LAST TIME OUT: Brooklyn earned is 6th-straight victory with a 7-2 win at Aberdeen or Friday night...
The win was the Cyclones' 10th-straight against the IronBirds...DH Jesús Báez drove in 3 with an RBI single in the 5th and a 2-run home run in the 9th...C Ronald Hernandez reached base 4 times with 2 hits and 2 walks, adding a 2-run triple to put Brooklyn in front in the 2nd...SS Boston Baro added a pair of knocks and 2B Jefrey De Los Santos collected 2 hits and an RBI...RHP Joel Díaz earned his 4th win, tossing 5.0 innings of 1-hit, 1-run ball, striking out 4...RHP Brendan Girton earned the hold, allowing 1 run on 2 hits in 3.0 innings...RHP Brett Banks pitched a scoreless 9th in his first outing with the club since returning from Single-A St. Lucie.

WE ARE THE CHAMPIONS: Brooklyn clinched its first postseason berth since 2022 by winning the South Atlantic League First Half North Division crown with a 6-4 win at Aberdeen on Thursday night...The playoff berth is the Cyclones' second since moving to the full-season level, winning the Second Half North Division title in 2025...Double-A Binghamton and Single-A St. Lucie clinched the first half crowns in the Eastern League Northeast and Florida State League Eastern Divisions, respectively...Brooklyn's 46-20 (.697) record is the best first-half record in the South Atlantic League since Minor League Baseball reorganized prior to the 2021 season...It is also the best first-half record in the SAL since Augusta (50-20, 1741) and West Virginia (48-20, 706) in 2007...Brooklyn will have home-field advantage in the SAL hoston Division playoffs, hosting Game 2 and, if necessary, Game 3...The 'Clones .701 winning percentage is the best in Minor League Baseball...The 47 wins are 2 behind the Athletics' Triple-A Las Vegas (49) for the MiLB lead.

COMEBACK 'CLONES: Brooklyn erased its 2nd 8th-inning deficit in 3 games in a 6-4 win at Aberdeen on Thursday night...The Cyclones trailed 4-2 entering the 8th on Thursday and 2-1 going into the 8th on Tuesday, coming back to win both...Brooklyn won 3 of their final 4 games of the first half when trailing in the 8th inning or later...The team also won 4 of their final 8 games of the final when either tied or trailing in the 8th inning or later...The Cyclones are 36-5 when scoring first and 11-15 when their opponent scores first.

LATE-INNING MAGIC: Brooklyn has dominated the latter stages of games in 2025...Despite trailing 2-1 through 7 innings on Tuesday and 4-2 through 7 on Thursday, the Cyclones came from behind to win both games en route to a South Atlantic League First Half North Division title...In 2025, Brooklyn has outscored opponents 73-23 (+50) from the 8th inning on...The Cyclones have outdueled their foes, 37-10, in the 8th, 32-11, in the 9th, and 4-2, in the 10th inning and beyond.

ROSTER MOVES: Brooklyn made a pair of roster moves prior to Saturday's game...The Cyclones have transferred RHP **Dakota Hawkins** to Triple-A Syracuse and RHP **Eduardo Herrera** to Double-A Binghamton...Brooklyn's active roster currently stands at 28 players.

SUERO SUAVE: C Chris Suero provided the go-ahead 3-run home run in the 8th inning of Brooklyn's First Half North Division-clinching win at Aberdeen on Thursday night...The 21-year-old also delivered the go-ahead 2-run double in the 8th inning on Tuesday...In the first 3 games of the series against Aberdeen. Suero is 8-for-14 (.571) at the plate with 4 runs scored, a double, a triple, a hore run, and 7 RBI... The Bronx native has also reached safely in 6-straight games, going 10-for-24 (.417) at the dish...In June, Suero is hitting .302/.397/.491/.888 with 9 runs scored, 5 extra-base hits, 2 home runs, and 13 RBI... Entering play on Saturday, the catcher is 3rd in the South Atlantic League in hit-by-pitches (13), tied for 3rd in RBI (.42), 8th in slugging percentage (.459), tied for 8th in stolen bases (21), and 9th in OPS (.845).

MARCO POLO: INF Marco Vargas has been scorching hot over the last few weeks, helping lead Brooklyn to a First Half North Division crown...The 20-year-old is riding a 10-game on-base streak since June 8, hitting. 400/.500/.457/.957 with 7 runs scored, 2 doubles, 6 RBI, 7 walks, and 9 stolen bases...In June, Vargas is slashing. 320/.414/.360/.774 with 8 runs scored, 2 doubles, 7 RBI, 8 walks, and 11 swiped bags...Since making his Cyclones debut, the Chilhuahua, Mexico native is tied for 3rd in the South Atlantic League in stolen bases (22)...He is also 7th in the league in steals for the year.

