2nd-most among Eastern League players.

WE'VE ENTERED A HOUSE OF WORSHIP: With right-hander Quinn Priester's dominant outing on Friday, September 9 at Erie, he lowered his ERA to 2.13 with Altoona, the 2nd-best mark among qualified Double-A pitchers since his debut on June 19. Akron's Tanner Bibee is the lone Double-A pitcher to record a better ERA in that timeframe (1.61). Priester also ranks 8th in IP (71.2) and 9th in WHIP (1.12). Twice this season Priester has matched his career-long outing of 7.0 innings pitched.

PLAYOFFS?!?!?!: With their fourth straight win and second in a row in Erie on Wednesday, September 7, Altoona stood just 3.5 games back of first place with 10 games to play in the regular season. With 7 games to play entering Sunday, Altoona is just 3.5 out of first behind Bowie.

20/20 VISION: Infielder Andres Alvarez has recorded the first 20/20 season in Altoona's franchise history with his two-run home run on Sunday, September 4 against Akron. With Aaron Shackelford already hitting the total, Altoona has 2 players with 20 HR on the same team for the first time since 2005 (Jose Bautista/Josh Bonifay) and just the third time in 24 seasons of the franchise's history. Alvarez and Shackelford have recorded the 11th and 12th 20-homer seasons in franchise history.

ENDY'S POP: Catcher Endy Rodriquez homered from both sides of the plate in Altoona's 13-7 win over Akron on Thursday, September 1. It was just the 5th time in franchise history that Altoona had a player homer from both sides of the plate and first time at PNG Field. **Rodolfo Castro** last turned the trick on 6/5/21 at Richmond. Others to homer from both sides of the plate in the same game in franchise history include: **Shawn Garrett** 5/2/03 at Reading, **Hector Gimenez** 5/5/10 at Richmond, **Shelby Ford** 5/15/10 at Richmond.

In his 26 games since joining the Curve on August 9 at Binghamton, he's batting .354/.440/.707/1.147 with 11 2B, 8 HR, 28 RBI, 15 BB and 1-1 SB. Since his promotion he ranks T-3rd in XBH (19), 9th in SLG% (.707) and 9th in OPS (1.147) among all minor league players.

ACTIVE 1'S: For the first time this season, Altoona has 4 First Round draft picks on the active roster at the same time with Connor Scott (13th overall, 2018 by Miami), Quinn Priester (19th overall, 2019), Nick Gonzales (7th overall, 2020) and Henry Davis (1st overall, 2021) active for Altoona.

NICKY G IS BACK: After missing 10 weeks of the season with a right foot injury, Infielder Nick Gonzales has reached base safely in 20-of-22 games since his activation batting: .296/.431/.506 (24-for-81) with 11 2B, 2 HR, 15 RBI, 16 BB since his return.

STOLEN HEARTS: The Curve have stolen 151 bases on the season, on pace to break the franchise record of 159 (2014) with 7 games to play. Altoona has 3 players, Jared Triolo (24), Liover Peguero (23) and Andres Alvarez (20), with 20 stolen bases for the second time in franchise history: first since 2014 when Keon Broxton and Alen Hanson each had 25 and Drew Maggi stole 37 bases.

THE 'WOLVES: Managed by Gabe Alvarez, Erie is on the doorstep of their first playoff berth since 2013. With their win over Bowie on Sunday, Erie holds the tiebreaker over Bowie and enters this series tied for first in the division. Erie's roster features some of the top Tigers prospects: RHP Wilmer Flores (#3), RHP Ty Madden (#4), RHP Reese Olson (#9), C Dillon Dingler (#10), INF Wenceel Perez (#15), OF Parker Meadows (#17), LHP Brant Hurter (#22), RHP Elvis Alvarado (#26),

THE FIRST INTO THE SEA: Chance Kirby takes the ball on Sunday afternoon for Erie. Kirby was named the SeaWolves Pitcher of the Year prior to Saturday's game, his 2.62 ERA is the best mark in the Eastern League. A 25th round pick out of UT-San Antonio in 2018, Kirby hails from Austin, TX, the same hometown as Curve INF Jared Triolo.
