Today's Game: The Dayton Dragons (partner of the Cincinnati Reds) host the Quad Cities River Bandits (partner of the Kansas City Royals) in the second game of the 2026 Midwest League Championship Series. This is a best-of-three series. Quad Cities leads the series, one game to none. If the series continues to a third game, it will be played in Dayton on Wednesday, Sept. 16 at 7:05 pm. **This is the Dragons first-ever trip to the MWL Championship Series in their 26th season of operation.**

The Dragons reached the league finals by defeating Great Lakes in the East Division playoffs (league semi-finals), two games to one, while Quad Cities, who won the West Division Second Half title, defeated South Bend two games to none in the West Division playoffs.

Last Game: Sunday, Game 1: Quad Cities 4, Dayton 0. Four River Bandits pitchers combined to scatter six hits. QC had only five hits but scored two runs in the first inning and adding single runs in the third and fourth. Ty Doucette had a single and double for Dayton and has hits in all four playoff games.

Playoffs--Route to Arrival: The Dragons were the East Division First Half champions, going 39-27. By winning eight of their last nine games in the first half including two elimination games on the final night, the Dragons overtook Great Lakes and Lake County to win the division by one game. Quad Cities won the West Division Second Half title by two games over Beloit, going 40-24.

Home Run History: Dayton's John Michael Faile hit his 31st career home run on Saturday night, breaking the all-time Dragons club record for career home runs. Chris Williamson hit 30 homers over the Dragons first three seasons, 2000-2002.

Top Draft Picks & Prospects with Dragons: Shortstop Justin Lebron, the Reds first round draft pick last month (18th overall pick), was added to the Dayton roster on August 11. Lebron was the 18th overall pick of the 2026 draft out of the University of Alabama. He has become the 22nd "true" first round pick to play for the Dragons. Every Reds first round draft pick since 2011 has played for the Dragons except 2025 first rounder Steele Hall, who is at Single-A Daytona and on track to play for the Dragons sometime in 2027. In 2026, Lebron led Alabama to their first College World Series berth since 1999. Lebron was selected by *Baseball America* as the "Best Athlete" in the 2026 college draft class. He was the only D1 player in the nation with 16 or more HR and 42 or more SB in '26. The Reds '26 second round pick, infielder Eric Becker (University of Virginia), joined the Dragons on August 6. Tyson Lewis, the Reds second round pick in 2024 (Millard West High School), joined the Dragons on June 30. Lebron, Becker, and Lewis are all ranked as Reds top-10 prospects by both *MLB Pipeline* and *Baseball America*.

Dragons Team and Player Trending Notes:

- This is the Dragons first trip to the MWL championship series, and their ninth trip to the MWL playoffs in their 26 seasons of operation. This 2026 post-season marked the Dragons sixth trip to the semi-final round and the first time they have advanced past that round. The MWL playoffs featured three rounds until 2021 when the post-season playoff format was shortened to two rounds, and the Dragons won their first round set four times prior to 2021. They also qualified for the post-season in 2024, their fifth trip to the semi-final round. This is the first-ever post-season meeting between the Dragons and Bandits.
- The Dragons finished the season with a record of 67-63 to post a winning record for the fifth time in the last six seasons.
- The Dragons finished the season by hitting at least one home run in their final 28 games, the longest home run streak anywhere in Full-Season Minor League Baseball since record-keeping of this statistic began in 2005.
- The Dragons hit 180 HR as a team this season to break the club record of 152 set in 2022 (record-breaking home run came on August 22). According to the final Midwest League media guide in 2020 and subsequent yearly research, **this is the second highest home run total in MWL history (Great Lakes hit 187 in 2021).**
- The Dragons hit 10 grand slam home runs this season, **tying the all-time Midwest League record set by Wisconsin Rapids in 1981.**
- The Dragons scored 747 runs on the year but break the club record of 730 set in 2000.

Dragons Hottest Hitters (Regular Season Games only):

John Michael Faile had 1 HR over his first 48 G this season (through the MLB All-Star Break). He had 13 HR in 37 G after the All-Star break on July 19. In his last 37 G, Faile hit .315 with 35 RBI with a 1.067 OPS. He led the MWL in HR and extra base hits since 7/19, ranking fifth in RBI, and third in OPS.

