LAST TIME OUT: The New Hampshire Fisher Cats had their four-game win streak snapped by the Reading Fightin' Phils, falling 6-1 on Friday night. Blue Jays No. 1 prospect Ricky Tiedemann made his return from the injured list but could not get out of the first inning in his first Double-A start since May 4. Tiedemann recorded only two outs and allowed three runs, four hits, one walk and struck out one on 31 pitches receiving the loss. The Fightin' Phils scored three runs in the first inning off Tiedemann and two more in the second on a two-run home run by Carlos De La Cruz. Reading starting left-hander David Parkinson threw six scoreless innings with seven strikeouts, quieting New Hampshire's bats and picking up the win. Alan Roden broke the shutout bid in the ninth with a solo home run, his first at the Double-A level

BULLPEN CAN SHOVE: New Hampshire relievers last night struck out 14 batters, the most in a single game this season by the bullpen. Gabriel Ponce struck out a season-high six in three innings of relief, Fitz Stadler struck out a pair in 1.1 scoreless innings, Trevor Clifton struck out one in his home debut, Joe Jones struck out three in two scoreless innings in his home debut, and T.J. Brock struck out a pair in a scoreless ninth.

DANGEROUS DAMIANO: IF Damiano Palmegiani continues to lead the active roster in home runs (14), RBIs (58) and multi-hit games (24). The Blue Jays No. 19 prospect is tied for the fifth in the league in RBIs and tied for sixth in doubles (22).

STEWARD THE SWIPER: OF Steward Berroa is second in the Eastern League in stolen bases after stealing his $40^{\text {th }}$ on the season Wednesday, one shy of Portland's Corey Rosier for the league lead. The last Fisher Cat to lead the league in stolen bags was former Fisher Cat Anthony Gose, who stole a team-record 70 bases in 2011.

NEW TOP 30 RANKINGS: MLB.com re-ranked the top 30 prospects lists for every team in baseball since the MLB Draft and the trade deadline. Six current Fisher Cats are in the Blue Jays top 30 prospects. LHP Ricky Tiedemann remains as the top Blue Jays prospect and OF Alan Roden remains at No. 7. IF Leo Jimenez has climbed from No. 19 to No. 6. RHP Chad Dallas reenters the top 30 and slots in at No. 14. IF Damiano Palmegiani jumps up ten spots to No. 19. LHP Mason Fluharty debuts at No. 28.

MENDOZA ON THE MOUND: RHP Abdiel Mendoza makes his third Double-A start and his first at Delta Dental Stadium. The 24-year-old Panamanian is coming off two starts in Binghamton where he pitched 9.2 innings and struck out nine over just two walks allowed. In his last start on Sunday, he struck out five in five innings pitched against the Rumble Ponies. Mendoza is from Chitre, Panama, the same birthplace as Leo Jimenez.

RAKING VS READING: C Phil Clarke is hitting . 333 with a homer and four RBIs in 10 games played. IF Damiano Palmegiani is hitting .333 with four home runs and 15 RBIs in 14 games while IF Riley Tirotta is hitting .304 in eight games vs Reading.

THIS DAY IN FISHER CATS HISTORY (August 12, 2016) - Connor Greene worked six innings without allowing a hit, and the Fisher Cats opened a series in Trenton with a 5-4 win. Greene walked two and struck out six, leaving with the Fisher Cats up 50 . The Thunder rallied with four in the bottom of the ninth on a grand slam by Billy McKinney. Chris Smith came of the bullpen to get the final two outs to preserve the win.

MANCHESTER-BOSTON REGIONAL AIRPORT FLIGHT TO THE MAJORS: Toronto (65-53) and the Chicago Cubs played game two of the series at Rogers Centre earlier today. The Cubs took the opener 6-2, getting to Jose Berrios early in the game. Brandon Belt homered and Alejandro Kirk had an RBI single for the Jays...Buffalo (54-57) and Worcester split a doubleheader with the Bisons taking the opener 7-1 and the Woo Sox winning 5-0 in the nightcap. Orelvis Martinez hit a three-run homer in the opener for Buffalo. The teams had a 4:05 game scheduled today at Polar Park...Four Vancouver (66-39) pitchers combined on a four-hit shutout in a game the Canadians won 1-0 Friday afternoon at the Nat. Cade Doughty knocked in the run with a single in the first inning. Anders Tolhurst, the second pitcher for Vancouver, earned the win...Dunedin (49-57) fell 11-9 at Lakeland last night. Manuel Beltre and Jace Bohrofen each hit three-run homers for the Jays. C J Van Eyk (van ike) worked the first 2.1 innings in his fourth start for the Jays, allowing one run and one hit. Toronto's second-round draft pick in 2020 (Florida State) is on Vancouver's roster, working on a rehab assignment.
