LAST TIME OUT: Brooklyn fell short in the initial game of the 2024 second half on Friday night, as Jersey Shore emerged victorious, 2-1 in 10 innings...RHP **Kade Morris** pitched a strong six frames, earning a quality start, surrendering only two runs on three hits...SS **William Lugo** crushed his fourth home run of the year - a solo shot to tie the game with Brooklyn down to its final out in the bottom of the ninth...Still, the Cyclones could not bring home the automatic runner in the bottom of the 10th after Jersey Shore accomplished the feat in the top half on a wild pitch...CF **Nick Morabito** and 1B **Nick Lorusso** each enjoyed multi-hit performances, while LHP **Julian Smith** and RHP **Joshua Cornielli** combined for four one-run innings of relief work...Jersey Shore clinched at least a series split, meaning a Brooklyn loss on Saturday or Sunday would be its first home series loss of 2024.

TODAY IN CYCLONES HISTORY: On June 22, 2015, CF/RF **Tucker Tharp** set a single-game Brooklyn Cyclones record, scoring five runs in a 14-0 win vs. Tri-City at Maimonides Park...Tharp went 4-for-4 in the game with an RBI and a walk...RF **Michael Bernal** clubbed a two-run home run and drove in four runs for Brooklyn...RHP **Matt Blackham** (7.0 IP), RHP **Christian Montgomery** (1.0), and RHP **Corey Taylor** (1.0) combined on a four-hit shutout that day for the Cyclones...Tharp was the New York Mets' 30th-round selection in 2014 out of Kansas University.

NICK SQUARED: OF **Nick Morabito** and IF **Nick Lorusso** have been two of Brooklyn's biggest offensive contributors as of late...The duo each put together multi-hit games in Friday's loss to Jersey Shore...Lorusso is tied for eighth in the circuit in extra-base hits (25), 10th in total bases (103) and OPS (.848)...Lorusso is third among New York Mets' full-season minor leaguers slugging (.481), tied for third in triples (3) and extra-base hits (25), fourth in OPS (.848), and tied for fifth in home runs (9) and RBI (35)...Morabito is tied for seventh in Minor League Baseball in stolen bases (32) and ranks 11th in on-base percentage (.437)...Since making his South Atlantic League debut on May 7, the former second-round pick is second in the league in steals (21), third in runs scored (29), and tied for seventh in hits (43)...The 21-year-old leads all full-season Mets farmhands in batting average (.327), on-base percentage (.437), and stolen bases (32)...He also tied for first in hits (74), third in OPS (.857) and runs scored (43), and fourth in walks (38).

O SAY, CONSUEGRA: OF **Stanley Consuegra** is in the midst of his best offensive stretch of the season...The 23-year-old tallied a career-high-tying four hits in last Sunday's loss at Hudson Valley...Consuegra has accomplished the feat four times, most recently on April 13, 2023, at Winston-Salem...He is also the second Cyclone to reach that mark in 2024, joining CF **Nick Morabito** (5/28 @JS)...Since May 17 at Bowling Green, he's hitting .294/.407/.549 with a .956 OPS...The Santo Domingo, D.R. native has scored 14 runs and added eight doubles, six home runs, and 20 RBI...Consuegra has raised his batting average by 61 points (.171 to .232) and his OPS by 216 points (.519 to .735) during the stretch...Since that date, the right-handed slugger is tied for fourth in the South Atlantic League in extra-base hits (14) and doubles (8), tied for seventh in total bases (56), ninth in slugging (.549), and 10th in OPS (.956)...On Wednesday, the veteran surpassed UTL **Jaylen Palmer** (204) for the most games played in franchise history (207)...Consuegra also set the Cyclones' all-time doubles record (40) on June 8 vs. Aberdeen and the all-time hits mark (185) on May 29 at Jersey Shore...He is also the franchise's all-time leader in extra-base hits (81), home runs (35), RBI (121), and outfield assists (19)...Consuegra also holds the single-season mark for home runs (23), and extra-base hits (42), and is tied with INF **Ronny Mauricio** (63) for single-season RBI.

