TODAY'S GAME: The Curve continue their lone series of the season against the New Hampshire FIsher Cats at PNG Field.

LAST TIME OUT: Anthony Solometo tossed six scoreless and combined with Jaden Woods on a 4-hit shutout of New Hampshire, 1-0.

5 GUYS: Altoona has won five straight games to begin a six-game series for just the second time since the schedule format was adopted in 2021. The Curve won five straight in their second-ever six-game series from May 11-16, 2021 at Binghamton. Altoona has never won all six games in a six-game series since the format was adopted. Altoona has been swept one time in a six-game series from April 23-28, 2024 against the Akron RubberDucks. Twice in the 2023 season, Altoona lost the first game of a series and then won five in a row to finish the week.

SEND US HOME: Altoona picked up their eighth walk-off win of the season on Friday, August 30 against New Hampshire when Matt Fraizer vanked a 3-run homer over the right field wall in the 10th inning. The Curve's 8 walk-off wins this season puts them in striking distance for the franchise record of 10, set by the 2005 Curve.

THE GUY WE WANT UP THERE: Infielder Brenden Dixon picked up his second walk-off hit of the season on Thursday, August 29 against New Hampshire. After Altoona bunted the game-winning run to third to start the 10th in a tie game, New Hampshire intentionally walked Matt Fraizer and Termarr Johnson to set up a force play at home and Dixon made them pay with a single to left-center to earn the victory.

THAT BALL IS LOOOOOOONG GONE: Altoona banged three homers in their win over New Hampshire on Wednesday, August 28, the most in a game for the Curve at PNG Field since May 25, 2023 when the Curve hit four homers in a 16-0 win over Hartford.

UNCHAPPED: Emmanuel Chapman has fulfilled a critically important role on Altoona's pitching staff throughout the season. Since June 19 he's recorded a 2-1 record and a 2.14 ERA (46.1 IP / 11 ER), 45 strikeouts and a .152 BAA in his last 17 appearances (4 starts). In that time he's matched his career-long outing of 4.0 innings four times.

A YOUNG MAN'S ARRIVAL: Infielder Termarr Johnson joined the Curve on Tuesday, August 27 ahead of their series with the Fisher Cats. At 20 years, 2 months and 16 days, <u>Johnson is the third-youngest player to suit up for the Curve</u>, behind Jose Tabata and Andrew McCutchen who were both 19 years old when they debuted for the Curve. At High-A Greensboro this season, Johnson helped the Grasshoppers earn a First Half title and batted .238/.372/.385/.757 with 17 2B, 1 3B, 13 HR, 46 RBI and 20-24 SB, He earned 78 walks in 110 games played. He ranked first in the SAL in walks (78) and runs scored (73), fifth in OBP (.372) and eighth in hits (94). Johnson's first Double-A hit was a two-run homer off New Hampshire's Nick Fraze on Wednesday, August 28.

SIR SAMMY SIANI: Outfielder Sammy Siani has heated up at the plate since July 30 (26 games), he's batting: .304/.396/.435/.831 with 5 2B, 2 3B, 1 HR, 11 RBI, 4-5 SB. Siani had a season-long 11-game on-base streak end on August 25 during which he hit: .297 with a .409 on-base percentage.

ROAD Z: Infielder Tsung-Che Cheng has one of the most dramatic home/road splits of any Eastern League player. In 58 road games, Cheng is batting .249 with a .772 OPS, totaling 10 2B, 10 HR, 29 RBI and 22 BB. In 51 home games, Cheng is batting .175 with a .543 OPS totaling 7 2B, 1 HR, 18 RBI and 32 BB. Overall, Cheng has done a majority of his damage at the plate on the first pitch of his plate appearance where he's batting .362 with a 1.111 OPS in 47 at-bats that he's put the ball in play in an 0-0 count.

Runs Scored ......8th (510) THE CATS THAT FISH: Cesar Martin is back for his fourth season as the Manager for the Fisher Cats. New Hampshire has spent much of the season in the bottom of the standings for the Northeast Division and enter this week with 48 wins, the fewest in the Eastern League and third-fewest by a Double-A club. New Hampshire's roster is a bit light in the prospect department, though former Curve INF Charles McAdoo is currently manning the hot corner for the Fisher Cats. McAdoo was traded to the Jays in exchange for INF/OF Isiah Kiner-Falefa at the trade deadline this season.

THE FIRST MEOWER: Michael Dominguez is back for more on Sunday afternoon. Dominguez tossed four scoreless innings on Tuesday. Dominguez was born in Newport News, VA and was picked by the Jays in the 15h round in 2019 out of Thomas Jefferson High School in Tampa, Florida. Noteable alums from Thomas Jefferson High School include a pair of Hall of Fame players, Tony LaRussa and Fred McGriff and a pair of high quality bug leaguers in Luis Gonzalez and Tino Martinez.
