Today's Game: The Nashville Sounds and Memphis Redbirds play the final game of the 2022 regular season this afternoon at First Horizon Park. Nashville leads the season series, 12-8, after last night's win. Left-hander Robert Gasser starts for the Sounds against right-hander Thomas Parsons for the Redbirds.

Robert Gasser: 23-year-old Robert Gasser gets the ball for the Sounds in the regular season finale. The left-hander is 2-1 with a 3.38 ERA (21.1 IP/8 ER) in four starts for Nashville since joining the team on August 30. He's 7-11 with a 3.75 ERA (132.0 IP/55 ER) in 26 starts between High-A Fort Wayne (18), Double-A Biloxi (4) and Nashville in 2022. Gasser last pitched on September 22 in a start at Louisville and delivered his eighth quality start of the season (W, 6.0 IP, 3 H, 1 R, 1 ER, 5 BB, 8 K). He is tabbed as the No. 11 Brewers prospect, according to MLB Pipeline. Gasser joined the Brewers system after being acquired by Milwaukee (along with Taylor Rogers, Dinelson Lamet and Esteury Ruiz) in exchange for closer Josh Hader on August 1. He was originally drafted by the Padres in Competitive Balance Round B of the 2021 draft out of the University of Houston.

Thomas Parsons: 27-year-old Thomas Parsons starts for Memphis in their final game of the year. The right-hander is 11-4 with a 4.27 ERA (130.2 IP/62 ER) in 37 games (16 starts) with Memphis this year. Parsons last worked on September 23 and was tagged with a loss against Gwinnett (6.0 IP, 5 H, 4 R, 4 ER, 3 BB, 7 K). He has pitched against Nashville four times (three starts) in 2022 and is 1-1 with a 3.71 ERA (17.0 IP/7 ER). He has allowed 9 hits and 10 walks to go along with 13 strikeouts. In 2021, he went 2-6 with a 5.86 ERA in 24 games (9 starts) with Memphis. Parsons was signed as an undrafted free agent by the Cardinals in 2018 after attending Adrian College in Michigan.

Superlatives: Last night's win improved Nashville to 48-26 at First Horizon Park...79-2 when leading after 8 innings...18-5-3 in series play...65-16 when scoring first...80-22 when scoring 4+...60-27 when not committing any errors.

Viva Las Vegas: The Nashville Sounds will play the Durham Bulls on Saturday, October 1 at 8:05 p.m. (CDT) for the International League Championship in Las Vegas. The winner of the IL Championship will then meet the winner of the Pacific Coast League Championship on Sunday, October 2 at 6:05 p.m. (CDT) for the Triple-A National Championship.

Division Champs Again: Nashville won the International League West Division Championship on Friday in Louisville. The last time the Sounds won a division title prior to this year was in 2016 as an affiliate of the Oakland Athletics. The Sounds have been division champs as the Triple-A affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers four times: 2005, 2006, 2007 and 2022.

Another Record in Reach: Nashville has scored 805 runs this year, just one run shy of the franchise record 806 set in 1999.

Bust out the Brooms: Winners of the first two games in the series, the Sounds are looking for the team's first three-game series sweep since August of 2019. From August 7-9, the Sounds went to Fresno and outscored the Grizzlies 25-10 in a three-game sweep. Later that month the team swept Oklahoma City in a three-game series from August 19-21 at Chickasaw Bricktown Ballpark.

Home is Where the Heart Is: With a 48-26 record at First Horizon Park this year, the Sounds own the best home record in Triple-A Baseball. The El Paso Chihuahuas, winners of the Pacific Coast League East Division, went 47-28 at home this year, but close their regular season on the road in Albuquerque tonight.

Just Win, Baby: The Nashville Sounds are the only team in Minor League Baseball to surpass the 90-win threshold in 2022. The team owns a .615 winning percentage, good for fourth-best among all full-season MiLB teams, behind Single-A Charleston (.684), Single-A Fresno (.629) and Advanced-A Eugene (.628).

Frelick On-Base: Outfielder Sal Frelick extended his on-base streak to 40 games last night, the longest active streak in the International League and the longest by a Sound this season. During the streak, Frelick is hitting .358 (58-for-162) with 36 runs, 8 doubles, 2 triples, 4 home runs, 22 RBI, 17 walks and 8 stolen bases. Since joining Nashville on August 2, Frelick is among International League leaders in hits (1st, 67), batting average (1st, .360), on-base percentage (3rd, .431), runs (3rd, 38) and total bases (7th, 93). Frelick's 40-game streak is the second-longest in the IL this year.

Among League Leaders: Shortstop Brice Turang continues to pace among the best hitters in the International League. Amongst all IL hitters, Turang is 2nd in runs (88), 3rd in hits (151), 6th in stolen bases (34), 8th in walks (65), 8th in total bases (215) and 10th in batting average (.286). Jon Singleton is 1st in walks (116), T-5th in runs (84), 5th in on-base percentage (.376), T-5th in RBI (87), T-7th in home runs (24) and 10th in extra-base hits (48).

LAST OUTING: Gasser last pitched on September 22 in a start at Louisville and delivered another quality start (W, 6.0 IP, 3 H, 1 R, 1 ER, 5 BB, 8 K). It was his eighth quality start of the season and second with Nashville. Gasser threw 56 of his 96 pitches for strikes.

AGAINST OPPONENT: Gasser is facing Memphis for the second time. His Nashville debut was against the Redbirds on 9/2 and allowed five runs on five hits in 3.2 innings.
