"FUN IS GOOD" FACTOIDS

LAST TIME OUT: The St. Paul Saints leaned on an 8-run seventh inning and launched three more home runs to sail past the Las Vegas Aviators on Wednesday night. Orlando Arcia got it started by bashing his sixth of the season for a leadoff blast in the second to make it 1-0. Ben Ross cracked his second in Triple-A out, each having come in the last three games for St. Paul, with another leadoff dinger in the third. A's No. 5 prospect Henry Bolte tied the game with a 479 foot bomb, the longest tracked homer in Triple-A this year, for a two-run blast in the third. Mike Paredes was otherwise solid, allowing just the home run damage across 4.0 innings. Aaron Sabato gave the Saints the lead back with a two out, RBI single in the fourth. In the seventh, a homer from Sabato, his fourth in two days in Vegas, started a big inning. Arcia, Hendry Mendez, and Alex Jackson all collected RBI knocks in a five-hit frame. A quartet of Saints relievers tossed 5.0 scoreless frames and retired 18 of the last 19 Las Vegas hitters to close.

SAINTLY SLUGGERS: After belting three more out of the ballpark Wednesday, the Saints now lead all of baseball (both the minors and MLB) with 62 home runs on the season. It's the 3rd-most home runs hit by an International League team 35 gamedays into a season going back to 2005. Over their last four games, the Saints have hit 18 homers and scored 50 runs, both of which lead baseball in that stretch and are the most runs scored and the most longballs hit in any four-game span in the Saints' franchise history. St. Paul have also clubbed 47 round trippers in their last 20 games going back to April 14 vs Lehigh Valley; they are tied with Somerset for the most in baseball in that stretch & it's the most round trippers in any 20-game stretch in franchise history.

DOMO ARIGATO, MR. SABATO: Saints first baseman Aaron Sabato now has four homers in two games in Las Vegas, including the sixth three-homer game in Saints history on Tuesday night. After riding the bench in 10 of the first 14 games of the season for St. Paul, Sabato has started 14 of 20 games since April 14. In that stretch, the former UNC Tarheel is 16-for-45 (.356) with all six of his homers and is producing a 1.309 OPS that ranks third among all Triple-A hitters with at least 30 PA in that run.

ARCIA, WE SEE YA: Saints infielder Orlando Arcia has hit safely in ten straight, the longest hitting streak for a St. Paul batter so far this year. The 31-year-old veteran is 17-for-43 (.395) with three homers & six extra-base hits during the run.

BARREL ME, BLAZER: On Tuesday night, the Saints lineup matched a season-high with seven "barrels," the optimal combination of exit velocity and launch angle. Any batted ball that exceeds 99 mph of exit velocity between a launch angle of 25-31 degrees qualifies, with each mph of velocity added increasing the range another 3 degrees (i.e. 100 mph between 24-33, 101 between 23-35, etc). The hard-hitting St. Paul lineup lead Triple-A in the metric as a team, and have produced more barrels than 23 MLB clubs.

BACK, BACK, GONE: Between Orlando Arcia, Kaelen Culpepper, Kyler Fedko, Alex Jackson, Emmanuel Rodriguez, Aaron Sabato, and Gabby Gonzalez, the Saints lead Triple-A with seven hitters that have slugged at least five home runs (Louisville have 6 & Charlotte & El Paso have 5 apiece entering Thursday). The Saints are currently on pace to set a new team franchise record in home runs in a season and surpass 2023's total of 206. All seven hitters that have clubbed at least five homers are currently on pace to break the Saints' single-season home run record, accomplished by Carson McCusker with 22 clouts last season.

LEADING OFF WITH A BANG: After adding three more inning-opening blasts to their ledger on Wednesday, the Saints now lead all of baseball in home runs to lead off an inning (see below). Kaelen Culpepper (4), Orlando Arcia (3) Alex Jackson (2), Emmanuel Rodriguez (2), and Aaron Sabato (2) have all touched off for at least two home runs to lead off an inning each this year, with Culpepper twice leading off with home runs to start the day offensively for St. Paul. Culpepper is one of 13 hitters in MiLB with multiple "leadoff homers" (HR in 1st inning by a leadoff man); nobody in the minors or MLB has more than two.