REIMER SHINE: INF Jacob Reimer has had a fabulous start to the 2025 season...Entering play on Saturday, Reimer leads the South Atlantic League in runs scored (52) and is tied for the league lead in doubles (18)...The Yucaipa, Calif. native is 2nd in extra-base hits (30), 3rd in total bases (115) slugging percentage (.509), and OPS (.898), tied for 3rd in hits (63) and triples (4), 4th in hits (65), tied for 5th in RBI (39), 7th in batting average (.288), and 10th in on-base percentage (.389)...Reimer was limited to just 35 games in 2024 with a hamstring injury.

BENGE IT LIKE CARSON: OF Carson Benge has been heating up at the plate...The 2024 first-round pick enters Saturday leading tied for the South Atlantic League in doubles (18) and triples (5)...He is also 2nd in runs scored (47), 3rd in batting average (.297), on-base percentage (.410), and hits (6d), 4th in OPS (.887) and extra-base hits (27), 5th in total bases (106) and slugging percentage (.477), tied for 5th in walks (39), and tied for 8th in RBI (37)...Benge is also riding a 12-game on-base streak since June 7, hitting ,306/404/.469/.873 with 7 runs scored, 6 doubles, a triple, 10 RBI, 6 walks, and 3 stolen bases... The Yukon, Okla. native was recognized on Mil.B.com's "Prospect Team of the Week" from May 20-25 after hitting ,412 (7-17) with 8 runs scored, 3 doubles, 2 triples, an RBI, 8 walks to 3 strikeouts, 2 stolen bases, and 2 hit-by-pitches in 6 games at Jersey Shore from May 20-25.

EWING-ING IT: IF/OF A.J. Ewing has had a marvelous start to his 2025 season...Entering play on Saturday, the Springboro, Ohio native is 3rd in all of Minor League Baseball in stolen bases (46) and tied for 3rd in triples (7)...Since debuting with Brooklyn on April 29, Ewing leads the league in steals (32), registering 7 more than anyone else...He is also 2nd in on-base percentage (.406), 3rd in runs scored (34), tied for 3rd in triples (3), 4th in walks (30) and hits (48), tied for 5th in games played (42), and 7th in batting average (.293)...Overall, Ewing is 2nd in the SAL in stolen bags (32), and 5th in batting average (.293) and on-base percentage (.406)..The 2023 4th-round pick was recognized as the South Atlantic League Player of the Week for May 13-18 vs. Winston-Salem...In 5 games, the 20-year-old went 9-for-18 (.500) at the plate with 5 runs scored, 2 doubles, a triple, 3 RBI, 5 walks, and 6 stolen bases...Ewing led the SAL in steals (6) and on-base percentage (.609) for the week...He was the first Cyclone to receive a league weekly honor since INF Nick Lorusso and LHP Felipe De La Cruz took home Player and Pitcher of the Week, respectively, for May 20-26, 2024.

CAN'T TUCC THIS: LHP Jonathan Santucci has found his form in 2025...The 2024 Mets' 2nd-round selection is a perfect 4-0 over his last 5 outings (3 starts), including a career-high-tying 51 scoreless inning performance in a no-decision on June 4 at Wilmington...Since May 16 vs. Winston-Salem, the 22-year-old has a 4-0 record with a 1.20 ERA (4 ER in 30.0 IP) with 17 hits allowed, 10 walks, and 32 strikeouts...Santucci saw his scoreless inning streak come to an end at 18.0 frames in May 10's win vs. Asheville...The southpaw's streak spanned from the 2nd inning in Game 1 of a doubleheader on May 23 at Jersey Shore until the top of the 7th with two outs on May 10...Since May 16, Santucci leads the South Atlantic League in ERA (1.20) and is tied for 1st in wins (4)...He is also 3rd in batting average against (.160), 4th in WHIP (0.90), 9th in innings pitched (30.0), and tied for 10th in strikeouts (32).

NOAH'S ARC: After being limited to just 13.0 mings in his first professional season in 2024, RHP Noah Hall has found a new gear in 2025...The 24-year-old registered his 1st pro save on June 5 at Wilmington, tossing 4.0 innings of 1-hit shutout ball...The save was Hall's first since April 30, 2021, vs. the University of Louisiana at Monroe, while pitching for Appalachian State University...Entering play on Wednesday, the Charlotte, N.C. native is 2nd in the South Atlantic League in ERA (2.39), 7th in batting average against (.200), and tied for 8th in innings pitched (60.1).

