### HARRIS HOMERS, RIDERS FALL TO NATURALS ON FRIDAY:

The Frisco RoughRiders were downed by the Northwest Arkansas Naturals 5-2 on Friday night from Arvest Ballpark. The Naturals (23-38) took an early lead thanks to a Jorge Bonifacio sacrifice fly in the first and a solo home run from Dillan Schrum off of Frisco (27-33) starter **Ryan Garcia** (2-5). The RoughRiders (27-33) struck back in the fourth when **Thomas Saggese** ripped an RBI single up the middle. Saggese finished with two hits on the night, extending his hitting streak to six games. **Luisangel Acuña** also collected two hits to give him four-straight multi-hit games and a 10-game hitting streak. After Bonifacio hit a bases-clearing double in the fifth, **Dustin Harris** clobbered his fifth home run of the season, a solo shot, to make it 5-2. **Aidan Anderson** threw two scoreless innings out of the Riders' bullpen. T.J. Sikkema (2-3) earned the win with 3.1 innings in relief for Northwest Arkansas.

### IT'S ABOUT STRAHM TIME:

Outfielder **Kellen Strahm** has been hot lately, hitting safely in seven-straight games while batting .414 (12-for-29)/.469/.552/1.021 with one double, one home run, four RBIs, five runs, three walks and a steal. Over the last seven games, he has raised his average from .200 to .232 and his OPS from .612 to .671.

### OWEN THEM NOTHING, GIVING THEM EVERYTHING:

Pitcher **Owen White** was named Texas League Pitcher of the Week for the week of June 5-11. White took the hill for the RoughRiders on June 7 in Corpus Christi and tossed seven shutout innings to earn the win. White gave up just one hit to the 23 batters he faced, walking two and striking out six. Frisco won the game, 9-0. White now has three starts in which he has not allowed a run, earned or unearned. In seven of his 11 starts, he has allowed two runs or fewer. His ERA this season is 3.54 over 53.1 innings. Last year, White won the award in just his second start at the Double-A level. The former second-round selection in 2018 has a 3.24 ERA over 75 innings in Double-A. White made his MLB debut on Tuesday, allowing three runs over two innings with two strikeouts.

### THOMAS IS BACK IN NWA:

**Thomas Saggese** returns to Northwest Arkansas for the first time since his first week in Double-A in 2022, in which he won Texas League Player of the Week by batting .381 (8-for-21)/.409/.857/1.266 with three doubles, two triples, a home run, nine RBIs, five runs scored with a steal and a walk. In the first four games of the series this year, he is hitting .444 (8-for-18)/.476/.667/1.143 with a double, a home run, two runs, four RBIs, two walks.

### THE SPEAS THAT PLEASES:

Reliever **Alex Speas** now has an ERA under 1.00 at 0.79 over 20 appearances. In 23.2 innings, he has struck out 39 to 11 walks. Opponents are hitting just .134 against him and he has not allowed an earned run over his last 11 outings. During that span, he has struck out 24 to four walks over 13.1 innings. On the season, righties are just hitting .117 (7-for-60) against him on the season with a .377 OPS.

### POWER SURGE:

After only hitting two home runs over a two-week span, the RoughRiders have hit 11 long balls over their last nine games. In the nine games, Frisco is hitting .264/.364/.441/.805 with 21 doubles, 11 home runs and averaging 6.7 runs per game. **Luisangel Acuña** has led the way, hitting .344 (13-for-38)/.390/.579/.969 in the span while **Thomas Saggese** hit four home runs.

### AMBUSH EARLY AND OFTEN:

**Thomas Saggese** has been fantastic on first pitches this season, tied for first in the Texas League with a .600 average (12-for-20) when he puts the first pitch of an at-bat in play. He has a 1.619 OPS on the first pitch after homering on the first pitch on Saturday, which is second in the league. **Luisangel Acuña** has also been great, hitting .463 (19-for-41) on the initial offering while his 19 hits on the first pitch lead the league.

### DUSTIN' THEM AND LEAVING THEM BEHIND:

**Dustin Harris** has been running wild for the RoughRiders this season. After stealing 19 bases in 85 games in 2022, Harris has already swiped 24 bags in 58 games this season. Harris is on pace for 55 steals, which would by far be a career high. **Luisangel Acuña** leads the league in steals with 28 and is on pace for a career-best 63 swipes. The RoughRiders are second in Texas League steals with 92 bases in 107 attempts (86 percent).

