## History vs. South Bend

The Lugnuts are 203-182 all-time vs. South Bend, 96-85 in Lansing and 107-97 in The Bend. Last year, the Lugnuts went 2-4 at Four Winds Field... but in the series finale, the Nuts' last road game of the year, September 4, Jorge Juan, Jack Owen, Shohei Tomioka and Osvaldo Berrios combined on a 2-1 no-hit win, the third no-hitter in franchise history.

Today: The Lugnuts open a six-game series with the Cubs, the only meetings of the year for Lansing with the defending Midwest League champions. The Nuts are coming off dropping four of six games at home to the current West Division leaders, the Cedar Rapids Kernels, though they did close the series with a victory on Sunday afternoon.

Starting Matchup: Lugnuts right-hander Christian Fernandez, coming over in the Christian Bethancourt trade last year from Tampa Bay, makes his eighth start with the Nuts this year, he won both his starts last week at Fort Wayne, Lansing's lone wins in the series. On the other side, right-hander Zebby Matthews, drafted by Minnesota in the 8th round in 2022, out of Western Carolina, is expected to make his debut at High-A. Through seven starts and $382 / 3 \mathrm{IP}$ with Single-A Fort Myers, he holds a 2.56 ERA, with 53 K and 5 BB.

Last Game: Lugnuts 3, Kernels 2. Euribiel Ángeles homered leading off the bottom of the first inning and delivered a tie-breaking sacrifice fly in the bottom of the eighth, lifting the Nuts to victory in the Sunday finale over Cedar Rapids. Both Lansing victories in the series came by an identical 3-2 score.

On the Air: Today's game is available on Bally Live and MiLB TV with Brendan King and Max Thoma, and via StreamGuys with Jesse Goldberg-Strassler on the call.
On Deck: The Lugnuts and Cubs play through Sunday, and then the Nuts return to Lansing to welcome in the Peoria Chiefs for a six-game homestand running from June 13-18.

## Lug•Notes

Power Show: In the six-game series against Cedar Rapids, the Lugnuts crushed nine home runs (three by Jonny Butler and three by Euribiel Ángeles) while the Kernels walloped 11 of their own home runs. Of all of those roundtrippers, 12 were solo shots - seven for Lansing, five for Cedar Rapids (which also hit two grand slams and a three-run blast).

Brisk Baseball: 14 of the last 18 Lugs games have been completed in 150 minutes or less, including 11 games completed under two hours and 20 minutes. Sunday's series finale took just 2:05 to finish.

Slim Finishes: Four of the six games of the Lansing/Cedar Rapids series were decided by one run, with each team prevailing twice by the slenderest of margins. The Lugnuts are 11-6 in one-run games this season.

Among the MWL Leaders: Outfielder Jonny Butler is second in the Midwest League with five triples and tied for eighth with 12 stolen bases. Starting pitcher Jack Perkins is third in the league with a .188 batting average allowed, fifth with a 2.89 ERA, fourth with a 1.03 WHIP and sixth with $462 / 3$ innings pitched. Relief pitcher Tyler Baum is tied for eighth with five saves. Catcher Daniel Susac is sixth with 50 base hits, fifth with a 294 batting average, ninth with 76 total bases, ninth with an .805 OPS and tenth with a .447 slugging percentage.

Congratulations! On Sunday, Stockton starting pitcher Wander Guante fired seven shutout innings, striking out five and allowing only one hit and two walks, in an 8-3 Ports victory over the Modesto Nuts. Yesterday, the California League rewarded him with its Pitcher of the Week Award.

Meanwhile, in Arizona: The Arizona Complex League started up its season yesterday, and two Lugnuts infielders currently on the Injured List third baseman Joshwan Wright (0-3) and shortstop Drew Swift ( $0-2$, RBI, 2 BB) - batted in the top two spots in the AzCL Athletics starting lineup, rehabbing their way back to Lansing.

