**SUNDAY:** The Flying Squirrels lost to the SeaWolves, 7-4, in the series finale at The Diamond. Erie took a 2-0 lead in the first inning with a two-run homer by Eduardo Valencia. In the bottom of the second, **Zach Morgan** cut the score to 2-1 with a sacrifice fly. Roberto Campos hit a two-run homer to open a 4-1 lead for the SeaWolves in the top of the fourth. Richmond rallied to tie the score in the bottom of the inning with a solo homer by **Cal Mitchell** and a two-run homer by **Aeverson Arteaga**. Erie pulled ahead in the ninth. Eliezer Alfonzo hit an RBI double and Max Anderson added a two-run single on an infield pop up.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Flying Squirrels play the opener of a six-game series against the Binghamton Rumble Ponies, Double-A affiliate of the New York Mets. The week is Richmond's first series in Binghamton since May 23-28, 2023, when the Rumble Ponies took five-of-six. The Rumble Ponies come to The Diamond to face the Flying Squirrels in a six-game series from June 10-15. This week's series is Richmond's second against the Northeast Division. They split a six-game series with Somerset from April 29-May 4.

PACKING THE HOUSE: Last year, the Flying Squirrels led all 30 Double-A teams in average (6,595) and total (435,295) attendance. Among the 120 MiLB teams, the Flying Squirrels were 10th in average attendance. It was the third straight year the Flying Squirrels led all 30 Double-A clubs in average and total attendance, which had not been done prior to 2022. Last year's total attendance is the highest since 2013 (434,769) and the fourth-highest average in team history. April 4 marked the 15th consecutive Opening Night sellout, marking every home opener in franchise history to date. This year, the Flying Squirrels are averaging 7,022 fans per home game, which ranks third among all 120 MiLB clubs. Their average of 7,290 in the season's first month was the highest April attendance in franchise history.

**THE FLYING SQUIRRELS** dropped four-of-six in last week's home series against the SeaWolves. The Richmond offense ranks fourth in hits (277), sixth in batting average (.225) and has the second-fewest strikeouts (306) in the Eastern League but are last in runs scored (123). The Richmond pitching staff is last in ERA (5.03).

**THE RUMBLE PONIES** are in first place in the Northeast Division, a half-game ahead of Portland and have won four-of-their-last-five games since May 14 (G2). Binghamton's roster features seven players ranked in Baseball America's top-30 prospects, including SS Jett Williams (No. 1), 1B/OF Ryan Clifford (No. 6), OF Nick Morabito (No. 12), RHP Jonah Tong (No. 13), C Kevin Parada (No. 27), RHP Jonathan Pintaro (No. 29) and 1B JT Schwartz (No. 30). MLB.com's top-30 Mets prospects lists features six Binghamton players, including Williams (No. 1), Clifford (No. 4), Tong (No. 6), Morabito (No. 17), Pintaro (No. 23) and RHP Jack Wenninger (No. 28).

FOR RICHMOND: Left-hander Seth Lonsway makes his eighth start of the season and the second of his career against the Rumble Ponies. He last pitched in the second game of Thursday's doubleheader against the SeaWolves and threw the longest outing of his professional career, allowing three runs over 6.2 innings in a loss. This season, Lonsway is tied for sixth in the Eastern League in ERA (2.75) and ranks 10th in BAA (.219) and WHIP (1.11). Lonsway previously faced Binghamton on July 26, 2024 at The Diamond and threw five scoreless innings with six strikeouts. Since joining the team last summer, Lonsway has not allowed an earned run eight-of-13 Double-A outings, including three-of-six starts in 2025. Lonsway was selected by the Giants in the sixth round of the 2021 MLB Draft out of Ohio State. For more on Lonsway, see page two.

**FOR BINGHAMTON:** Right-hander Jack Wenninger makes his eight start of the season, his first year at Double-A. He last pitched last Wednesday at Hartford and allowed one run over six innings with six strikeouts in a loss. Wenninger went 4-0 with a 0.90 ERA in his first four starts of the season. In his next two starts, he allowed 10 earned runs over 10.2 innings pitched prior to last week's outing against the Yard Goats. In the Eastern League this season, Wenninger ranks tied for fourth in wins (4), fifth in WHIP (0.98), tied for sixth in strikeouts (43), eighth in BAA (.207) and tied for eighth in innings pitched (36.2). Last year, he split the season between Low-A St. Lucie and High-A Brooklyn, going 4-6 with a 4.30 ERA in 25 outings (19 starts) in his first full professional season. Wenninger was selected by the Mets in the sixth round of the 2023 MLB Draft out of the University of Illinois. He is ranked by MLB.com as the No. 28 Mets prospect.

