LAST TIME OUT

The Baysox held on for a second consecutive one run victory in a 3-2 win over Reading on Thursday night. **Silas Ardoin** drove in all three runs for the Baysox in his first two at-bats, his first three RBI game of the year. **Seth Johnson** delivered four scoreless innings with four strikeouts in a no decision. After giving up a leadoff homer in the fifth, **Dylan Heid** picked up the win after setting down the next six in a row. **Lincoln Henzman** recorded his first save of the season with two scoreless innings.

BASALLO BITS

C/1B **Samuel Basallo** has reached base safely in 28 of his last 30 games dating back to May 21. After a pair of hits on Tuesday, Basallo now has 20 multi-hit games on the season, the most by a Baysox hitter this season. His 19-game on-base streak from May 21 to June 12 is the longest Baysox on-base streak this season and is tied for the sixth-longest in the Eastern League. Since May 21, the 19-year-old is slashing .315/.392/.942 with six homers and 18 RBI.

BENCOSME BARRELS

After a bunt single yesterday, IF **Frederick Bencosme** now owns the longest active hit streak in the league at 12 consecutive games, which is also the longest hit streak by a Baysox player this season. The Orioles No. 27 prospect is slashing .300/.408/.758 over this span.

RHODES IS ROLLING

In the month of June, OF/1B **John Rhodes** is batting a team-high .317 with a team-leading 15 RBI. The Orioles No. 23 prospect has the 10th-best batting average in the league in the month of June.

THE FANTASTIC FABIAN

OF **Jud Fabian** is tied for the league lead among active Eastern League players with 13 home runs on the season. Fabian hit a league-high six homers in the month of May and has five thus far in June.

WELCOME MR. ETZEL

OF/1B **Matthew Etzel** was the first Orioles '23 draft pick to be promoted to Double-A after being selected in the 10th round out of So. Miss. On Tuesday, the 22-year-old hit his first Double-A homer with an opposite field solo shot. His 36 steals on the season between High-A Aberdeen and Double-A Bowie is tied for fourth-most in all of MiLB.

ENJOY THE ROAD

Bowie begins the second half with a slew of games on the road. 21 of the first 27 games to start the second half will be played on the road. The Baysox ended the first half with a road record of 13-17.

BUILT BY THE BULLPEN

Bowie's bullpen leads the Eastern League and all of Double-A in innings pitched (350.2) and strikeouts (406). The Baysox bullpen owns a 1.20 WHIP, which is the third-lowest in Double-A. In the 59 innings pitched in the series against Altoona, 37.1 innings came from the bullpen (63%).

WE'RE TALKING ABOUT THE FIGHTIN'S'

The Reading Fightin' Phils finished the first half in fifth in the Northeast Division with a record of 31-37. The Double-A affiliate of the Philadelphia Phillies has won three in a row after securing a series win at New Hampshire. The Fightin' Phils have hit the second most homers in the league and have scored the fourth most runs. Due to injuries, Reading's active roster includes only three of the Phillies' top 30 prospects (per MLB Pipeline) - OF/1B Carlos De La Cruz (No. 12), C Caleb Ricketts (No. 20), IF Robert Moore (No. 25)

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

RHP Robinson Pina makes his 13th start of the season for the Fightin' Phils. The 25-year-old is in his first season with the Phillies organization after previously spending the last six seasons in the Angels organization where he reached as high as Triple-A Salt Lake. Pina is tied for the league lead in wins (8) and has a 2.38 ERA in June. The San Cristobal, Dominican Republic native has walked only eight batters all year. He faced the Baysox back on April 7 and threw five innings of two-run ball.

2024: Struck out 7 batters over 3.2 IP across 5 H, 3 R (2 ER) and 2 BB in no decision on Sat. 6/22 vs ALT. Has thrown 3rd most innings in O's system (60.0) and has struck out 2nd-most batters (77).

Baysox have won eight of last 10 games that Pham has started in. Has struck out 7+ batters in four of last five starts. Threw first scoreless start of season by matching career-high 6.0 IP and 0 BB over 6 K to record win on 6/11 @ HBG. Ended month of May with a 5.64 ERA. Allowed just two runs or less in four of his five starts in May. Collected first Double-A win on 5/7 vs AKR after dealing 5.0 IP with 6 K, matching season-high. Named to Bowie Opening Day roster and was named Opening Night starter. Second season as full-time starter after beginning pro career in bullpen.