First-Round Pedigrees: The Lugnuts' roster boasts the A's last two first-round selections. 20-year-old Max Muncy was the 25th overall selection in the 2021 draft and enters the season ranked the A's No. 1 shortstop prospect by MLB Pipeline. 22-year-old Daniel Susac was taken 19th overall in 2022 and is the A's No. 2 catching prospect behind 1B/C Tyler Soderstrom.

In a Nutshell: Making ninth appearance, eighth start, tonight for Lansing... before Myers, the last Pitt Panther to start a game for the Nuts was also the only other Panther to play for the Nuts: T.J. Zeuch (pronounced "Zoyk"), the 21st overall pick in 2016, who made two starts in the Midwest League for Lansing in 2016, spent last season with the Cincinnati Reds, and is currently in Lehigh Valley (Triple-A - Philadelphia)... @mitch_myers9 on social media.

Hometown Hero: Hometown of Lanett's motto is "The Gateway to Alabama," since it sits directly on the Eastern border to Georgia, directly bordering West Point, Georgia... pitched for Valley High School as a freshman and sophomore and Opelika High School as a junior and senior, posting a career 1.22 ERA with a fastball/curveball mix, playing third base, and batting third... father Barry starred in baseball at Jacksonville State.

The Buc Starts Here: Initially committed to University of Alabama, joining juco Florida Southwestern State instead, making 15 appearances, 14 starts, in both 2017-18 and 2018-19... as a freshman: 5-6, 4.28, 2 CG, 73 2/3, $35 \mathrm{BB}, 62 \mathrm{~K}, 1$ HR... as a sophomore: $7-2,3.29,3 \mathrm{CG}, 79$ $1 / 3,23 \mathrm{BB}, 88 \mathrm{~K}, 3 \mathrm{HR} . .$. became one of 10 Bucs to sign on with a D-I program (not including Ryan Gusto, who was drafted in the 11th round by the Astros).

Onward to Pitt: Upon transferring to Pittsburgh, made four starts in 2020 (2-2, 3.52, 23 IP, 4 $\mathrm{BB}, 30 \mathrm{~K}, 0 \mathrm{HR}$ ) before the season was shut down, with 10 strikeouts in six shutout innings vs. Lehigh... followed in 2021 as Pitt's Friday starter: 13 GS, 5-5, 3.21, 1 CG, 81 1/3, 23 BB, team-leading 83 K, 6 HR... tossed $9-I P$ CG at Virginia, 3/20/21, allowing three hits, one run, and whiffing five.

2022 Professional Debut: After signing for $\$ 125,000$ as the Athletics' 12 th-round selection in 2021, did not appear in a Minor League game until 2022, spent entirely with Stockton... led Ports in starts (22, six more than the closest teammate), innings (124 1/3, $281 / 3$ more innings than the closest teammate), and double plays (10)... worked seven innings five times, $62 / 3$ innings once, $61 / 3$ innings twice, and six innings four times: 12 starts of 22 starts lasting at least six innings... struggled in 12 games, 11 starts, at home ( 7.11 ERA, .304 avg, 16 HR , in 57 innings) compared to 11 starts on the road ( 4.14 ERA, 269,10 HR in $671 / 3$ innings)... lefties and righties hit nearly identically: . 286/.355/.536 for lefties, $.285 / .339 / .525$ for righties, though righties hit 17 of the 26 home runs allowed... struggled mightily in first innings, allowing .353/.402/.627 slash line and six home runs... opposing base stealers swiped 10 bases in 16 attempts.

2023 with the Lugnuts: Opened season as the Nuts' Wednesday starter... tossed first quality start of the year on April 27, allowing two runs (both in the 5th) in six innings vs. Quad Cities April 27... followed up with a second quality start on May 4 vs. Dayton, though he once again received a no-decision... has a 4.50 ERA in five home starts ( 26 IP) compared to a 2.13 ERA in three road appearances (12 $2 / 3$ IP) ... struggling with leadoff hitters in innings: . $447 / .488 / .553$ with 17 hits, three walks.
