NOTES AND NUGGETS

JAC ATTACK

Sunday night, it was announced that top Royals prospect **Jac Caglianone** was to be promoted from Double-A Northwest Arkansas to Triple-A Omaha ... "Cags" has gone 6-for-21 with 3 homers and 7 RBI over his first 5 Triple-A games.

✦ Caglianone was selected by the Royals with the 6th overall pick in the 2024 MLB Draft, announced as a two-way player, though he has yet to pitch professionally.

✦ Caglianone leads Minor League Baseball with 50 RBI, 3rd with 99 total bases, tied 3rd with 12 home runs and tied 7th in the Minors with 55 hits.

✦ Including Double-A games, Cags enters today's game on a 18-game hitting streak, a stretch where he's batting .333 (25-for-75) with a 1.058 OPS since May 3, tied for the 2nd-longest active streak in the Minors ... he's reached base in his last 25 games, going back April 25, with a .343 average (34-for-99) and 1.031 OPS.

✦ Cags is responsible for 4 of Omaha's 6 hardest-hit balls this season, including the hardest-hit ball of the year by a Chasers hitter, a home run on Wednesday at 113.6MPH ... his average exit velo is 2nd in Omaha's offense, at 93.6MPH.

LET'S RAVE

Outfielder **John Rave** has been a consistent presence at the top of the Storm Chasers lineup all season long, contributing in all facets of the game.

✦ Rave leads the Minors in run scored (46) ... he leads the IL in triples (4), is 2nd in total bases (95), tied 3rd in extra-base hits (21), 4th in steals (17), tied 4th in hits (52) and 6th in slugging percentage (.549) ... he is also 2nd on Omaha in homers (9).

✦ Rave has served as Omaha's leadoff hitter in 42 of 48 games this year ... he's reached base to begin 18 of 42 games (.429 OBP leading off the 1st inning) ... that includes 12 hits (5 singles, 3 doubles, 4 homers), 5 walks and 1 hit-by-pitch ... his 4 leadoff homers this year are the most in the Minor Leagues, while 27 total bases to lead off games ranks 2nd in the Minors.

✦ Thursday, Rave snapped a career-best 16-game hitting streak, the 3rd-longest streak in the IL this year, hitting .406 (26-for-64) with a 1.214 OPS from May 3 to 21 ... he also scored a run in all 16 games of that hitting streak, with 23 runs scored in the stretch, a career-best and new modern Omaha record.

BAM BAM CAM

Shortstop **Cam Devanney** is one of the hottest hitters in baseball right now, with 7 home runs and 22 RBI in his last 13 games both are tied for the most of all hitters in professional baseball since May 10.

✦ Devanney homered in the first 4 games of this week's series vs. Salt Lake ... he now leads the Storm Chasers with 11 homers this year, tied 2nd in the International League, tied 4th at the Triple-A level and tied 6th in the Minors.

✦ Going back to the start of the 2024 season, Devanney has driven in 115 runs for Omaha, tied for the most of any International League player in that span, 4th-most of any Triple-A player and 9th-most among all Minor League players.

✦ Outside of ranking high on the leaderboards in home runs, Devanney's 38 RBI are tied 6th in the Minors, tied 5th in Triple-A and tied 3rd in the league ... he is 2nd in the IL in slugging percentage (.630) and 4th in OPS (1.011).

✦ Devanney's 3 grand slams this year are tied for the most in the Minor Leagues, all coming in the month of May ... he is 4-for-6 when batting with the bases loaded and his 13 total bases and 15 RBI when hitting with the bases loaded both lead the Triple-A level, ranking 2nd and 3rd in the Minors, respectively.

✦ Cam has hits in 24 of his 33 games that he's started this year, with an RBI in 20 of 33 games ... his 8 games with 2+ RBI are the most of any Storm Chasers hitter.

THAT'S WHAT SPEED DO

While the Storm Chasers do not lead the league in stolen bases, Omaha has one of the highest success rates on the basepaths in the Minors.

✦ Omaha has successfully stolen 76 bases this year, and only been caught 10 times ... 76 steals rank 4th both in the International League and among Triple-A teams.

✦ 76-for-86 in steal attempts is a 88.4% success rate, the highest stolen base rate at the Triple-A level and 3rd-best among full-season Minor League teams (1st: New Hampshire Fisher Cats, 94.6%, 35-for-37).

✦ **John Rave** leads the team with 17 steals, ranking 4th in the International League and 5th at the Triple-A level ... **Nick Loftin** is 2nd in Omaha with 12 stolen bases.

U CAN'T TOUCH THIS

The Omaha Storm Chasers pitching staff sits near the top of the International League in strikeouts, with 482 strikeouts this season ... that is 2nd in the league and at the Triple-A level.

✦ Over 417.2 innings, Omaha pitchers are averaging 10.39 K/9, which ranks 3rd both in the International League and at the Triple-A level.

✦ With 482 strikeouts through 48 games, an average of 9.94 strikeouts per game has the staff on pace for 1,496 strikeouts this season ... the franchise record is 1,282 strikeouts by the 2023 Storm Chasers.

Scorigami: A portmanteau of score and origami, a scorigami is a scoring combination that has never happened before in a team, sport or league's history. The term was originated by SB Nation writer Jon Bois for NFL scores.

Above is a matrix of every final score that has happened in a Triple-A Omaha game since 2000. Green squares represent Omaha wins, while red squares represent Omaha losses. The number inside the square refers to the number of times that result has occurred. Empty squares represent a scoring combination or result that has not happened.

Since 2000, there are **58** results in Triple-A Omaha games that have only happened once. **34** of those results (wins or losses) are a true scorigami, a scoring combination that has only happened once. Recent scorigami occurrences are listed to the right, with true scorigamis in bold.
