Dayton has romped to victories in the first two games of the series, improving to 8-6 against the Nuts, 5-3 in Lansing. Former Wake Forest Demon Deacon **Colin Peluse**, Baseball America's No. 26 Athletics prospect, makes his 13th Lugnuts start, taking on former Clemson Tiger **Carson Spiers** for Dayton.

Yesterday: Dragons 12, Lugnuts 4. 2021 17th overall selection **Matt McLain** enjoyed a smashing Dayton debut, going 4-for-5 with two singles, a three-run double and a two-run homer to lead the Dragons to the Wednesday matinee romp. The game was played in three hours and 12 minutes, with a 92-minute rain delay between the 5th and 6th innings.

On Deck: Tomorrow is a *LAFCU Frontline Friday* with LAFCU Fireworks following the game.

What's New in 2021: Entering this season, the Lugnuts' stadium name changed from Cooley Law School Stadium to Jackson® Field™, Lansing moved up to the High-A Central and the ballclub accepted an invitation to affiliate with the A's, the Nuts' fourth MLB partner, following the Royals (1996-98), Cubs (1999-2004) and Blue Jays (2005-2020).

LUG•NOTES: HEADLINES AND POINTS OF INTEREST

Welcome Aboard: Third baseman **Brett Harris** and shortstop **Drew Swift** joined the Lugnuts today and are immediately in the starting lineup, becoming the 48th and 49th different Lugnuts to suit up this season and the 852nd and 853rd Lugnuts all-time. They are also the first members of the 2021 draft class to join the Nuts, with Harris selected in the 7th round from Gonzaga University and Swift taken by Oakland in the 8th round from Arizona State University.

All You Need is Glove: Speaking of the Lugnuts' newest additions, Harris was named the 2021 West Coast Conference Defensive Player (in addition to being honored as First Team All-Conference, leading the Bulldogs with a .355 average, 1.027 OPS, 52 runs, 70 hits and 18 extra-base hits in 52 games, committing only two errors) and Swift was named the Pac-12 Defensive Player of the Year, the first Sun Devil so honored, and received the 2021 ABCA/Rawlings Gold Glove as the nation's top defensive shortstop.

Hump Day: The curse of the Wednesdays struck again yesterday, with the Lugnuts falling to 3-12 on their worst day of the week.

Twice Roasted: Dayton has won the first two games of this series by a combined 22-5 score. The Dragons have more extra-base hits (12) than the Lugnuts have total base hits (11) in the series.

Going Streaking: **William Simoneit** went 1-for-4 with a run scored yesterday, extending his team-high hitting streak to 11 games. He's hitting 15-for-44, .341, in those 11 games, dating back to July 30.

Alumni Report: **Vladimir Guerrero, Jr.**, who played for the 2017 Lansing squad at 18 years old, is second in the Majors in home runs (35), first in RBIs (88), third in on-base percentage (.405), third in slugging percentage (.619), first in OPS (1.024), first in total bases (255), and tied for first in runs scored (87) with 2017 Nuts teammate **Bo Bichette**. Meanwhile, 2019 Lugnuts outfielder **Griffin Conine**, currently with Double-A Pensacola, leads MiLB with 30 homers.

Hoya Saxa: The Lugnuts have won all seven games in which **Jack Cushing** has pitched, including both games the Georgetown right-hander pitched at Lake County, Tuesday's opener and Sunday's finale. In just seven appearances, six starts, in the High-A Central, Cushing is already tied for the league lead with six victories. Cushing is scheduled to start again on Saturday night against Dayton.

Nut-lympics Report: Event 4, Clubhouse H-O-R-S-E was held today before the game. Event 3, Juggling, was held before last Saturday night's game, with **Jared McDonald** winning the gold medal, **DJ Lee** capturing silver and **Yerdel Vargas** taking bronze. Event 2, Grape Catching, was held three days earlier, last Wednesday, with the pairing of tosser **Brock Whittlesey** and catcher **William Simoneit** winning gold, followed by **Leudeny Pineda/Elvis Peralta, Jr.** taking silver, and **Jorge Juan/José Mora** earning bronze. Event 1, Fungo Golf, came two Sundays ago, opening the Nut-lympics, with **Anthony Phillips** winning gold, **Javier Godard** silver and **Charles Hall** bronze.

TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2011: For the second time in the season, Jake Marisnick led off the game with a home run, pounding a 2-0 pitch from South Bend's Jeffrey Shields to left. Marisnick finished 4-for-5 with two steals, catcher Jack Murphy went 3-for-3 with two doubles, 3 RBIs and a walk, and the Lugnuts won on the road, 6-2.
2016: To Be Continued! Jackson Lowery struck out West Michigan catcher Shane Zeile with the bases loaded to end the 10th inning, and the umpires called it due to wet conditions – forcing a suspension in a 3-3 tie between the two clubs at Fifth Third Ballpark. The game was picked up again on August 13th, and it required 19 minutes to complete, with the Lugnuts winning in 11 innings, 5-3.

