STARTING NINE- NEWS AND NOTES

- ♦ **Last Time Out:** After being rained out on Tuesday, the Chiefs could not get the offense going in Wednesday's doubleheader, losing 5-1 and 2-0 to Lake County. **R.J. Yeager's** solo homer in the fourth inning of game one was the lone offense for Peoria. For the Chiefs, it marked the first time they lost consecutive contests since late July.
- ♦ **Rolling Along:** Despite a pair of losses Wednesday, Peoria's pitching staff has carried the load in the month of August. Entering play on Thursday, the Chiefs own a 2.29 ERA in August, the second lowest among full-season MiLB clubs. Peoria has posted four shutouts this month. Last week, the Chiefs turned in 25 consecutive scoreless frames against Beloit. Earlier this month, Peoria turned in 30-straight scoreless innings against Quad Cities.
- ♦ **Stuck in Neutral:** Though the Chiefs have racked up the wins in recent weeks, the offense has been stuck in neutral. Since August 1, the Chiefs have scored 52 runs, second fewest in the Midwest League ahead only of this week's opponent Lake County. Additionally, the Chiefs are hitting just .225 over the course of the month.
- ♦ **RISP-y Business:** For the most part, the Chiefs have been quite reliable with runners in scoring position in 2023. As of late, however, the Peoria bats have struggled to deliver the timely hit. Over their last eight games, the Chiefs are 12-for-75 (.160) with RISP. The Chiefs were 0-for-7 in Wednesday's twinbill.
- ♦ **Magic Rajcic:** Like many of his pitching cohorts, **Max Rajcic** has been delaing in recent outings. Rajcic has not allowed a run over his last 14 innings of work, spanning three starts. Rajcic limited Beloit to just two hits in his win on August 10. The Sky Carp did not move a runner past second base.
- ♦ **In a Pinch:** Though he was tagged with a tough luck loss in Wednesday's nightcap, **Edgar Manzo** has been dominant in his two spot starts this season. In his two outings, Manzo has allowed just four hits over 8 2/3 innings. The right-hander has scattered just two unearned runs in the process.
- ♦ **Church of Nathan:** **Nathan Church** continues to pace the Midwest League and all of High-A in hits (116). Church is in some rare air among recent Chiefs. His 116 knocks are the most in a single season since 2019 when former first-round pick Delvin Perez racked up 123 hits for Peoria. If Church continues on his 2023 pace, he'll accumulate the most hits in a single season since Magneuris Sierra's 161 back in 2016.
- ♦ **Welcome to Ohio:** Peoria is wrapping up its 12-game road trip this week by making their first trip to Eastlake, Ohio since 2019. Lake County took two of three from the Chiefs in the last meeting. Current Cardinals infielder Brendan Donovan racked up five hits in the series and headlined the Peoria club.
- ♦ **Cardinals History:** Coach **Christina Whitlock** is blazing a trail in the game of baseball. Whitlock is the first uniformed female coach in the history of the Cardinals organization. Whitlock coached softball for more than two decades and suited up for the U.S. Women's National Team as a player.