**DON'T RUN ON RICHMOND:** The Flying Squirrels' catching unit of **Adrián Sugastey** and **Zach Morgan** have combined to throw out 21 stolen base attempts this season, which is second among all 30 Double-A teams and leads the Eastern League. Sugastey is second in the Eastern League with 12 runners caught stealing. Morgan is fourth in the EL with nine.

WAIT A MINUTE: Northern Virginia native Bryce Eldridge returned to the Richmond roster on April 22 after missing the start of the season with an injury. He hit a solo home run in his first plate appearance of the year. The 20-year-old first baseman played at four levels in the Giants organization in his first full professional season last year, including nine games with Richmond in September. For the year in 116 games, Eldridge hit. 291 with 23 homers and 92 RBIs. He is ranked by Baseball America as the No. 22 prospect in baseball. Eldridge is also the fifth Virginia-born player to suit up for the Flying Squirrels in franchise history. After batting .111 (1-for-9) in his first three games of the season, Eldridge is batting .310 (22-for-71) in his last 19 games since April 27. On May 10, Eldridge drove a two-out, three-run homer against the Senators to give the Flying Squirrels the lead in the eighth for a comeback win. He hit his third homer of the year last Thursday night in the second game of a doubleheader against the SeaWolves. On Friday, he went 3-for-4 with two homers, a double and four RBIs. In last week's series against Erie, Eldridge hit .364 (8-for-22) with three homers, two doubles and six RBIs over six games.

**HELLO, GAVELLO:** Catcher/infielder/outfielder **Thomas Gavello** joined the Flying Squirrels from High-A Eugene on May 9. In his Double-A debut on May 10 at Harrisburg, he hit a double on the first pitch he saw in the game. He followed with two hits, including another double, in his second game the following day. Since joining Richmond, Gavello has picked at least one hit in all five Double-A games he has played, including three doubles. He has played one game at shortstop and four games in left field, the first games of his professional career in the outfield.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: In the Eastern League, Diego Velasquez is tied for seventh in hits (38). Seth Lonsway is tied for sixth in ERA (2.75), 10th in BAA (.219) and 10th in WHIP (1.11). Jack Choate is sixth in strikeouts (41). John Michael Bertrand is fourth in innings pitched (39.0). Joe Whitman is ninth in BAA (.217).

**TOP SKIPPER:** Flying Squirrels manager **Dennis Pelfrey** has led the team to 216 wins in his career, which is for the franchise's all-time wins record for a manager. From 2011-2013, **Dave Machemer** won 216 games as Richmond's manager, leading the team to the Eastern League postseason for in 2011. Pelfrey, who has been with Richmond since the 2022 season, led the team to back-to-back postseason appearances for the first time in franchise history in 2022 and 2023. He also managed the 2021 Eugene Emeralds to the High-A West championship.

PROSPECT WATCH: Richmond's roster includes seven players are ranked in Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects, including Bryce Eldridge (No. 1), Joe Whitman (No. 10), Diego Velasquez (No. 13), Sabin Ceballos (No. 16), Trent Harris (No. 26), Aeverson Arteaga (No. 27) and Jack Choate (No. 28). There are also seven players ranked in MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list, including Eldridge, (No. 1), Whitman (No. 7), Harris (No. 11), Velasquez (No. 15), Arteaga (No. 16), Ceballos (No. 23) and Choate (No. 27). Eldridge is also ranked No. 22 overall by Baseball America and No. 22 by MLB.com.

# THIS DATE IN RICHMOND BASEBALL HISTORY

1964: The Richmond Virginians beat the Columbus Jets, 6-3, at Parker Field. Elvio Jimenez drove in the go-ahead run for a 4-3 lead in the seventh. Ted Kazanski added a two-run homer in the eighth. Harry Bright had a double, a single, an RBI and a run scored in the win. 1966: The Richmond Braves beat the Toledo Mud Hens, 6-0, at Parker Field. Larry Maxie threw a seven-hit shutout, aided by four double plays. Richmond scored three unearned runs in the fourth, including an RBI double by Tommie Aaron, before a two-run homer by Gil Garrido in the fifth opened a 5-0 lead. The game marked the return to Parker Field for the former Richmond Virginians, who moved to Toledo to become the Mud Hens for the 1965 season. The R-Braves management billed the game as a "second opening night," which included music, a ceremonial first ball and more. The former Virginians in the Toledo lineup were mostly greeted with cheers. 1984: The Richmond Braves beat the Rochester Red Wings, 7-6, at Parker Field. Larry Whisenton drove in the game winning run with a walk-off single in the bottom of the ninth inning. Richmond took a 1-0 lead with an RBI single in the second by Tom Hayes. Paul Zuvella hit an RBI triple and scored on a double by Brad Komminsk in the third. Paul Runge pushed the lead to 4-0 with a single in the fourth. The R-Braves led 6-0 entering the eighth before the Red Wings rallied to tie the game in the ninth.