Root, Root, Root for the Home Team: July 4th's Lugnuts/Dragons series finale drew a season-high attendance of 10,109. That's higher than the average attendance in MLB for the Baltimore Orioles, Pittsburgh Pirates, Tampa Bay Rays, Miami Marlins and Oakland Athletics. Only nine of the 119 other Minor League teams have drawn a larger crowd to a game this season: Albuquerque, Nashville, Salt Lake, Charlotte, Fresno, Indianapolis, Round Rock, Durham and Las Vegas.

Pitching is an Art... and So is Sculpting: Blake McFarland, who pitched for the 2012 Lansing Lugnuts, is now a professional sculptor who competed on NBC's reality show "Making It," hosted by Nick Offerman and Amy Poehler, but was eliminated in the fifth episode.

Major League Lugnuts: Five former Nuts have made their Major League debuts this season - pitcher **Ty Tice** '18 (Toronto, now with Arizona), outfielder **Josh Palacios** '16-'17 (Toronto), pitcher **Taylor Saucedo** '16-'17 (Toronto), pitcher **Conner Greene** '15 (Baltimore) and pitcher **Kirby Sneed** '16-'17 (Toronto). Tice and Palacios made their first MLB appearance in the same game for the Toronto Blue Jays on April 9th. It was the seventh time in team history that two Lugnuts made their MLB debut in the same game, with the first occurring on September 14, 1998: **Carlos Febles** and **Carlos Beltrán** for the Kansas City Royals. Sneed most recently debuted, appearing in relief for the Blue Jays on July 28.

Star of Stars: The 2021 MLB All-Star Game MVP Award was won by 2017 Lugnut **Vladimir Guerrero, Jr.**, who went 1-for-3 with two RBIs, including a 468-foot home run, in the American League's 5-2 victory. Fellow 2017 Lugnut **Bo Bichette** came off the bench for the A.L. as reserve shortstop.

Record-Setting, Single Game, Stolen Bases: On June 15, **Max Schuemann** broke **Samad Taylor's** franchise single-game record of four steals in a game (set July 1, 2018) with five stolen bases against the Great Lakes Loons.

Record-Setting, Single Game, Home Runs Allowed: On June 20, **Stevie Emanuels** broke the franchise single game record, tied many times before, of three homers served up in a game, giving up four HRs to the Loons - two apiece by Deacon Liput and Andy Pages.

Record-Setting, Single Game, HBPs: On July 14, Lansing Lugnuts pitchers hit seven Lake County Captains, breaking the franchise single game record, and the second-highest single game HBP total for a team plunked by one pitching staff behind the 1993 Gulf Coast League Braves, who were hit eight times on June 18, 1993.

Representing His Country: 1B/3B **Jordan Díaz** played for Colombia in Olympic Baseball Qualifying play, blasting a game-tying home run in the 9th against Venezuela, but Colombia lost all three games in opening pool play and was eliminated. Team USA won the tournament, punching a ticket to Japan.

Front Office Connections: Lugnuts pitching coach **Don Schulze** was drafted 11th overall by the Chicago Cubs in 1980, 12 picks before Oakland Executive Vice President of Baseball Operations **Billy Beane** was drafted by the New York Mets. Lugnuts first baseman **Patrick McColl** set a new Harvard baseball single season record with 70 hits in 2019, breaking the previous record held by Athletics General Manager David Forst.

International Appeal: Seven nations are represented on the Lugnuts' roster: USA, Colombia, Cuba, Dominican Republic, Japan, South Africa (**Anthony Phillips**) and Venezuela (**Javier Godard**).

Finally: Pitchers **Jeff Criswell**, **Stevie Emanuels** and **Shohei Tomioka**, catchers **Jared McDonald**, **Drew Millas** and **William Simoneit**, first baseman **Patrick McColl**, and outfielder **Michael Guldberg** have all made their pro debut this season with the Lugnuts.

So Many Starters: The Nuts have used 16 different starting pitchers this season, **Brady Basso**, **Reid Birlingmair**, **Charlie Cerny**, **Jeff Criswell**, **Jack Cushing**, **David Leal**, **Stevie Emanuels**, **Richard Guasch**, **Jorge Juan**, **Rafael Kelly**, **Bryce Nightengale**, **Colin Peluse**, **Leudeny Pineda**, **Seth Shuman**, **Shohei Tomioka** and **Brock Whittlesey**.

Three Nuts Go to Washington: On July 30, catcher **Drew Millas** and pitchers **Richard Guasch** and **Seth Shuman** were traded by the Athletics to the Washington Nationals in exchange for catcher **Yan Gomes** and utilityman **Josh Harrison**.

