### GROSHANS HELPS SHRIMP TO WALK-OFF WIN

Jordan Groshans' walk-off single in the ninth inning capped a come-from-behind win for Jacksonville in beating Gwinnett 5-4. The Jumbo Shrimp fell behind quickly, with the Stripers picking up three runs in the first inning. Jacob Amaya nabbed an RBI double in the bottom of the first and Jacksonville tied things up in the third on a two-run bomb from Avisail García. The score remained deadlocked until Luke Williams' RBI single in the seventh. In the bottom of the eighth, a two-out RBI base knock by García knotted the score again. Groshans then won it with a base hit in the ninth inning.

### X MARKS THE SPOT

Xavier Edwards was optioned to Jacksonville on May 30 by Miami, but has been on a tear in his return to Triple-A. In the 40 games he's played since he's been optioned, the Coconut Creek, Fla., native is 62-for-169 at the plate, slashing .367/.411/.467/.878 with six doubles, one triple, three home runs, 25 RBIs and 36 runs scored. This hot streak has pushed Edwards up to second in the International League in batting average (.348) and ninth in OBP (.419). Among the 292 players in the IL this season with at least 100 plate appearances, Edwards ranks second in swinging-strike rate (4.0 percent).

### AUSTIN POWERS

Austin Allen entered play on April 28 just 2-for-his-first-47 (.043) on the season. In the 49 games, since, however, the St. Louis native is 51-for-175 (.291/.371/.663/1.034) at the plate with 12 doubles, one triple, 17 home runs, 48 RBIs and 34 runs scored. After striking out in 25.1 percent of his plate appearances at the Triple-A level last season, Allen is fanning just 20.3 percent of the time in 2023.

### NEED FOR SPEED

Xavier Edwards stole a base successfully on Saturday, pushing his personal streak to 24 attempts in a row without getting caught. The Jumbo Shrimp as a whole have been one of the best teams in baseball in stealing bases; Jacksonville's 84.6 percent stolen base success rate is second in Triple-A and third out of the 120 full season MiLB teams. Only two Jumbo Shrimp have been caught stealing since July 9, with the club swiping 17 bags in that span.

### MAYOR MANGUM

Jake Mangum went hitless in seven of the eight games he played in from May 31-June 8, going just 1-for-24 at the plate. In the 29 games since that point, Mangum is a sizzling 42-for-121, hitting .347/.383/.471/.854 with 10 doubles, one triple, one home run, 12 RBIs and 21 runs scored. The Flowood, Miss., native has picked up 11 multi-hit games in his last 17 games, batting 30-for-81 (.370/.400/.494/.894) with seven doubles, one homer, eight RBIs and 15 runs scored during this stretch. On the season, among the 222 IL players with at least 150 plate appearances, Mangum has the fourth-highest opposite field rate (44.1 percent). His 30.5 percent line drive rate is sixth.

### ODDS & ENDS

Jacksonville looked like world beaters in a six-game series at Charlotte from July 4-9. The Jumbo Shrimp took five out of six games from the Knights - their most wins in a series since 2022 and outscored Charlotte by a whopping 58-28 margin. However, in the other 17 games of the second half of the season, Jacksonville is just 7-10, with all but one of those victories coming by no more than two runs. In those 10 defeats, the Jumbo Shrimp have lost by a combined 50 runs. Thus, while the club was +30 in their run differential in the Queen City, they are at -25 against their other second-half opponents (Durham, Worcester, Nashville & Gwinnett).

### THE PENDULUM SWINGS

Jacksonville started their series at Nashville with strong performances from their bullpen. In the set's first two games, Shrimp relievers surrendered only one run on seven hits in 11.0 innings of work, combining for 12 strikeouts against seven walks. However, things devolved quickly from there; over the next three contests, Jacksonville's relief corps combined to allow 21 runs, all earned, on 24 hits in 17.0 innings with 23 strikeouts against 12 walks. Over the last three games, the bullpen has regained its footing, firing 12.0 innings of four-run ball, ceding seven hits and five walks and picking up 16 strikeouts.

### SHRIMP BITES

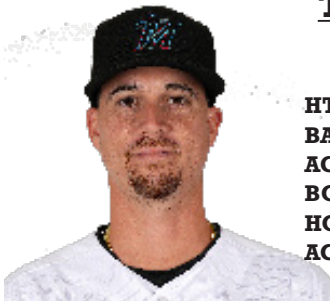
