ROCKER SPINS THREE SHUTOUT FRAMES, RIDERS BLANK ROCKHOUNDS 3-0:

The Frisco RoughRiders spelled the Midland RockHounds 3-0 on Friday night from Riders Field, securing their third shutout of the season and winning their third game in a row. RoughRiders (25-17) starter **Kumar Rocker** pitched three shutout innings on his MLB season and winning their fund game in a row, Rodginiders (25-17) stater **kumar Nocker** pitched these studied timings on the Mass rehab assignment from the Texas Rangers. The 2022 third-overall pick allowed just two hits while punching out three across 34 pitch-es (23 strikes). Frisco reliever **Ben Anderson** (2-3) secured the victory, tossing 5.1 scoreless frames while fanning three. Kyle Robinson (0-1) took the loss despite posting a quality start in his Double-A debut. Robinson had retired 11-straight for Midland (24-18) before **Josh Hatcher** clipped a two-out, solo homer in the bottom of the fourth inning to put the Riders up 1-0. In the bottom of the sixth, Frisco added on when **Abimelec Ortiz** rifled an RBI single and **Keyber Rodriguez** topped an RBI fielder's choice to snatch a 3-0 lead. In the top of the ninth, Frisco reliever **Travis MacGregor** replaced Anderson to record the final two outs of the game. With the tying run at the plate MacGregor struck out, lunicr Perest to earn bit first save as a PouchPider. run at the plate, MacGregor struck out Junior Perez to earn his first save as a RoughRider.

SAVE IONIGHT: On Friday night, **Travis MacGregor** became the 10th different Riders pitcher to record a save in 2025. Frisco is the only team in Minor League Baseball to accomplish the feat this season. Current Triple-A Round Rock pitcher **Robby Ahlstrom** leads the Riders with four saves while Skylar Hales and Gavin Collyer both have two saves. Frisco leads the Texas League and is tied for fourth in MiLB with 15 saves

KNOCK THAT STARTER OUT ASAP:

The RoughRiders have been much better against the bullpen on offense than they have been against starting pitchers. Against start-ers, the RoughRiders are slashing .243/.316/.370/.695 with the second-fewest RBIs in the league (74). When the Riders face opposing bullpens, they are hitting .248/.343/.381/.724 with 111 RBIs (2nd) and 20 HR (T2nd).

RISP-ECT THIS:

The RoughRiders overall are hitting .234 with runners in scoring position, but have struggled over their last 25 games. In that stretch, the Riders are just 12-12, batting .183 (39-for-213)/.261/.282/.543 with RISP. Their .183 batting average is last in the Texas League and 28th among 30 Double-A teams.

ABIM-ELECTRIC ORTIZ:

Abimelec Ortiz has been on fire at the plate for the Riders. While having reached in his last 13 games, Ortiz is hitting .360 (18-for-50)/.458/.620/1.078 with four doubles, three home runs and 14 RBIs. Last Wednesday, he clubbed the first walk-off grand slam in franchise history while driving in six runs . His six RBIs were the most in a game since 2022 (Josh Stowers). On Friday, he hammered a game-tying home run in the bottom of the ninth before the Riders eventually won 6-5 in 11 innings on a Josh Hatcher RBI single. He is 10th in the Texas League in May average (.308), second in RBIs (17), tied for seventh in home runs (four) and seventh in OPS (.954). For his efforts and three home runs, Ortiz was named Texas League Player of the Week.

MAY FLOWERS AND HOMERS:

The RoughRiders have both hit and given up their fair share of long balls this month. They have hit 15 this month, which is tied for the fewest in the league and have allowed 24, which is the most. Frisco's 4.22 ERA is fourth in the league during the month while they are just 11-8 in May.

DOUBLE-A DOUBL-A RON:

Aaron Zavala has been on fire at the plate for the Riders. After a dreadful start, batting just .077 (2-for-26) through 10 games, he is hitting .309 (25-for-81)/.447/.494/.941 over his last 24 games. He leads the Texas League in walks (34) and is second in OBP (.428) while leading the league in walk rate (23.4 percent), a mark which also ranks 3rd in Minor League Baseball (min. 140 PA). His 14-game on-base streak ended Thursday, batting .367 (18-for-49)/.516/.551/1.067 with 15 runs scored, a double, a triple, two home runs, 11 RBIs and 15 walks. During the streak, he reached multiple times in 11 of the 14 games. In May, he is hitting .328/.461/.475/.936, ranking fifth in average, first in OBP and eighth in OPS in the Texas League.