Prospecting: Rated Baseball America's **No. 26** A's prospect... "Not assigned to the alternate training site, Peluse committed to an at-home workout plan tailored to increase his leg strength and added 10 pounds of muscle. He arrived at instructional league showing significant velocity gains, much to the A's surprise... Peluse's fastball sat 96 mph and touched 98 at instructs, a marked increase from his low-90s readings in college. His slider was already a plus pitch, showing late life and more drop than a typical slider"... MLB Pipeline's **No. 26** A's prospect, grading his fastball at 55, slider at 55, change-up at 50 and control at 45, writing about Peluse, "A ninth-round pick in 2019, Peluse has put himself on the prospect radar for the A's after showing up to the instructional league that consistently hit 97-98. Now carrying a power fastball, Peluse also brings a strong slider that flashes plus, as well as a changeup that is still developing."

Notable 2021 Moments in Lansing:

- May 8 vs. Lake County: made High-A debut in relief, following Jeff Criswell (2 IP) and Shohei Tomioka (3 IP)... worked with William Simoneit to form an all-Wake Forest battery... picked Bryan Lavastida off 1st base.
- May 22 at Fort Wayne: made first High-A start... departed in the 4th with one out, one run in and the bases loaded, and Bryce Nightengale allowed all three inherited runners to score.
- June 5 vs. South Bend: Domination. A team-high 10 strikeouts in 5 2/3 innings.
- June 12 at West Michigan: held Whitecaps scoreless for the first four innings... five hits and five runs in the 5th.
- July 11 at Great Lakes: served up HRs to the first two batters, James Outman and Justin Yurchak, before blanking the Loons over the next 12 outs, with five strikeouts.

Last Outing: August 6 at Lake County, earned his fourth straight win in outdueling 2019 first-rounder Daniel Espino... allowed sacrifice flies in each of the first two innings before blanking the Captains for the remainder of his 5 2/3 innings... 85 pitches, 59 strikes... Lugnuts triumphed, 5-3.

Draft Day: Taken 284th overall in the 9th round, 2019, and signed for \$149,300... highest of five Wake Forest players drafted in 2019... only one Demon Deacon was drafted in 2020, but it was Braves first-rounder Jared Shuster, taken 25th overall... one of nine Lugnuts drafted in 2019, including the 6th round (Seth Shuman), 7th round (Drew Millas), 10th round (Patrick McColl), 16th round (Brady Basso), 19th round (Jared McDonald), 21st round (Shane Selman), 26th round (Elvis Peralta, Jr.) and 33rd round (Charles Hall)... college teammates with 2019 Lugnuts third baseman Johnny Aiello.

Life as a Pro: Debuted with SS-A Vermont on June 28th, 2019... made four straight starts, not throwing more than three innings in any of them, and then moved to the pen, with five scoreless innings in relief July 27th... in final outing, struck out six in 3 2/3 at Lowell on August 8th.

College: Spent three years at Wake Forest University... began as a Tuesday starter as a freshman before moving to bullpen and pitching effectively (3.54 ERA, 20 G, 7 GS, 40 2/3 IP, 12 BB, 37 K), with three NCAA shutout Super Regional appearances at Florida... served as Sunday starter as sophomore and was Wake Forest's top starter statistically (3.87 ERA, 16 G, 14 GS, 83 2/3 IP, 26 BB, 63 K)... Friday starter as a junior (5.74 ERA, 15 GS, 80.0 IP, 12 HR, 36 BB, 71 K)... in total at Wake: 4.54 ERA, 51 G, 36 GS, 204 1/3 IP, 200 H, 21 HR, 74 BB, 171 K... pitched in summer ball for the Baltimore Redbirds in 2017 (6 G, 3 GS, 1.37 ERA, 26 1/3 IP, 4 ER, 7 BB, 21 K) and for the Chatham Anglers in 2018 (2.57 ERA, 2 G, 7.0 IP, 3 H, 2 ER, 4 BB, 10 K).

High School: At Middletown H.S., spent one year on wrestling team... was also a member of Sports Medicine and ROTC... in second start, junior year, on the Middletown Cavaliers baseball team, tossed no-hitter with 11 strikeouts at Wilmington Blue Rocks' Frawley Stadium, and then woke up the next day and couldn't move his arm... the injury led to Tommy John surgery, causing Peluse to miss entire senior season... still was rated No. 2 player in Delaware by Perfect Game.

Hometown: Middletown, Delaware, is in New Castle County, located in the northern part of the state just across from the Maryland border... it hosts the Olde Tyme Peach Festival each August and the Big Ball Marathon every Labor Day (a 24-hour baseball marathon for charity played with an oversized softball, the "big ball")... St. Andrew's School in Middletown was the site for the filming of Dead Poets Society (1989), starring Robin Williams, with the theater scene in the movie filmed at Middletown's Everett Theatre... there was also an episode of The West Wing filmed at St. Andrew's School... Tampa Bay wide receiver Chris Godwin is from Middletown and attended Middletown H.S.