Ty Doucette finished 2026 with a 16-G hitting streak, batting .358, 6 HR, 4 2B, 1 3B, 17 RBI--**longest Dragons hitting streak since Jose Barrero (17) in 2018.**

Kyle Henley ended the season with an 8-G hitting streak, going 14 for 33, .424, with 1 HR, 2 2B, and 7 RBI.

Justin Lebron hit 8 HR in the first 23 G of his pro career to end the year. Since his first G on 8/11, Lebron in the MWL was T-1st in HR, T-2 in R, T-4th in XBH.

Ryan McCrystal in his last 16 G (since 8/19) went 19 for 63 (.302) with 2 HR. In the post-season, he is 8 for 15 (.533) with 1 HR.

Kien Vu since returning to the Dragons on September 1 batted .304 with 3 HR, 7 RBI.

Dragons First Half Summary: Record: 39-27, East Division champs. By winning 8 of their last 9 games in the half including 2 elimination games on the final night, the Dragons overtook Great Lakes and Lake County to win the division by 1 game. The Dragons outscored their opponents 90-26 in those nine games. The Dragons previously won First Half division titles in 2001 and '07. The Dragons First Half winning percentage of .591 tied for second best in franchise history (44-26, .629 in 2007; 39-27, .591 in 2022).

--**John Michael Faile** is the NCAA Division II all-time career leader in both home runs (81) and RBI (337). Faile has hit 17 home runs in his Dragons career and would equal the team's career record of 30 this season if he matches his home run with the Dragons in 2025 (13).
--**Mason Neville** tied for the NCAA D1 lead in home runs in 2025 with 26 with Oregon. He was a First Team All-American and First Team All-Big Ten selection.
--Shortstop **Justin Lebron** was a Second Team All-American in both 2025 and '26 with the University of Alabama.
--Starting pitcher **J.P. Ortiz** had the best ERA (2.81) in the Reds farm system in 2025 with Daytona among pitchers with at least 80 innings.
--Center fielder **Jack Lausch** (Northwestern) and relief pitcher **Bryce Archie** (South Florida) were both NCAA Division I starting quarterbacks.

All-Time Best Dragons: The team named their 12 Greatest Dragons in franchise history as part of last season's 25-year celebration. Those players, listed alphabetically, are Homer Bailey, Jay Bruce, Zack Cozart, Johnny Cueto, Elly De La Cruz, Adam Dunn, Todd Frazier, Hunter Greene, Billy Hamilton, Austin Kearns, Joey Votto, and Jesse Winker.

A total of 163 players have gone from the Dragons to the Major Leagues, and another 45 Reds players have completed injury

rehab assignments with the Dragons, including Jose Rijo, Joey Votto (three times), Homer Bailey, Drew Stubbs, Johnny Cueto, Aroldis Chapman, and Brandon Phillips. Three members of the Reds Hall-of-Fame have served as coaches for the Dragons including Ken Griffey Sr., Chris Sabo, and Tom Browning. Every season in Dragons history has featured a future Major League player/s on the Dayton roster. Most recently: Chase Burns in 2025; Sal Stewart, Rhett Lowder, and Hector Rodriguez in 2024; Blake Dunn, Julian Aguiar, Chase Petty, and Edwin Arroyo in 2023; Elly De La Cruz, Rece Hinds, Noelvi Marte, Andrew Abbott, Connor Phillips, and others in 2022.