2023: Began the season with High-A Aberdeen, going 3-3 with a 2.45 ERA in 12 outings. Won South Atlantic League Pitcher of the Month award in May, posting a 1.54 ERA and 34 K in 23.1 IP. .163 opposing average was the lowest in the South Atlantic League at the time of his promotion. Five of 10 starts with Aberdeen were 5+ IP with one run or fewer allowed. Promoted to Bowie on 6/2. Began Double-A career with nine scoreless frames across two starts. Surrendered fewer than 3 ER in 11 of his 14 Double-A outings, including six outings of 5 IP or more. Had a 1.80 ERA for Bowie in July. Was named an Orioles' Organizational All-Star in 2023.

2022: Spent the first portion of 2022 on the injured list, being activated by Single-A Delmarva on April 26. Pitched in six games for the Shorebirds, allowing two earned runs through 11.1 innings, before promotion to High-A Aberdeen on May 24. Only allowed a single run through his first three appearances for Aberdeen (8 IP) before allowing six runs across four innings in back-to-back rough outings. Placed on IL for the second time in the season in late June. Spent a brief rehab stint with the FCL Orioles after being activated August 5, before finishing the season with Aberdeen. In total, pitched to a 5.66 ERA with the IronBirds across 20.2 innings in the regular season.

2021: Pitched 6.2 innings for the FCL Orioles in 2021, surrendering six runs before throwing five scoreless innings across three appearances in Delmarva to end the season.

Personal: Pitched for four seasons at the University of San Francisco, finishing seventh in program history with 215 strikeouts and fourth with 11 saves.

Boasting a desire to better represent the Chesapeake Bay area, Bowie's "Cangrejos Fantasmas de Chesapeake" identity came to light after research presented the existence of the small, yet active Atlantic Ghost Crab species in the bay.



CHESAPEAKE BAYSOX

On Sunday, May 26, the Bowie Baysox will take the field as the "Chesapeake Baysox." This alternate identity was created to celebrate and learn about the conservation of the nearby Chesapeake Bay. The uniform tops are detailed with stenciled outlines of local wildlife, design, and architecture around the Chesapeake Bay.

In addition to activities around Prince George's Stadium promoting the conservation of the Chesapeake Bay, the jerseys will be auctioned off following the May 26 contest, with proceeds benefitting the Chesapeake Bay Foundation.



BOWIE PIT BEEF

The "Bowie Pit Beef" is an alternate identity of the Bowie Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland. The Baysox will take the field as the Bowie Pit Beef on both June 23 and August 4.

Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore's east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s



COACHING STAFF

ROBERTO MERCADO

Manager

The 17th manager in Baysox franchise history, Mercado spent each of the past two seasons as the manager of the High-A Aberdeen IronBirds. He was honored with the Orioles organization's Cal Ripken, Sr. Player Development Award following his first season with Aberdeen in 2022. Prior to the start of his professional career, Mercado spent 17 years on the coaching staff at New Britain High School in Connecticut. He began as an assistant coach in 2004 before being promoted to head varsity coach in 2011. In addition to coaching the New Britain baseball team, Mercado served as the Dean of Students for over 18 years. He also spent time as an assistant coach of the Yarmouth Dennis Red Sox in the Cape Cod Baseball League from 2014-2022 and was a coach in the Goodwill Series, where high school baseball players from the United States competed overseas in both Australia and New Zealand in 2017 and 2018.

AUSTIN MEINE

Pitching Coach

Meine joins Mercado in the move from High-A Aberdeen. Meine served as the IronBirds pitching coach in 2023, where he helped Aberdeen post the third-lowest ERA (3.81) and second-most strikeouts (1,363) across the South Atlantic League. He previously spent two seasons on staff at the University of North Carolina at Charlotte, where he guided the 49ers to the two highest single-season strikeout totals in program history. Meine has also worked on staff at the Premier Pitching and Performance facility in Missouri. He pitched collegiately at Lindenwood University.

JOSH BUNSELMAYER

Hitting Coach

Bunselmayer served as the hitting coach for the Orioles' Single-A affiliate, the Delmarva Shorebirds, last season. 2024 is Bunselmayer's fifth season in the Orioles' system after also spending the previous three campaigns as a hitting coach in both the Florida Complex League and Dominican Summer League. He played three seasons in the Independent Frontier League following a collegiate playing career at Saint Louis University.

CHASE SEBBY

Fundamentals Coach

Sebbly joins the Baysox staff as the Fundamentals Coach in 2024. Sebbly was the fundamentals coach in Aberdeen last season and was a development coach within the Orioles' organization in 2022. Sebbly played collegiately as a catcher at Cypress College and Ball State.