JOLTIN' JEFREY: IF/OF **Jefrey De Los Santos** is in the midst of perhaps his best stretch of the 2024 season...The Higüey, D.R. native has already notched six multi-hit games in June...During the calendar month, De Los Santos has hit safely in all but four games...The left-handed swinger is tied for second in the league in triples (2) and eighth in slugging (.560) and OPS (.953) during the month...Since May 16, the 21-year-old is second on the 'Clones in batting average (.274) and OPS (.860), trailing only OF **Stanley Consuegra** in both categories.

SUERO SUAVE: C **Chris Suero** has started to find his rhythm offensively in the South Atlantic League...The 20-year-old capped the last home series vs. Aberdeen with his first career multi-home run game, blasting two-run shots in the fourth and sixth innings...In five games against the IronBirds, Suero was 7-for-16 (.438) at the dish with seven runs scored, a double, three home runs, and an eye-popping 11 RBI...Since May 17 at Bowling Green, Suero has reached safely in 24 of 25 games, hitting .267/.413/.419 with an .832 OPS...The Bronx native has scored a whopping 20 runs with a double, four home runs, 18 RBI, and 21 walks...Since that date, Suero is fourth in the SAL in walks (21) and 10th in on-base percentage (.413)...The third-year pro has also reached in 13-straight contests since June 6...Suero is hitting .289/.441/.511 with a .952 OPS in that span, accumulating 10 runs, a double, three home runs, 13 RBI, and 13 walks to 14 strikeouts.

vs. JERSEY SHORE: Brooklyn returns home for a six-game series, including the final three games of the season's first half, against the Phillies' High-A affiliate...Jersey Shore boasts seven of Philadelphia's top 30 prospects per MLB Pipeline: INF **Aidan Miller** (2), OF **Justin Crawford** (4), INF **William Bergolla** (11), OF **Emarion Boyd** (16), OF **Hendry Mendez** (22), LHP **Sam Aldegheri** (23), RHP **George Klassen** (28)...The Cyclones split both series played in 2024 at ShoreTown Ballpark, going 6-6 in 12 contests...Brooklyn does not return to Jersey Shore in the 2024 regular season, hosting the final 15 meetings...In 2023, Brooklyn dropped the season series to the Jersey Shore, 15-11...The Cyclones were 11-6 in Lakewood and 4-5 on Coney Island...Dating back to 2021, Brooklyn leads the all-time series, 53-46 (.535).

JUNIOR MINTS: INF **Junior Tilen** enters play tied for the longest active on-base streak in the South Atlantic League, and tied for the third-longest of the year, reaching in 26 consecutive games since Game 1 of a doubleheader on May 16 at Bowling Green...Greenville OF **Allen Castro** has also reached in 26-straight games...Greenville's INF **Kristian Campbell** reached in 34-straight contests from April 11 to May 31, the SAL's longest run in 2024...The 21-year-old has accumulated a .268/.357/.402 slash line with a .759 OPS during the streak, adding five doubles, a triple, two home runs, 13 RBI, and 14 walks...The infielder is the first Cyclone to record an on-base streak of 20 or more games since INF **José Peroza** reached in 31-consecutive games from July 29 until September 2, 2022...Tilen also posted a 10-game hitting streak from May 26 until June 9...He slashed .375/.409/.550 with a .959 OPS in that time.

OH, HENRY! The Cyclones added RHP **Henry Henry** from Single-A St. Lucie on Tuesday...The 25-year-old made his Brooklyn debut on June 19th vs. Jersey Shore, tossing one scoreless inning of relief work where he accumulated two strikeouts and allowed one hit...Signed by New York as a minor league free agent on May 16, the San Cristóbal, D.R. native spent the first eight seasons of his professional career in the San Diego Padres...Between High-A Fort Wayne and Double-A San Antonio, Henry was 3-4 with a 5.19 ERA (29 ER in 50.1 IP) with 35 walks and 37 strikeouts in 34 appearances (three starts) in 2023...Henry Henry is not to be confused with former Pittsburgh Pirates infield prospect **Henry Henry** or the Cyclones' legendary on-field emcee **King Henry**.