TWINS OF TOMORROW: The Saints opened the year with nine of the Twins' Top-30 ranked prospects, marking the most players listed on MLB's Minnesota Top-30 list to open a campaign in the Saints' history as a Triple-A franchise. Between Walker Jenkins, Kaelen Culpepper, Emmanuel Rodriguez, & Connor Prielipp, they touted four prospects on either the MLB.com or Baseball America Top-100 list to open the year, surpassing last year's three. Gabriel Gonzalez (7/10), Andrew Morris (13/13), Marco Raya (18/21), and John Klein (20/23) all opened the year in St. Paul, along with LHP Kendry Rojas (10/8) on the injured list. RHP Ryan Gallagher (19/22), OF Hendry Mendez (12/14), and RHP C.J. Culpepper (22/-) have all since joined the Saints mid-season.

CAREER NOTES

- Enters his first season as Twins farmhand...originally a 30th-round pick by the Angels in 2019...was released in May 2020 and signed with Toronto over a year later...spent the last 5 years in Jays system
- Has produced a sub-3.00 ERA in three straight seasons & owns a 2.66 ERA from 2023-25, which ranks 7th in MiLB among pitchers with at least 200 IP

2025

- Named the Warren Spahn Award Winner as the Triple-A Buffalo Most Valuable Pitcher for second year in-a-row
- Spent the entire season with Triple-A Buffalo, going 6-2, 2.57 ERA (24 ER, 84.0 IP) with 72 strikeouts (20 K%) and 36 walks (10 BB%) in 40 app. (5 GS)
- Ranked 7th in the International League in ERA (min. 50 IP)...threw a scoreless outing in 20-of-40 appearances, mostly in relief
- Of his 40 appearances, five were starts...one of which came vs the Saints on May 9 at CHS Field (3.1 IP, 1 Run, 5 hits, 1 BB, 3 SO, 1 HRA, season-high 64 pitches)

2024

- Was named the Warren Spahn Award winner as the Buffalo Bison's Most Valuable Pitcher...led all Bison arms in ERA (min 30 IP)...went 4-0 with a 2.97 ERA (26 ER, 78.2 IP) while ranking top-5 on the staff in wins & strikeouts (72)

LAST APPEARANCE: Started on Sunday in series finale vs Iowa and fired 3.0 scoreless innings...faced the minimum through the first two innings before a leadoff single in the third (erased a two-out walk with pickoff in the first, 1-2-3 second inning)...struck out the final three hitters he faced after allowing his first base hit...threw 13 four-seamers (31%), 12 sweepers (29%), 10 changeups (24%), and 7 sinkers (17%)...generated six swings-and-misses, led by three on the changeup...

TROY PERCIVAL, YOU'RE MY HERO: A Southern California native, Bash's family were Angels season ticket-holders while Bash was growing up. He attended Game 7 of the 2002 World Series, where the Angels beat the Giants for the Commissioner's Trophy. Bash would go on to eventually be drafted by the Angels in the 30th round of the 2019 Draft. He would spend just one year with the Halos organization before being released in May of 2020, signing with the Missoula Paddleheads in Indy Ball for the start of 2021, and eventually latching on with the Blue Jays.

IT AIN'T MUCH, BUT IT'S HONEST WORK: Following the cancellation of the 2020 minor league season, Bash was working as a groundskeeper at his old college, California Baptist. In 2021, he got the call from the Missoula Paddleheads (Independent, Pioneer League) in 2021 and signed with them.

THE INVINCIBLE ONE: Spending most of the last two seasons with Triple-A Buffalo in the Toronto system, Andrew Bash is the back-to-back Warren Spahn Award winner, granted to the Bisons' Most Valuable Pitcher each season. Bash ranked 7th in the International League in ERA last season (min 50 IP) with a 2.57 mark, his second straight year throwing up a sub-3.00 ERA. The award is of course named for the Hall-of-Famer, who although he didn't ever play for the Bisons, is a South Buffalo native. Nicknamed "the Invincible One," Spahn won 363 games and threw 382 complete games in his illustrious 21-year career.

Cracked 2 HR on 5/3 vIOW, his 6th career multi-HR game as a pro...collected a hit in five consecutive AB's from May 2-3 vIOW (HR'd in final 2 AB of 5/2, hits in first 3 5/3)... Hit safely in nine straight games from April 24-May 5 (15-38, .395, 2 HR, 4 XBH, 4 RBI), the longest for a Saints hitter on the season at the time...

 >Returned to action on May 6 with Atlanta but appeared in just four games and only received 1 AB before being released on May 25
 Signed as a free agent with Colorado on May 28 and closed the year hitting .203, 3 HR 12 RBI and a .544 OPS in 62 games with the Rox
 >Was mired in a 1-for-29 (.034) slide from July 5-July 26
 Graded as an above average defender at shortstop in the big leagues, posting a +2 Outs Above Average, in the 78th percentile of big leaguers at the position
