ABOUT LAST NIGHT... The Vancouver Canadians were pummeled by the Hillsboro Hops (Diamondbacks) 11-4 Wednesday afternoon at Ron Tonkin Field.

The Hops got to C's starter Paxton Schultz (L, 4-5) for two runs in the first and five in the second then added pairs of runs in the fourth and fifth to jump out to an 11-0 lead before Vancouver could get their offense started.

Orelvis Martinez - the #3 Blue Jays prospect - spoiled the shutout with his fifth High-A home run of the year in the fifth before an Andres Guerra double, a wild pitch and a sacrifice fly from Luis De Los Santos scored a run in the seventh to make 11-2.

The Canadians used an error, a walk, and a Tanner Morris double to score two in the ninth but that would be all as they fell 11-4.

Morris was the only C's batter to record two hits in the game and extended his hitting streak to a team-best 14 consecutive games. Spencer Horwitz did the same with a double in the first. On the mound, Justin Maese and Thomas Ruwe combined on three scoreless innings from the sixth through the eighth.

BATTLE FOR THE 'BORO: Vancouver and Hillsboro meet for their fourth series of the season this week. The C's faltered in round three August 3-8 when they were the home team for the first time; they lost the final four games of the series to fall to 8-10 against the Hops this year. Hillsboro has outscored the Canadians 95-78 in the season series thus far.

HOME AWAY FROM HOME: Due to pandemic-related border closures, Ron Tonkin Field in Hillsboro will serve as Vancouver's home ballpark this year. 78 of 120 C's game will take place in the Tualatin Valley over the course of the season (60 home games, 18 as the visitors).

ON THIS DATE IN CANADIANS BASEBALL HISTORY: August 26, 2018 - The C's scored three in the eighth to break a 2-2 tie and beat Boise 5-2 at The Nat. Consecutive one-out walks set the table for a two-RBI double from Griffin Conine then Jake Brodt brought him in with a two-bagger of his own. Connor Law set down the side in order to secure the win.

BMO: Spencer Horwitz was named High-A West Player of the Week for August 17-22. The Timonium, MD native went 13-for-21 (.619) with three doubles, two home runs, six runs scored, six RBI and five walks. He reached base 67% of the time, slugged 1.048 and compiled an OPS of 1.715 in a series split with the Tri-City Dust Devils (Angels) while raising his season average from .260 to .274.

OPENING SALVO: Vancouver and opponents have combined to score 157 runs in the first inning this season, the most of any stanza. The C's have outscored their opposition 79-78.

WE'RE GOING STREAKING: Spencer Horwitz and Tanner Morris have a hit in 14 consecutive games, the longest hitting streak by any C's hitter this season. Horwitz has gone 26-for-54 (.481) with six doubles, three homers, 11 runs scored, 15 RBI and 13 walks while Morris is 18-for-58 (.310) with four doubles, a triple, seven runs scored, five RBI and seven walks.

ON THE HILL: #14 Blue Jays prospect CJ Van Eyk gets the ball for Vancouver looking to lead the C's back into the win column. His name was last called on August 20 against Tri-City when he turned in his fourth consecutive start with two earned runs or less; that day, he went five innings, allowed a pair of runs on four hits, walked two and struck out six but didn't get a decision. Van Eyk, 23, made two starts against Hillsboro the last time these two clubs went head-to-head in early August. He got a game one win on August 3 when he two-hit the Hops over five scoreless innings before taking the loss on August 8 despite allowing only three runs (two earned) on three hits in four frames. In four August starts, the Tampa, FL native is 2-1 with a 2.84 ERA over 19 innings in which he's given up 12 hits, walked eight, K'd 20 and limited opposing opponents to a .179 batting average.

Collin Sullivan goes for the Hops in his second High-A West start. He made his Hops debut on August 20 in Spokane and was roughed up for seven runs on six hits in an inning and a third. He signed as an undrafted free agent in May of this year and made his pro debut with Low-A Visalia, where he appeared in two games (one start), logged 9.2 scoreless innings, allowed two hits, issued no walks and struck out four. Sullivan, 23, played his college ball at the University of South Florida and established a 4.21 ERA in 59 games (50 starts) over four seasons.
