COLUMBUS, OHIO – The Omaha Storm Chasers came up short in Game 1 of a doubleheader against the Columbus Clippers, losing 3-0 before bouncing back in Game 2 with a 5-4 win for a split on the day.

- ⚡ A 2.5 hour delay pushed back the start of Game 1 and Omaha was unable to mound any offense against Columbus, falling in a 3-0 contest, the team's third straight shutout loss ... the loss extended the Chasers' streak of 25.0 consecutive innings without scoring, the longest such stream for Omaha since at least 2005.
- ⚡ **Nate Eaton** had 2 of Omaha's 3 hits in the first game, while reliever **Sam Long** pitched 1.2 scoreless innings ... the two runs starter **Anthony Veneziano** allowed came on sacrifice flies in the 3rd inning.
- ⚡ In Game 2, the Chasers immediately bounced back to get on the board with just one out in the top of the 1st inning, as a **Tyler Tolbert** walk, **Tyler Gentry** single and **CJ Alexander** RBI single put Omaha up 1-0 early.
- ⚡ **Devin Mann** hit a solo homer in the 2nd inning of Game 2 for a 2-0 lead, then Nick Pratto added an RBI single in the 4th inning, at the time a 3-1 lead.
- ⚡ **Walter Pennington** fired 3.0 hitless and scoreless innings of relief in Game 2, retiring 9 of 10 batters faced, including 7 of his last 8, with 3 strikeouts.
- ⚡ Columbus struck Omaha reliever **Jonah Dipoto** for 3 runs in the bottom of the 6th inning in the back half of the twin-bill ... **Logan Porter** connected on a two-run homer with two outs in the 7th to put Omaha ahead ... **Will Klein** finished things off and pitched a scoreless bottom of the 7th to shut the door and earn a save.

NOTES AND NUGGETS

ALL QUIET ON THE OMAHA FRONT

A run in the top of the first inning in the second game of yesterday's doubleheader snapped a streak of 25.0 innings without scoring a run, the longest scoreless streak in modern Omaha franchise history (since 2005).

- ⚡ This marked the first time since 2005 that the club failed to score over three consecutive games ... in this stretch, the Chasers hit just .142 (12-for-84) with 4 doubles, 8 walks and 36 strikeouts (38.7% strikeout rate).
- ⚡ Prior to this stretch, Omaha only had six occasions since 2005 of losing back-to-back games in shutout fashion ... last year, no Triple-A team lost three straight games in a shutout, only the Jersey Shore Blue Claw (Phillies A+) had a stretch of 3 straight shutout losses, between June 10 and 13.

LATE BLOOMERS

Omaha's runs in the first and second innings in Game 2 yesterday were the team's first runs of support for a starting pitcher all season, in what was the sixth game of the year.

- ⚡ Over the first five games of the 2024 season, Omaha's starting pitchers combined for 20.0 innings of work ... however, in that time, the offense did not score a single run while the starters were in the game.
- ⚡ The three runs Omaha scored between the first and fourth innings in Game 2 last night were the first runs the team scored all year in the first half of the game (prior to the bottom of the fifth inning).
- ⚡ In the first through fourth innings so far, Omaha hits .174 as a team (15-for-86), with a 50-point jump to a .223 average (23-for-103) in the fifth inning or later.

COMEBACK KINGS

All three of Omaha's wins this season have been nail-biters, all are one-run wins and all have been comeback victories as well.

- ⚡ Both walk-off wins Omaha had last weekend were dramatic games where they trailed for the first half of the game ... on Opening Day, Iowa led 1-0, then 4-0 and Omaha did not take a lead until walking off in the 11th ... on March 30, Iowa led 2-0 in the middle of the 5th, but the Chasers scored 3 in the bottom half to take a lead.
- ⚡ Last night, Omaha led for much of the game, but Iowa scored 3 runs in the bottom of the 6th, so the Chasers entered the top of the 7th down by one run and did not jump back ahead until they were down to the last out of the game.

RELIEF AID

The Storm Chasers bullpen is still of the best in the International League as Omaha's relievers have combined for a 3.41 ERA through the team's first six games.

- ⚡ A 3.41 ERA (11 ER in 29.0 IP) ranks 5th out of the 20-team International League and 6th among the 30 Triple-A teams.
- ⚡ The Storm Chasers bullpen has combined to hold opposing hitters to a .156 average (15-for-96), which is the second-best mark among Triple-A teams.
- ⚡ Of the 25 individual appearances by Omaha relief pitchers, 20 have been scoreless ... of the five outings where Chasers relievers allowed a run, three were multi-run outings, including 2 of less than an inning.
