## JACKSONVILLE WALKS OFF NASHVILLE IN EXTRAS

After falling behind early, the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp rallied from three different deficits Wednesday in their 10-9 10-inning win over the Nashville Sounds at 121 Financial Ballpark. Jacksonville (9-7) entered the bottom of the 10th trailing 9-7. Santiago Chavez started the inning at second and CJ Hinojosa grounded out, allowing Chavez to advance to third. With two outs, Jordan Groshans walked and Peyton Burdick singled, scoring Chavez to cut the deficit to 9-8. Groshans advanced to third on Burdick's single. With runners at the corners, Jerar Encarnacion knocked a single plating Groshans to tie the game, and on the same play, Burdick scored the winning run on a bobbled relay throw.

#### FIRST THINGS FIRST

In 13 of the club's 16 contests thus far in 2023, the Jumbo Shrimp have had their leadoff man reach base to start the game. Of those 13 leadoff baserunners, five have come on swings on the first pitch. Nine of those 13 leadoff baserunners have also come via hits. Of those other four leadoff baserunners, three were via walks and one on an error.

#### THE \*START\* OF SOMETHING?

Jacksonville starting pitchers have ceded three runs or fewer in nine of their last 10 games. During that span, Jumbo Shrimp lid-lifters have yielded 23 runs, 20 earned, on 49 hits in 50.2 innings for a 3.55 ERA. This stretch has not seen Jacksonville starters strike out many opponents, with the club's rotation registering just 40 punchouts (7.1 K/9). However, they have only issued 14 walks during this run, a rate of 2.5 per nine innings.

#### GO C.J., GO C.J., GO C.J., GO

On Jacksonville's slugging offense, perhaps no one has shined more than **C.J. Hinojosa**. Through 12 games thus far in 2023, Hinojosa is 18-for-48, slashing a robust .370/.397/.722/1.119 with two doubles, one triple, four home runs, 16 RBIs and eight runs scored. The Houston native ranks tied for fifth in the International League in RBIs, fifth in batting average, eighth in slugging, tied for ninth in home runs, 11th in OPS and tied for 10th in hits. The Houston, Texas native has hits in seven consecutive games entering play on Thursday.

#### BYE-BYE BURDICK

Coming into 2023, **Peyton Burdick** hadn't recorded a multihomer game since bashing two in Biloxi on August 4, 2021 while playing for Double-A Pensacola. The Cincinnati native has already registered two multi-homer games this season , and his eight on the season lead the International League. Burdick is also second in the IL in extra-base hits (12), second in hits (23), tied for second in RBIs (18), fourth in runs scored (17), seventh in slugging (.761), seventh in OPS (1.166) and 21st in batting average (.343). Heading into play on Thursday, Burdick has a hit in 15 consecutive games, the longest such streak in the circuit.

#### LEADERS, NOT FOLLOWERS

The Jumbo Shrimp weren't able to get a first inning tally on April 14, which ended their streak of five consecutive games with a first inning run. Still though, over their 16 games played, the Jumbo Shrimp have struck for at least one tally in their first at-bats 10 times. Jacksonville has scored first over their opponent in nine of their 16 games thus far in 2023, going 7-2 (.778) when doing so. Conversely, the club has struggled when falling behind, going just 2-5 (.285). The Jumbo Shrimp scored the game's first run 83 times during the 2022 season (55.7 percent) and had a 62-21 (.747) record when doing so.

#### THE SOUND(S) OF MUSIC

After owning the Nashville Sounds in 2021 with a 5-1 record, the Jumbo Shrimp struggled in 2022 against the eventual IL West Champs. In 18 contests last season, Jacksonville finished six games below .500, winning just six total affairs for a .333 winning percentage. Nashville owned Jumbo Shrimp pitching, slashing .303/.373/.451/.824 with 42 XBHs (21 2B, 1 3B, 20 HR). Of the 10 International League teams the Jumbo Shrimp matched up against in 2022, the pitching staff owned the second-worst ERA (5.52) against Nashville.

#### SHRIMP BITES

The Jumbo Shrimp are 13-for-14 (92.9 percent) on their stolen base attempts during that span... Jacksonville's 39 walks over the last seven games since April 11 are second in the circuit. The Jumbo Shrimp mustered just 25 in their first eight games, the second-fewest in the league.

-In high school, Bryan was selected as a 2014 Under Armour All-American and was rated the 131st-best prospect in the nation by Perfect Game in 2015.

-He was ranked as the fourth-best player in the state of Indiana and the third-best right-handed pitcher as a senior in high school.

-Hoeing was named to All-Tournament Teams at 2014 Perfect Game WWBA 17U National Championship and 2013 Perfect Game WWBA 16u National Championship.

### 2023 SEASON

-Made first appearance of the season, coming out of the bullpen against Gwinnett. He tossed three innings, allowing just one run on five hits with four punch outs.

### 2022 SEASON

-Made MLB debut on 8/20/22 against the Los Angeles Dodgers.

-Hoeing was transferred to Jacksonville on May 3 from Double-A Pensacola. At the time of his promotion, Hoeing was leading the Southern League in both ERA (0.35) and innings pitched (25.2) while ranking second in both batting average against (.211) and WHIP (0.94), tied for fourth in wins (2) and sixth in strikeouts (26).

#### 2021 SEASON

-There, Hoening made 22 appearances (22 GS) going 7-6 with a 4.83 ERA in 121.0 innings, he allowed 65 ER and held opponents to a .267 batting average.

-After posting a 7.91 ERA in May (19.1 IP), 6.12 ERA in June (32.1 IP) and 6.29 ERA in July (24.1 IP), Hoeing closed the season strong. In August, he went 2-0 with a 1.00 ERA in four starts (27.0 IP, 16 H, 7 BB, 23 K). In three September starts, the right-hander worked to a 2-0 record and 3.00 ERA (18.0 IP, 19 H, BB, 11 K).

### **2019 SEASON**

-After being drafted in the seventh round of the MLB draft in 2019, Hoening was sent to the NYPL with the Batavia Muckdogs.

-In nine relief appearances, he tossed 22.1 innings and struck out 17 in his professional debut season

-He tallied his first professional strikeout on 7/18 vs. the Auburn Doubledays.

#### ADDITIONAL CAREER NOTES

-Originally drafted out of high school by the Arizona Diamondbacks in the 32nd round (2015) but elected not to sign.

-Signed with Louisville but also strongly considered North Carolina, Vanderbilt, Indiana and Georgia Tech.

-His mom, Donna, is the person whom had the greatest influence on his athletic career. She played basketball at Ball State. Meanwhile, Bryan's cousin, Alex Meyer, plays in the Minnesota Twins' organization.