ALL BÁEZ ON ME: After recovering from knee surgery, INF Jesús Báez has slowly returned to form... Since the start of May, Báez leads the South Atlantic League in RBI (33)...He is also 3rd in on-base percentage (.399), 4th in OPS (.870), 7th in total bases (66), tied for 7th in batting average (.293), tied for 8th in hits (41), and 9th in slugging percentage (.471)...On the year, Báez is tied for 8th in RBI (37)...The 20-year-old reached base safely in 17-of-23 plate appearances in the May 20-25 series against Jersey

vs. ABERDEEN: After taking 4-of-6 at home against Asheville, Brooklyn hits the road for the final 3 games of the first half and the opening 3 games of the second half...Aberdeen dropping 3-of-5 from Jersey Shore...Sunday's series finale was canceled due to unplayable field conditions...The IronBirds are 10-21 at Ripken Stadium this season...Brooklyn took 4-of-6 from Aberdeen in Maryland from April 15-20 and lead the season series, 14-2...The IronBirds boast 8 of the Orioles' Top 30 prospects per MLB Pipeline: OF Vance Honeycutt (4), INF Griff O'Ferrall (6), RHP Michael Forret (7), LHP Luis De León (13), INF Aron Estrada (16), C Ethan Anderson (17), INF Leandro Arias (21), and OF Austin Overn (30)...Anderson is currently on the injured list...In 279 meetings since 2002, the Cyclones lead the all-time series, 151-128 (.541)...Brooklyn is 73-57 (.562) against the IronBirds in 130 games at Ripken Stadium.

Shore and went 6-for-8 at the plate in May 23's doubleheader with 3 runs scored, a double, 2 home runs, and 7 RBI, en route to winning South Atlantic League Player of the Week honors...During the week, Báez hit 647 (11-17) with 6 runs scored, 2 home runs, and 10 RBI...The infielder led the circuit in batting average (.647), on-base percentage (.739), slugging percentage (1.059) OPS (1.798), and was tied for the league lead in RBI (10)...After OF A.J. Ewing won Player of the Week for May 13-18, it maked the first time Brooklyn hitters had won a league's Player of the Week award in consecutive weeks in franchise history.

SWIPER (KEEP SWIPING: Brooklyn is off to a historic start on the basepaths in 2025...The Cyclones' 7-6 win vs. Wilmington on April 29 saw them nab a franchise record 9 stolen bases, courtesy of 7 players...The mark topped a previous high of 8 on August 2, 2017, vs. Tri-City...Brooklyn enters play on Saturday with 153 steals, good for the 2nd most in the South Atlantic League behind only Aberdeen (162)...The 153 steals are tied for 6th in Minor League Baseball...Cleveland's Single-A Lynchburg leads MiLB (192)...Brooklyn already has 3 players with 20-plus steals, 7 players with 10-0-more steals, and 9 players with 5-plus...The 153 swiped bags are the most by the Cyclones through the team's first 67 games in Minor League Baseball's Digital era (2005-present) by 55 swipes...The 2005 club is 2nd with 98...The Cyclones are 28 steals shy of breaking their single-season franchise record of 181 steals set in 2024.

GIRT 'ER DONE: After tossing 5.0 perfect innings record on to sceaas act in 2014.

GIRT 'ER DONE: After tossing 5.0 perfect innings in June 14's 1-0 win vs. Asheville, RHP Brendan Girton was named South Atlantic League Pitcher of the Week on Monday for Week 12 (June 10-15)...The 23-year-old is the first Cyclone pitcher to receive a weekly honor this year and the first to win Pitcher of the Week since LHP Felipe De La Cruz took home the award for May 20-26, 2024...Girton is the first Cyclones' right-hander to earn the honor since RHP Luis Moreno won for July 25-31, 2022...Girton did not receive a decision on June 14, but retired all 15 batters he faced, striking out 6...He, RHP JoB Za (30 IP), and RHP Raimon Gómez (1.0) combined on a 4-hit shutout...Since May 1, the Gage, Okla., native is 2nd in the South Atlantic League in batting average against (.172), 3rd in WHIP (0.94), and 5th in ERA (2.41)...Among pitchers with 45.0 or more innings, Girton is tied for 7th in the SAL in strikeouts-per-9-innings (10.76) and 10th in ERA (2.92).

HOME COOKING: Brooklyn has been a model of consistency at Maimonides Park this year...June 12's defeat vs. Asheville marked the end of the Cyclones' 15-game home winning streak...Brooklyn's franchise record for consecutive home wins is 19, set in the inaugural 2001 campaign...Entering play on Friday, Brooklyn holds the best home record in the South Atlantic League at 26-7 (7.8B)...Greenville is second best (22-16)...The 26 home wins are tied for the 3rd most in all of Mil.B...The Athletics' Triple-A Las Vegas leads the minors (28)...Brooklyn's .788 home winning percentage is the best in Mil.B...Pittsburgh's Triple-A Indianapolis (.750) is 2nd.