Recordkeeping & Highlights

- Carlos Sanchez tied the Dragons club record by stealing bases in six consecutive games, April 17-22 (record shared by Billy Hamilton and Michael Siani; records available since 2005).
- The Dragons broke their club record for most runs in a game on May 20, topping Fort Wayne 22-8. The record of 21 had held up for 25 years after being set in 2001. The Dragons also tied their club record for most home runs in a game on May 20, matching the mark set in 2001 and 2007. In the game on May 20, the Dragons scored five runs in the first inning, keyed by a grand slam home run by Carter Graham, and jumped out to a 13-0 lead over the first two innings. Carlos Sanchez scored five runs, tying the record set by Austin Kearns (2000) and Wily Mo Pena (2001)...The Dragons had 11 extra base hits, most in a game since MLB assumed record-keeping duties in 2005 (no record of this stat prior to that year). Graham became the first Dayton player with four extra base hits in a game since Kevyn Feiner in 2009, Graham had 6 RBI...Sanchez and Alfredo Duno each had two home runs...Sanchez reached base in all six plate appearances, going 4 for 4 with two walks.
- Carter Graham collected eight RBI in one game vs. Great Lakes on May 28, tying the club record set in 2019 by Brian Rey. Graham broke the club record for most RBI in a home game, topping Juan Francisco's seven RBI in 2007. On June 18 at Peoria, Jacob Friend also tied the record with eight RBI in the final game of the half.
- In one of the most amazing endings to a game in Dragons history, Kien Vu completed a "true" steal of home to break a 4-4 tie with two outs and two strikes in the bottom of the ninth inning to give the Dragons a walk-off win over Fort Wayne on June 11.
- On June 14 vs. Fort Wayne, the Dragons tied a club record for most home runs in a game with six. The Dragons finished the 6-game series with Fort Wayne with 18 HR, 61 runs, and 32 extra base hits, all team records for a series (MWL went to 6-game sets in 2021). The Dragons hit six HRs in one game three other times in '26.
- The Dragons hit 10 grand slams on the year, tying the league record by Wisconsin Rapids in 1981 and breaking the club record of five set in 2013 and 2023. The Dragons hit six grand slams in June and four within a six-game period from June 12-18. Alfredo Duno hit two grand slams in a three-game period June 12-14.
- On June 16 at Peoria, Carter Graham connected on his third grand slam home run of the season to establish a team record for most grand slams in a season and career with the Dragons. Since records on the topic became available in 2005, only five other Dragons players have hit two grand slams in one season (Jeremiah Piepkorn in 2005; Denis Phipps in 2007; Beau Amaral in 2013; Jack Rogers in 2023; Alfredo Duno in 2026).
- On June 18 at Peoria, the Dragons swept a doubleheader to clinch their third First Half East Division title in team history, and their first since 2007. In the second game, the Dragons beat the Chiefs 18-1 as Jacob Friend tied a club record with eight RBI while hitting two home runs including a grand slam. The Dragons hit six home runs in a game to tie their club record (for the third time in 2026).
- On June 18, the final game of the first half, the Dragons broke a club record (stats available since 2005) for most multi-home run games by a player over a single season when Jacob Friend had the Dragons 10th 2-homer game. The number of occurrences has since increased to 12. Dragons with two home runs in a game in 2026 include Carter Graham (3 times), Carlos Sanchez (2 times), Alfredo Alcantara (2 times), Peyton Stovall, Alfredo Duno, Yerlin Confidan, Jacob Friend, and Mason Neville.
- Carter Graham hit 11 home runs for the Dragons in June, the second highest HR total for a Dayton player in franchise history (Austin Kearns had 14 in July, 2000). Graham was selected as the Midwest League Player of the Month and Cincinnati Reds Minor League Player of the Month for June. He became the first Dayton hitter to be named MWL Player of the Month since Blake Dunn in April, 2023, and only the fourth since the award's inception in 2005.
- Brady Afthim tossed an immaculate inning in the eighth inning on July 21. Afthim struck out all three batters in the inning on the minimum nine pitches.
- On July 21, the Dragons posted one of their biggest comebacks in franchise history. They trailed 6-0 in the middle of the second inning, came back to take a 10-9 lead in the sixth, trailed 13-10 going to the bottom of the ninth but tied the game with three in the inning, and won in the 10th on Jacob Friend's sacrifice fly. This was the first time the Dragons won a game despite trailing by at least three runs in the ninth inning since 2024. The six-run deficit tied for sixth largest in a Dragons victory since 2001.
- On August 22, The Dragons hit their 153rd home run of the season to break the club record of 152 set in 2022. The Dragons finished the year with 180 home runs, the second highest total in Midwest League history.
- The Dragons scored 747 runs on the year but break the club record of 730 set in 2000.
- The Dragons finished the season by hitting at least one home run in their final 28 games, the longest home run streak anywhere in Full-Season Minor League Baseball since record-keeping of this statistic began in 2005.