HOUND HUNTING:

The Riders struggled against the Midland RockHounds a season ago. On top of being knocked out the postseason by Midland last year, they went just 6-12 during the regular season against the A's affiliate. Frisco was held to a .219/.291/.305/.596 slashline against the RockHounds. Since 2015, the Riders have had just one winning season against Midland, going 97-126 (.434) against the A's affiliate.

BRATT SUMMER IS BACK:

Mitch Bratt has been one of the stronger arms for Frisco to start the year. Through his first seven starts, his 2.21 ERA is second in the Texas League. His 4.1 percent walk rate, 7.83 K/BB, 31.8 percent strikeout rate and 90.3 percent left on base rate are the best in the Texas League. His 47 strikeouts are tied for the most in the Texas Rangers organization and his 36.2 innings are the most thrown among Rangers farmhands



ABOUT MITCH

-During COVID-19, finding a place to throw was difficult, so he built a bullpen in the backyard of his home in Newmarket, Ontario to keep throwing. While most Canadian schools were not able to start playing baseball in 2021, Bratt made the decision to transfer to Georgia Premier Academy in Statesboro, Georgia (outside of near Savannah). He completed his final year of high school online while playing baseball.

-After spending two months at GPA, he played in the MLB Draft League during the summer of 2021, going 1-1 with a 2.57 ERA while playing for the West Virginia Black Bears.

-Baseball America ranked Bratt as the No. 3 Canadian prospect going into the 2021 draft. Committed to play baseball at Florida State.

-Made one start for Team Canada in the 2023 World Baseball Classic as a 19-year-old against Team USA, going 0.1 IP, 3 H, 6 R, 6 ER, facing MLB All-Stars Mookie Betts, Mike Trout, Paul Goldschmidt, Nolan Arenado, Kyle Tucker, Tim Anderson and JT Realmuto.

2025 SEASON

-Ranked as the No. 17 prospect in the Rangers organization by MiLB.com

-Recorded RoughRiders first quality start of the season on 4/11 at NWA, allowing two runs over six innings with six strikeouts to no walks. He moved up a day in the rotation, pitching on five days rest.

-On May 10th at San Antonio, Bratt took a no-hitter into the sixth inning before allowing a bloop single into right. He struck out a career-high 10 batters in the game before leading after six innings. The RoughRiders fell 2-1 on a two-run walk-off home run from Romeo Sanabria.

2024 SEASON

-Ranked as the No. 21 prospect in the Rangers organization by MiLB.com

-After tough first start of the season (3.0 IP, 8 H, 7 R, 7 ER, 0 BB, 4 K vs. JS) with Hickory, has gone 6-3 with a 2.30 ERA over his last 16 games (14 starts) with 80 strikeouts to 16 walks over 74.1 innings.

-In last 10 games in Hickory (nine starts), went 4-1 with 1.35 ERA, striking out 55 over 53.1 IP to 11 walks, holding opponents to .182 batting average.

-Dominated with Hickory while ahead in the count, allowing a .163 average and .240 slugging (as opposed to .298 average and .638 slugging when behind in the count).

-First Double-A start was 5.0 shutout innings at San Antonio on 8/1.

2023 SEASON

-Spent all of 2023 with High-A Hickory and was selected as an MiLB.com Organizational All-Star.

-Despite being 19 at the beginning of the season and turning 20 midway through the year, he ranked fifth in the South Atlantic League in ERA (3.54) among those with at least 15 starts.

-Was placed on the Injured List from 7/18-8/31 with lat tightness.

-Played under Carlos Cardoza in the 2023 Arizona Fall League with the Surprise Saguaros, going 1-0 with a 6.46 ERA over six games (one start).

2022 SEASON

-Was named an MiLB.com Organizational All-Star with Low-A Down East, entering the season as the youngest pitcher in the Carolina League at 18 years old.

-He finished the season third in ERA (2.45).

-Named the Rangers Starting Pitcher of the Month for July, going 3-1 with a 1.96 ERA.

2021 SEASON

-Bratt out 13 of 24 (54.2%) batters faced without issuing a walk over four appearances for the ACL Rangers in his professional debut.

-He recorded at least three strikeouts in each of his outings, all of which came in August or September, shortly after his 18th birthday.