KEEP THE 'COASTER MOVING: The Cyclones remained perfect in series through the first 67 games of the 2025 season with Friday's Second Half-opening victory at Aberdeen, earning the series victory...Through Brooklyn's first 12 series of the year, the Cyclones hold a 9-0-3 record...In home series, Brooklyn is 5-0-1, splitting their first full 6-game set with Hudson Valley from April 8-13...The Cyclones have not lost a series since they dropped 5-0-6 at home vs. Jersey Shore from August 20-25, 2024...Since then, Brooklyn is 11-0-3 in a series of any length.

THRICE IS NICE: The Cyclones completed the 2nd triple play in franchise history in the top of the 9th inning in Sunday's comeback win vs. Asheville...Tourists SS Drew Vogel hit into a 4-3-5 triple play...2B Marco Vargas fielded the ball behind second, stepped on the bag, and threw to 1B Jacob Reimer for a double play...Reimer then threw across the diamond where 3B Jesús Báez tagged out CF Lucas Spence, who overslid the bag, for the triple play...lt marked Brooklyn's first triple-killing since July 10, 2016, on a 2-6-4 triple play from C Dan Rizzie, to SS Colby Woodmansee, to 2B Nick Sergakis...1B Pete Alonso was on the field for the 1st triple play in franchise history...Brooklyn then turned a double play to start the 10th inning, as 1B Oliver Carrillo filed out to left and Vogel was tagged out trying to advance to 3rd...RHP Ben Simon recorded 6 outs by facing only 3 batters...t is the only known occurrence of a pitcher recording at least 6 outs and facing 3 or fewer batters since at least 1910.

BROOKLYN TO THE BIGS: After 4 former Cyclones made their Major League debuts in 2024, 5 alumni have already accomplished the feat in 2025, and a 6th could be on its way...RHP Paul Gervase (2023), who was traded to the Tampa Bay Rays at the trade deadline last year, had his contract selected from Triple-A Durham on Saturday...RHP Blade Tidwell (2023) became the 5th to debut this year, suffering the loss in a start for the New York Mets in Game 1 of May 4's doubleheader at St. Louis...OF Rhylan Thomas (2023) with the Seattle Mariners, RHP Mike Vasil (2022) with the Chicago White Sox, OF Jake Mangum (19, '21) with the Rays, and C Hayden Senger ('18, '21) with the New York Mets are the others to debut this year.

THIS DATE IN CYCLONES HISTORY: On June 21, 2010, RF Cory Vaughn tripled and clubbed a 2-run home run in Brooklyn's 5-2 win vs. Aberdeen...In 2011, down 2-0 entering the 7th, the Cyclones tied the game on a 2-run double by RF Javier Rodríguez and walked it off in the 9th on a 18 Luke Stewart RBI double in a 3-2 win vs. Aberdeen...In 2014, Brooklyn scored 3 runs in the top of the 11th, tallying run on a dropped third strike wild pitch, RF Michael Bernal single, and a 3B Jhoan Ureña bunt in a 3-1 win at Aberdeen...In 2016, the 'Clones tallied 5 runs in the bottom of the 7th in an 8-3 win vs. Tri-City...SC Colby Woodmansee provided the go-ahead 2-run single...In 2018, RHP Christian James (6.2 IP) and RHP Trent Johnson (2.1) combined on a 2-hit shutout in a 6-0 win at Connecticut...In 2022, Brooklyn scored 2 in the 8th to tie and 2 in the 9th to walk-off Jersey Shore, 4-3...CF Jaylen Palmer scored the tying run on a wild pitch, and LF Matt Rudick delivered the walk-off sacrifice fly.

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: Brooklyn's roster features no shortage of talent...According to MLB Pipeline, the Cyclones boast 12 of the Mets' Top 30 prospects...Those include OF Carson Benge (3), INF Jesús Báez (7), LHP Jonathan Santucci (11), INF Boston Baro (12), INF Marco Vargas (13), INF Jacob Reimer (17), RHP Nate Dohm (18), C Chris Suero (20), OF Eli Serrano III (21) and C Ronald Hernández (5), OF A.J. Ewing (26), and RHP Will Watson (29)...The Cyclones also possess 11 of the Mets' Top 30 farmhands per Baseball America...The list features Báez (6), Benge (7), Ewing (8), Reimer (10), Vargas (11), Baro (17), Santucci (18), Suero (19), Serrano III (20), RHP Raimon Gómez (21), and Dohm (24)...Brooklyn also hosts 11 of SNY's Top 30 from Joe DeMayo...Benge (5), Báez (6), Baro (13), Santucci (15), Vargas (17), Dohm (20), Reimer (21), Serrano (22), Suero (25), Hernández (26), and Gómez (28).

FLASH GORDON: The Santa Clarita, Calif. native has been outstanding for the Cyclones in 2025...Entering play on Saturday, among South Atlantic League pitchers with 50.0 or more innings of work, Gordon is 6th in the circuit in ERA (2.73)...He is also 8th in the SAL in strikeouts-per-9-innings (10.59).