WALK THIS WAY: INF **William Lugo** has had a keen eye at the plate in 2024, drawing 48 walks...That number ranks second in the South Atlantic League, while his 20.0% walk rate is first...Among minor leaguers with 240 or more plate appearances, Lugo sits fourth in walk rate...Lugo's former Cyclone teammate and Double-A Binghamton's IF/OF **Ryan Clifford** leads MiLB (22.3%).

YOU'LL GET NOTHING AND LIKE IT: RHPs **Dakota Hawkins** (5.0 IP), **Joey Lancellotti** (1.0), and **Joshua Cornielli** (3.0) combined on the first nine-inning no-hitter in Brooklyn Cyclones history June 4's 3-0 win vs. Aberdeen...The only previous no-hitter came on August 23, 2009, when RHP **Brandon Moore** tossed a seven-inning no-no in a 5-0 win during Game 1 of a doubleheader at Aberdeen...It is one of four no-hitters in Minor League Baseball in 2024...The effort was the first no-hitter by a Mets minor league affiliate since RHP **Joander Suárez** hurled a seven-inning one on September 7 at Hartford...It was also the first nine-inning no-hitter thrown in the borough of Brooklyn since RHP **Sal Maglie** tossed a no-no for the Dodgers against the Philadelphia Phillies on September 25, 1956, at Ebbets Field.

ATOP THE HEJ-ES: RHP **Josh Hejka** earned his first save of the season on May 5 vs. Aberdeen, making his Cyclones' franchise-record-setting 48th pitching appearance in the process...The 27-year-old broke a tie with **Hunter Parsons** (47) for the most pitching appearances in Cyclones franchise history...In his 61 career outings for Brooklyn since 2019, Hejka has accumulated a 5-3 record with a 2.35 ERA (26 ER in 99.2 IP) and 7 saves, walking just 24 and striking out 88.

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: The Brooklyn Cyclones have several Top 30 prospects according to *Baseball America* and MLB Pipeline...The 'Clones have three of the Top 30 per BA: **Kade Morris** (21), **Jonah Tong** (22) and **Calvin Ziegler** (29)...Ziegler is currently on the full-season injured list...Plus four of the Top 30 per MLB: Tong (20), Ziegler (23), **Wilfredo Lara** (24), and OF **Nick Morabito** (26).

LAST TIME OUT: Did not receive a decision last Sunday afternoon at Hudson Valley...Surrendered one run on two hits over 3.0 innings...Walked a career-high three and struck out one...Permitted a solo home run to 2B **Roc Riggio** in the bottom of the first...Tossed a career-high 60 pitches and 31 strikes (51.67%)...Relieved by RHP **Ben Simon** to start the bottom of the fourth with Brooklyn leading 2-1...The Renegades scored two runs in the bottom of the 10th – winning on a CF **Jace Avina** sacrifice fly to left – to walk-off the Cyclones, 8-7.

BIRDMAN BIRDMAN: Prior to joining the rotation, Hawkins impressed in a relief role...Among South Atlantic League relievers, the 24-year-old was sixth in strikeouts (34) and tied for sixth in innings pitched (24.2) prior to his first start...He was also first in ground ball rate (62.1%) and swinging strike rate (19.7%), second in strikeout rate (33.0%) and FIP (1.88), fourth in strikeout-to-walk rate (24.3%), seventh in walk rate (8.7%).

2023: Signed with the New York Mets as an undrafted free agent out of Washington State University on July 19, 2023...Assigned to the Florida Complex League Mets on August 11...Made a pair of scoreless relief appearances before being transferred to Single-A St. Lucie on August 26...Did not allow a run on two hits over 6.0 innings with the Mets...Struck out seven without issuing a walk.

WAZZOU WIZARD: The Chehalis, Wash. native had an outstanding career at Washington State University...After starting his collegiate tenure with two years at Lower Columbia College (Longview, Wash.), Hawkins went on to be named All-PAC 12 Honorable Mention in 2023...In 14 starts, he accrued a 5-3 record with a 4.32 ERA (35 ER in 73.0 IP) with 27 walks and 92 strikeouts...His 92 K's were fourth in the conference and ninth-most in a single-season at Washington State.