### ONE HOME RUN, PLEASE. AND MAKE IT GRAND:

The RoughRiders have had a knack for grand slams this year with **Thomas Saggese** hitting Frisco's seventh grand slam of the season on last Friday. They are one of two teams with seven grand slams in all of Minor League Baseball. Six different players have accounted for the grand slams (Hicks, **Luisangel Acuña**, **Jax Biggers**, **Dustin Harris**, **Trevor Hauver**, **Thomas Saggese** (2)). Frisco also has a 1.101 OPS with the bags full, which is fourth in the minors (Low-A Myrtle Beach, 1.321 and Triple-A Saint Paul, 1.181, Double-A Somerset, 1.118).

### ACUÑA MATATA:

RoughRiders infielder **Luisangel Acuña** has been on fire to start his 2023 season. The Rangers No. 3 prospect is hitting .307 (69-for-225)/.372/.444/.816 through the first 52 games. Over his last 48 games, he is batting .319/.388/.469/.858. Acuña is riding a 10-game hitting streak, batting .362 (17-for-47). When the 21-year-old arrived in Frisco in 2022, he had a wRC+ of 68 while it has nearly doubled this season (118).

### WALK THIS WAY:

On the season, Frisco's 298 walks are tied for first among Texas League teams while their .353 team OBP is third in the Texas League. **Dustin Harris** is first in the league with 42 walks.

### ABOUT JACK

-Leiter was drafted in the first round (No. 2 overall) in 2021 by the Rangers out of Vanderbilt University. With the Commodores, Leiter was a unanimous First Team All-American and a finalist for both the Golden Spikes Award and the Dick Howser Trophy.

-Threw first regular-season, complete-game no-hitter to start SEC play since 1971 against No.16 South Carolina on March 20th, 2021. He walked the first batter of the game before retiring the last 27 he saw with 16 strikeouts on 124 pitches. Followed up that no-hitter with 7.0 no-hit innings in his next start (20.2 consecutive no-hit innings over three starts from March 20th - April 2nd).

-Drafted in 20th round in 2019 by NYY out of Delbarton School (NJ). Named 2019 New Jersey Gatorade POY, striking out 95 in 57 innings as a senior.

-The family lineage is strong with Jack. His father, Al, pitched in 19 MLB seasons (1987-2005), making two All-Star teams and winning both the 1993 and 1997 World Series. His uncle, Mark, played 11 seasons in the majors (1990-99; 2001) and his cousin, Mark Jr., pitched two seasons (2017-2018) with Philadelphia and Toronto. Al now works as an analyst for MLB Network.

### 2023 SEASON

-Leiter entered the 2023 season as the No. 78 prospect in baseball according to MLB.com and the No. 5 prospect in the Rangers system.

-Over three starts on May 5th, May 11th and May 17th, Leiter allowed just three earned runs over 17.0 IP (1.59 ERA) while striking out 25 and walking five.

### 2022 SEASON

-Leiter entered the 2022 season as the No. 17 prospect in baseball according to MLB.com and the No.1 prospect in the Rangers system.

-Leiter dazzled in his professional debut, striking out seven over his three innings against the Arkansas Travelers on April 9th. The righty helped draw the largest crowd since 2019 at Riders Field for the debut (9,322).

-Threw the Riders first quality start of the season on May 7th against Arkansas. Leiter retired the last 15 batters he saw, allowing just two hits (one in the first and one in the second inning).

-Leiter came out of the bullpen as a "start" to finish a suspended game on May 31st (game was finished on June 1st) and recorded a career-best eight strikeouts against Wichita over 5.2 innings. The game resulted in a 3-0 win for Frisco, the Riders second shutout win of the season to that point.

-The righty allowed just one home run over his first nine outings before allowing two against Amarillo on June 7th. The two home runs were a grand slam and a two-run shot in a 7-4 loss to the Sod Poodles.

-Leiter was placed on the Development List on June 28th and was activated on July 10th before his start against San Antonio.

-Pitched a 1-2-3 inning on nine pitches in The SiriusXM All-Star Futures Game from Dodger Stadium on July 16th.

### 2021 SEASON

-After being drafted second overall in the 2021 draft, Leiter did not pitch in the minor leagues. Instead, he returned to Vanderbilt to workout, continue college and prepare for 2022. Did not finish degree, but got closer.

-Leiter was high school teammates with Yankees No. 1 prospect (No. 8 in baseball) Anthony Volpe at Delbarton School (NJ).
